## REMINDER TO TRAINERS: TRAINERS MUST KEEP TREATMENT RECORDS

Stewards wish to remind all trainers of their obligations under the relevant Rules of Racing for each code to maintain accurate treatment records in the prescribed format.

Please refer to the relevant Rules of Racing for details on what must be contained in a treatment record. At a minimum two (2) years' worth of records must be retained by a trainer, regardless of whether a racing animal is still in that trainer's care.

Accurate and up-to-date treatment records must be made available to Stewards for inspection immediately upon request.

It is recommended that treatment records be kept securely stored at a trainer's registered training facility.

Penalties will apply for any rule breaches relating to the keeping, maintaining or failing to produce treatment records.
