

ON LOAN APPRENTICE JOCKEYS

Any trainer wishing to employ an Apprentice Jockey under a loan agreement must complete the following before the apprentice is permitted to work in their stables or ride in races in Tasmania.

- Make the necessary application to the Principal Racing Authority (PRA) where the apprentice is indentured in conjunction with the Master of the Apprentice.
- The apprentice must complete a Next of Kin form and an Emergency Medical Information sheet in accordance with Local Rules before riding in Tasmania.
- Obtain the relevant approval from Tasracing by lodging a copy of the completed and signed loan agreement.

Once advised by Tasracing that approval for the loan has been granted, the Office of Racing Integrity (ORI) will contact the relevant PRA to obtain information regarding the medical details, concussion information and clearance.

Trainers are reminded that the apprentice **MUST NOT** perform any duties for them until they have been advised that the registration of the loan agreement has been approved and all information has been submitted to ORI.
