My husband, Professor Frank van Kann, and I, Susan Hartley, moved here to farm seven years ago. We came here because this is an excellent location to grow clean, green, GMO free food and to do eco tourism specialising in paddock to plate with organic food (presently in conversion).

Apart from the cost of purchase of our 69 hectare farm in Tasmania, we have spent a further\$600k in setting up our business in farming and eco tourism, employing locals in a number of capacities.

We assure the panel that any change in the material nature of the food we grow and feed our animals would have a very negative impact on our business and our viability.

We wish to see the status of GMO free Tasmania maintained, and further more, marketed as a special point-of-difference compared with other food destinations on mainland Australia.
