

Fee Increase

From 1 July 2022, the Tasmanian Government is introducing a **landfill levy** on waste sent to landfill.

Funds will be reinvested in resource recovery and recycling initiatives across Tasmania.

The Tasmanian Government has introduced a landfill levy on waste going to landfill. This will encourage people to reduce waste and recycle. Materials such as aluminium, plastic, paper and cardboard are resources that can be recycled.



This means that landfills will not fill up so quickly and items such as batteries do not end up polluting our water and land.



The money raised by the levy will be used to support new recycling initiatives. For example, factories to make plastic building materials, new furniture from timber offcuts, and to make compost out of organic waste like food scraps.



This is good news for Tasmanians. Modelling undertaken by economists shows that the landfill levy will result in 130 full time jobs in the first few years of operation.
