TOPIC: **Tasmanian Bushfires – Survey Recovery Plan for the Tasman Peninsula**

DATE: 4 February 2013

All Tasmanian Registered Land Surveyors are advised that, as part of the Tasmanian Bushfire Recovery Program, the Office of the Surveyor General has developed a Survey Recovery Plan and conducted a number of surveys on the Tasman Peninsula in the following areas:

- Boomer Bay
- Dunalley
- Dunalley South
- Murdunna
- Sommers Bay
- Connellys Marsh

The objective of these surveys was to locate and document existing permanent marks, property boundaries, reference marks and other cadastral evidence considered at risk from recovery and clearance activities.

Additional survey control was also established and this information is now available in the Survey Control Marks Database (SurCoM).

Survey Information Only (SIO) plans are currently being prepared and are expected to be available through the Land Information System Tasmania (the LIST) in mid-February.

In the interim, surveyors engaged on remarks or surveys in these areas are advised to contact this Office to ensure coordination of activities and survey information:

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
