Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS 2YO MADIEN – 1000 METRES

Bold Instinct (B Muchu) – Bumped with Decisive Choice at the start.

Froland (M Ulucinar) – Slow to begin.

Galan (T Baker) – Rider reported the gelding hung out throughout.

Grand Pegasus (T Doyle) – Jumped awkwardly and lost ground.

Decisive Choice (A Darmanin) – Jumped outwards at the start bumping with Bold Instinct. Over raced early stages. Rider A Darmanin was reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mount out fully to the line.

Jaguar Stone (E Byrne Burke) – Slow to begin, layed in home straight.

Pink Beauty (C Jordan) – Stewards queried C Jordan in relation to the filly's performance. Rider C Jordan stated that the filly was racing back in distance and was unsuited to the quick early pace.

RACE 2 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS MADIEN – 1100 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when Stewards viewed the official patrol films of the start to consider making Selkie (T Baker) a non-runner. After reviewing the official patrol films and speaking with the stater Mr D Evans and rider T Baker, Stewards deemed Selkie a runner.

Moonlight Knight (T Doyle) – Slow to begin.

Step Too Far (T Stalker) – Shifted out at start.

Vivre Is The Word (B McCoull) – Slow to begin. Steadied off heels of Finxy at 800 metres.

Etosha (M Ulucinar) – Jumped awkwardly.

Gee Gees Fifthtest (D Parish) – Underwent a post race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Reconstructive (B Muchu) – Travelled wide throughout.

Rohzhae (B Louis) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start when tightened by Step Too Far and Crystal Pallazo.

Selkie (T Baker) – Dropped head prior to jumping, harmlessly dislodging its rider. Underwent a post race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Crystal Pallazo (E Byrne Burke) – Shifted in at start.

Rider T Baker underwent an examination by the on-course medical staff and was passed fit to take his remaining rides.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES MONEY BACK ODDS MDN/CL1 – 1600 METRES

Starion (A Darmanin) – Slow to begin. Rider was queried on the performance of the gelding. Rider A Darmanin stated that when the gelding was placed under pressure at the 600 metres, it failed to respond to his riding.

Innocent Pegg (T Doyle) – Layed in home straight.

McDowall (B Louis) – Layed out at 1400 metres. Over raced throughout middle stages.

Esque (M Ulucinar) – Failed to muster early speed.

RACE 4 – MONTONE CLASS 3 HCP – 1200 METRES

Nothing to report.

RACE 5 – HYGAIN BENCHMARK 64 HCP F&M – 1400 METRES

Gee Gee Josie (A Darmanin) – Was declared a non-runner when the gelding prematurely broke through the gates. Bumped with Miss Charlie Brown at 200 metres. Underwent a post race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

The following deductions for the non-runner were ordered:

Gee Gees Jenina	(1 st) -- 4 cents a win & 7 cents a place
Verbano	(2 nd) – 7 cents a place
Stelladoni	(3 rd) – 7 cents a place

Verbano (D Pires) – Layed in home straight. Rider D Pires pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip 6 times prior to the 100 meters and 9 times within the 100 meters for a totality of 16 times. Mr Pires was fined the sum of \$300.00 and was reminded of his right to appeal.

Miss Charlie Brown (B McCoull) – Bumped with Gee Gee Josie at 200 metres.

Steffanidi (B Muhcu) – Hung in throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

RACE 6 – THE MILLS NEW NORFOLK GUINEAS – 1600 METRES

Alpine Wolf – Over raced middle stages. Jockey D Ganderton pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(c) in that he performed a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post. Rider D Ganderton was fined the sum of \$200.00 and advised of his right to appeal.

Medal - Trainer representative Mr G White pleaded guilty to a charge under AR106 for incorrect gear in that Medal did not wear blinkers in the race when declared to do so. Mr White was fined the sum of \$100.00

Rich Clan (A Darmanin) – Over raced early and middle stages.

Ensnare (C Jordan) – Slow to begin. Wide throughout

Stewards spoke with rider D Ganderton in relation to directions given to him when leaving the mounting yard. Stewards took no further action only to remind rider D Ganderton on his obligation to adhere to stewards directions in the future. In taking no action stewards were mindful that miscommunication had caused this incident.

RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN STAKES – 1600 METRES

The all clear in this event was delayed when Jockey D Pires requested to view the official patrol films in relation to alleged interference in the home straight. After viewing the films, Mr Pires elected not to lodge a protest and all clear was given on the judge's numbers.

Lim's Cruiser (B McCoull) - Bumped on entering the home straight. Layed out momentarily in the home straight.

The Inevitable (S Carr) – Slow to begin. Over raced middle stages. Layed in home straight. Jockey S Carr was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift in at the 100 meters when insufficiently clear of Brinktop Lad. In not taking further action stewards could not attribute the blame to anyone rider as Lim's Cruiser had marginally rolled out at the same time.

Mandela Effect (B McDougall) – Slow to begin.

Blaze Forth (A Darmanin) – Over raced early and middle stages.

Brinktop Lad (D Pires) – Over raced early stages. Tightened and checked off the heels of The Inevitable in the home straight.

Videmanette (S Miller) – Bumped on entering the home straight.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BRIGHTON CUP – 2100 METRES

One Lotto (B McDougall) – Rider granted permission to ride 1 kilogram over the allotted weight.

Creative Hero (T Baker) – Caught wide early and middle stages. Over raced middle stages.

Full Knots Ahead (S Carr) – Layed in home straight causing rider S Carr to stop and straighten. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on 8 times prior to the 100 meters and 10 times within the 100 meters for a totality of 18 occasions. Ms S Carr was fined the sum of \$500.00 and advised of her right to appeal.

Encosta Fiorente (A Darmanin) – Jumped awkwardly. Slow to begin.

One Lotto (B McDougall) – Jumped awkwardly. Slow to begin.

So Astounding (G Catania) – Got its head up and over raced in early stages.

RACE 9 – TASMANIAN WINE CENTRE CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Meeting abandoned prior to Race 9 due to poor visibility, thunder, lightning and heavy downpour of rain @ 4.11pm

Rider A Darmanin was found guilty of a charge under AR218(2)(c) in that his mobile phone was in his possession and was turned on in the jockey's room. Mr A Darmanin was fined the sum of \$300.00 and advised of his right to appeal.
