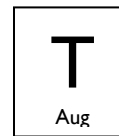

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

In the event of such licence being granted, I agree:

- To observe and be bound by the Australian Rules of Racing (including the Local Rules of Racing imposed by the Principal Racing Authority) together with all applicable Race Club by-laws and Track Regulations and Association Regulations in force from time to time during the currency of such licence.
- To observe and be bound by such directions as may from time to time be made or given by the Committee, Stewards or officials of the Principal Racing Authorities or any Race Club or Association.
- That the Licence may be revoked at any time by the Director of Racing without the giving of any reason in accordance with the Rules.
- That the Principal Racing Authority gives no warranty as to the suitability and/or safety of the premises, track, and training or other facilities owned or occupied by any Race Club, Association or other entity connected with horse racing, and that I must at all times satisfy myself as to the fact that such premises, track, training or other facilities are appropriate, fit for purpose and without obvious defect.
- Not to make any public statement or comment concerning any matter currently the subject of investigation or hearing by or before the Principal Racing Authority, or the Stewards, Committee or Appeals panel or other body authorised by each.
- To provide any sample either prior to or subsequent to riding in any race, trial or trackwork for the purpose of detecting any substance banned under the Rules if directed to do so by the Stewards.
- To (in the case of a female rider) not ride after the first trimester of a pregnancy and to only continue riding during the first trimester subject to fulfilling the conditions and requirements outlined in the Rules.
- That I shall not be exempted from personal liability arising under the Rules for or by any reason whatsoever.
- That I acknowledge and accept my obligation to the owners of any horse, when interviewed by the media, in respect to disclosure of private or confidential information.
- That it is a requirement under the Australian Rules of Racing that at all times when mounted on a horse, I wear an approved safety vest, a properly affixed and approved skullcap and approved footwear.
- That I am aware the Director only grants licences to Jockeys on the condition that I am not an owner or part owner or any racehorse.
- That I understand that I am not allowed to bet on horse racing or to receive presents in connection with races from persons other than the owners of the horse I ride in such races, and that should it be proved that I have any interest in any racehorse or be engaged in any betting transaction or otherwise to have disregarded this notice, I may be fined, my licence suspended or disqualified.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

In making my application to be licensed as a Visiting Jockey, I hereby –

- Declare that the information contained in this Application for Licence is true and correct and I am aware of the consequences for giving false information or failing to declare all relevant information;
- Agree that in the event of my application being approved to be bound by, and comply with, the policies, directions and Rules of Racing in Tasmania, as amended from time to time;
- Agree that I am bound by Tasracing's Conditions of Entry (www.tasracingcorporate.com.au/conditions-of-entry) and Track Rules (www.tasracingcorporate.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2012/11/TASRACING-TSD0057-Thoroughbred-Track-Rules.pdf) as set down from time to time by Tasracing at both training and racing venues; and
- Declare that I have read and understood the Conditions of Licence.
- Acknowledge that any debts accrued or owed by me to Tasracing and/or the Office of Racing Integrity will be paid within the time permitted by those organisations.

AR.278 – Disqualified Persons Bound by Rules during disqualification

- (1) Subject to subrule(2), if a licensed person is disqualified, that person's licence immediately ceases and becomes void, and that person must make application to a PRA to be relicensed in order to be granted a new licence.
- (2) For the duration of a period of disqualification, a disqualified person is and remains bound by, and subject to, the Rules.

AR.23 – Suspension pending the hearing and determination of a charge

Without limiting any other rules or Stewards' powers, if a person has been charged with a breach of these Rules (or a local rule of a Principal Racing Authority) or with the commission of an indictable criminal offence, and if the Stewards are of the opinion that the continued participation of that person in racing might pose an unacceptable risk of prejudicing the image, interests, integrity or welfare of racing, the Stewards may pending the hearing and determination of the charge:

- Suspend any licence, registration, right or privilege, granted under these Australian Rules;
- Prevent any horse owned (or part owned) or leased by that person from participating in any race or official trial;
- Order that any registration of the transfer of ownership and/or training of a horse related to that person be prevented or suspended;
- Make any other direction or order the Stewards think fit in the interests of racing.
