ZEKE SLATER – INQUIRY CONCLUDED

Stewards have concluded an Inquiry into the betting activities of Mr Zeke Slater whilst disqualified.

On August 9 2018, Mr Slater reserved his plea to and was then found guilty of charges pursuant to AHRR 259(j) and written submissions were then made in relation to penalty.

Under the provisions of AHRR 259A Mr Slaters disqualification of eighteen months was recommenced from 4 August 2017 and will expire at midnight on 3 February 2019.

In determining penalty, Stewards were mindful of Mr Slaters offence history which included previous breaches of disqualification, the volume and value of bets placed by Mr Slater, his personal circumstances and that breaches of disqualification are serious matters requiring penalties which serve to act as a specific and general deterrent.
