Hi Jen, points from the development lease are below. I would say on this reading that the boat is authorised, provided all RAA/envt conditions from regional perspective are met and Chris mentioned this previously as having been done. Even if the boat was not mentioned specifically in the leases (it is not mentioned in the hut lease) I would say that use of the boat for access for either of the leases would be an ancillary purpose and ok.

Approved Use means the use of the Land:

- (a) for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and using the Development (including the construction and use of a helipad on the Conservation Area);
- (b) for the provision of commercial hut accommodation for Clients on Halls Island;
- (c) for the provision of a docking point on Halls Island (including providing for the transfer of Clients and goods) from the Conservation Area to Halls Island in a row boat;
- (d) for the provision of access and egress by foot by the Operator and the Client over those parts of the Conservation Area to the helipad;
- (e) for the purpose of transporting Clients over Lake Malbena from the Conservation Area to Halls Island by row boat; and
- (f) for uses that are reasonably ancillary to the uses referred to in paragraphs (a),(b), (c), (d) and (e) above;

subject to the paragraphs (a) - (f) inclusive, the Operator acknowledges the number of commercial camps to Halls Island is limited to a maximum of 30 each year of the Term. .

Development means the design, construction and completion all of the works (including building works) which are required to be carried out in accordance with Schedule A, including:

- (a) the installation and construction of infrastructure reasonably necessary to provide for hut accommodation facilities within that part of the Land on Halls Island,
- (b) the installation and construction of infrastructure reasonably necessary to enable the embarking and disembarking of Clients onto the Land from a row boat
- (c) the establishment of a Walking Route, which the Operator acknowledges may be assessed by the Minister from time to time, with the Minister reserving the right to request that the Operator construct a hard track, which may require further environmental assessment, at the cost of the Operator;
- (d) the installation and construction of a helipad necessary to enable the landing and taking off of helicopters to allow Clients to embark and disembark onto that part of the Land contained within the Conservation Area;; and

where the context admits or requires, means those buildings and improvements once constructed.

The Deputy Secretary has determined that we will provide you with an Aircraft Landing Authority so you can undertake your outstanding surveys. He has asked me to get more information from you to inform the authority and determine that your request fits the requirements of the TWWHA Plan.

Can you provide a detailed explanation addressing the following to me in writing (return email OK).

- The purpose of the flight(s) and landing(s) (landing includes the dropping of an object (boat / equipment) by an aircraft) such as transport personnel and vessel / equipment.
- The need (why do you need to do it – what surveys are you undertaking)
- The precise dates and times of the flights (including the number of flights and landings).
- The coordinates of the landing site.
- The number of people and other equipment being transported.

In addition can you also provide a description of the vessel and its power source (oars / motor etc) to ensure it complies with the TWWHA plan.

Helicopter depart Halls Island 441991E, 5355460N. 1 landing and take-off permitted at 442498E, 5355305N (adjacent Halls Island).

09/05/2019

1 landing and take-off permitted at 442498E, 5355305N (adjacent Halls Island).

Additional Conditions:

1. All equipment and materials used in association with all landings are to be removed from the Reserved Land by the permit holder.
2. On each occasion of landing or taking off, the authority holder or representative in the aircraft and/or the aircraft pilot shall be in possession of a copy of this authority.
3. Confirmation of the pilot's intentions is to be given to Paul Flood, Acting Ranger in Charge – Great Western Tiers (0429 635 182) at least 24 hours before commencement of operations.
4. Provision is to be made for a representative of the Director to be present during any aircraft operation allowed under this authority, should this be requested.
5. The authority holder must comply with all reasonable instructions given by Parks and Wildlife Service staff.
6. No flora, fauna, artifacts or other material not connected with the authority holder's operations may be removed or disturbed without appropriate authority.
7. All personal footwear, equipment and the aircraft are to be cleaned so as to remove any soil or other material which may carry pathogens such as *Phytophthora cinnamomi* (die-back root-rot fungus), Chytrid Fungus Disease and Didymo Algae prior to any landing on reserved land.
8. The authority holder must ensure that all helicopter and sling loading operations are operated in accordance and compliant with the conditions of an approved Job safety Analysis (JSA) for this activity and that landing and takeoff areas are secure and safe for the public prior to the commencement of and during operations. Ensure that slinging loads over or across public access areas and tracks is avoided or risk mitigated.
