

Summary of Direction to Conduct a Steward's Investigation under Rule 181 of the Australian Harness Racing Rules and to Take Associated Actions

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Take any action available pursuant to appointments as stewards to remediate, penalise, or address these matters as appropriate. These actions may include the making of further determinations, the laying of charges, the imposition of penalties, as well as any actions available to you under the Australian Harness Racing Rules (AHRR) 181 and 183.

Specific matters to address:

- Fifteen races referred by Mr Ray Murrhiy that may involve questionable race tactics, for consideration of further scrutiny and to take any action as appropriate and available under AHRR 181 and 183.
- Review the following specific findings relating to the AHRR reported in Mr Ray Murrhiy's Final Report:
 - Finding 1 - Race 2 on 7 October 2022 at Burnie
 - Finding 5 - Race 3 on 19 August 2022 at Launceston
 - Finding 6 - Failure to care for two-year-old gelding Blings on Fire
 - Finding 7 - Mistreatment of horses in the wash bay on race days at Yole Sidmouth property
 - Finding 8 - Race day administration of medication
 - Finding 9 - Administration of injections to horses within one clear day of the race
 - Finding 10 - Administration of intra-articular injections to horses within eight clear days of the race.
