R56 (6) A female greyhound shall not be used for breeding purposes unless registered with a Controlling Body as a 'breeding female'.

R56 (8) Application for registration as a breeding female may be made by the owner of a breeding female or person authorised by the owner, by lodging with the Controlling Body in the state or territory in which the relevant person resides –

- a completed prescribed form together with a prescribed fee; and
- at the expense of the applicant, a DNA fingerprint analysis on a sample taken by a veterinarian or other authorised person and carried out by an approved DNA laboratory; and
- evidence of meeting the minimum vaccination requirements in rule 25 of these Rules.

L56.1 A person may not apply for the registration of a breeding female unless they are registered as a breeder.

R56 (9) The period of registration for a breeding female is to be one (1) year from the current vaccination date pursuant to sub-rule (8)(c) of this rule.
