SHORT FORM - REASONS FOR DECISION

1. The board is comfortably satisfied that the charge occurred in the manner originally laid and described by Stewards.
2. The appeal against conviction is dismissed.
3. The Board finds that the Stewards proceeded to impose penalty using a personnel incident report that had not been properly updated to include two past successful appeals (such error in that document disadvantaging the appellant).
4. In consideration of such an error the appeal against penalty is upheld and the penalty varied to a severe reprimand.
5. In accordance with section 99(4) and 99(5)(d) of the Act, 25% of the appellant's prescribed deposit is to be forfeited to the Secretary of the Department. The appellant is also ordered to pay 25% of the cost incurred in preparation of the transcript in accordance with section 99(8) and 99(9)(c) of the Act.
