

FOOD RECYCLING

Guide to food waste that must not be fed to animals

Food waste that **MUST NOT** be fed to ruminants: goats, cows, deer, sheep or camelids (alpacas, camels or llamas)



- ⊘ Meat or products derived from meat (e.g. sausages or offal) or meat processing by products (feathers, blood)
- ⊘ Fresh bakery goods (including meat pies, sausage rolls and quiche)
- ⊘ Shelf stable bakery products that contain meat (including cheese and bacon rolls)
- ⊘ Fish

Food waste that **MUST NOT** be fed to pigs



- ⊘ Cream, cheese, milk, butter and other dairy products imported from other countries
- ⊘ Food products which have had contact with meat
- ⊘ Fresh bakery goods (including meat pies, sausage rolls and quiche)
- ⊘ Shelf stable bakery products that contain meat (including cheese and bacon rolls)
- ⊘ Meat or products derived from meat (e.g. sausages or offal) or meat processing by-products (blood)
