NOTICE REGARDING SECTION 263 OF THE *LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995*:

Under section 263 of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* a person, in making an application, giving any document or stating anything to a fisheries officer, must not:

- (a) make a statement knowing it to be false or misleading; or
- (b) omit any matter from a statement knowing that without that matter the statement is misleading.

Penalty - fine not exceeding 500 penalty units
