

SUMMARY OF THE MODIFICATIONS TO THE PIPE CLAY
LAGOON MARINE FARMING DEVELOPMENT PLAN OCTOBER
1998.

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Primary Industries and Water conducted a review of the Pipe Clay Lagoon Marine Farming Development Plan October 1998 (MFDP) in 2008, in accordance with section 48 of the *Marine Farming Planning Act 1995* (MFPA).

The review identified three modifications to the Pipe Clay Lagoon MFDP October 1998. The Minister for Primary Industries and Water gave final approval to the modifications on the 11 December 2008, in accordance with section 31 (3)(a) of the MFPA.

In accordance with section 48(3)(c) of the Act, the modifications supersede the relevant parts of the Pipe Clay Lagoon MFDP October 1998.

MODIFICATIONS

Modification 1

It was identified during the review of the Pipe Clay Lagoon MFDP October 1998 that the location of a flow channel within Zone 2 deviated from the location defined by coordinates specified in the plan. The coordinates within the plan were modified to reflect the true location of the flow channel within Zone 2.

Modification 2

Zone 2 was modified to permit the stocking of a lease within the zone to hold stock larger than 15mm, being the prescribed limit in the original Pipe Clay Lagoon MFDP October 1998. The modification provides for the holding of up to 3000 brood stock up to 150mm in length.

Modification 3

Minor modifications to some of the zone coordinates were necessary to rectify anomalies identified as a result of upgrades to mapping software utilised in the development of marine farming development plans. In addition, all coordinates were converted to the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA 94).
