


LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995
NOTICE FOR THE TASMANIAN SCALLOP FISHERY COMPRISING ACTIVITIES
BY WAY OF FISHING FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES -

I, Dr Ian Dutton, General Manager- Marine Resources, Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment, acting pursuant to a delegation from the Minister for Primary Industries and Water made on 7 January 2021 and acting pursuant to Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act), in accordance with the *Fisheries (Scallop) Rules 2020*, hereby:

1. Determine under Rule 18(1)(a), the dates of the open season for the commercial scallop fishery, are from 12:01am 24 June 2022 to 11:59pm 31 December 2022 (inclusive).
2. Determine under Rule 19(1)(a) and 19(1)(b), the specified area of State waters to be open to the commercial scallop fishery for commercial scallop dredging are State waters adjacent to the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north by the line of latitude at 42° 20.483' South running due east from Cape Sonnerat (Schouten Island), bounded in the south by the line of latitude at 43° 14.8' South running due east of the Monkeys (Tasman Island), bound in the east by the line of longitude 148° 30' East, and also including the waters within Great Oyster Bay north of latitude 42° 20.483' South, excluding: State waters contained within the following boundary:
 - i. latitude 42° 18.334' S, longitude 148° 02.698' E; to
 - ii. latitude 42° 17.495' S, longitude 148° 05.030'E; to
 - iii. latitude 42° 22.5' S, longitude 148° 05.024' E; to
 - iv. latitude 42° 22.5'S, longitude 148° 01.753'E; to
 - v. latitude 42° 20.698' S, longitude 148° 02.701' E; to
 - vi. latitude 42° 18.334' S, longitude 148° 02.698' E.
