Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – GLENORCHY CRICKET CLUB PACE – 1609 METRES

MISTA EAGLE hung in in the score up and contacted a marker peg. A warning was issued. Showed gate speed to the lead, withstood an early challenge from GAUCI, who then race outside the leader throughout.

TRACER BULLET was caught wide early before restraining to a position in the running line.

After pleading guilty to a charge issued under AHRR168(1)(a), driver Mr M Yole (MAJOR SEASCAPE NZ) was fined the sum of \$100. The particulars of the charge were that entering the home straight, Mr Yole shifted his horse wider on the track when not sufficiently clear of GAUCI (S Rawnsley), causing that horse to be checked. TRACER BULLET (R Ashwood), was inconvenienced in this incident.

RACE 2 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090 METRES

WHEY BETTER was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile barrier draw.

ISLAND ROCKNROLL showed gate speed to lead before surrendering the lead in the early stages to MYKINDOFFEELING who worked forward from the second row to take over that position.

BACCARAT raced outside the leader early before obtaining a trail in the middle stages when SIGNORINA JUJON who moved three wide in the middle stages to take over that position

SIGNORINA JUJON gave ground in the latter stages to be beaten 48.8 metres.

Stable representative Mr P Ford advised Stewards of a change of tactics on STONE CRACKER in that STONE CRACKER would be restrained in the early stages and driven more conservatively.

RACE 3 – TASMANIAN VETERINARY SERVICE PACE – 2090 METRES

JOCUND galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

LAKE EYRE NZ galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

SOMEHOWSOMEWAY galloped out. As this was the pacers first standing start after qualifying, SOMEHOWSOMEWAY and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

ARTIFLASH was fractious before the start, stood flat footed and then galloped out. ARTIFLASH has been placed outside the draw in standing start events.

PROFICIENT NZ was checked after the start by the galloping ARTIFLASH.

MONARKMAC galloped out and will continue to be placed right out of the draw in future standing start events.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2090 METRES

BOOKER BAY broke in the initial score up and caused a false start. BOOKER BAY has been placed out of the draw in future mobile barrier events

BOOKER BAY Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 75 metres. No apparent abnormalities were detected. BOOKER BAY has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

BETTERTHANFETTA showed gate speed to race outside the leader throughout.

Stewards queried the apparent improved performance of JACK JAMES, who raced mid-field before utilising the sprint lane to win the event. Trainer representative Mr M Triffitt advised Stewards that subsequent to its last run JACK JAMES had undergone a veterinary examination where blood samples were taken and JACK JAMES had been treated accordingly. He added that JACK JAMES had been driven conservatively in tonight's event and had appreciated an easy run, which had enabled the horse to finish off as expected. Mr Triffitt advised that JACK JAMES will be driven in a similar fashion in future starts. Trainer Ms J McKenzie was issued with a reprimand under AHRR190(6) in that she failed to notify another person in charge of her horses.

RACE 5 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 1609 METRES

MY CELEBRITY showed gate speed to lead before surrendering the lead in the early stages to BLACKJACK HANOVER who worked forward and took over that position.

MIA FROM MEMPHIS underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after dislodging her driver Mr M Cooper during the preliminary. MIA FROM MEMPHIS was deemed suitable to race.

Driver Mr M Cooper was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(h) for failing to have MIA FROM MEMPHIS in her correct position at the start.

After an inquiry for the reasons for LIFES A JUNGLE (C Crook), racing in a four wide position with 1100 metres to run, driver Mr M Cooper, (MIA FROM MEMPHIS), pleaded guilty to a charge under AHRR163(1)(b)(i). The particulars of the charge were that Mr Cooper shifted his horse wider on the track when not sufficiently clear of LIFES A JUNGLE (C Crook), obliging that horse to race wider on the track. Mr Cooper's licence was suspended for three race dates with the suspension commencing midnight the 14th of May 2021 and expiring midnight the 30th of May 2021.

After beginning satisfactorily, ONLY IN ROME NZ has been placed back in the mobile barrier draw.

An inquiry will be held into the whip action of driver Mr P Hill (BLACKJACKHANOVER) at a date to be fixed. An inquiry will also be held into the reasons for Mr P Hill leaving the track within the 30 minute guidelines following this event.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES PACE – 2090 METRES

Stewards delayed the all clear in this event to enable them to view the patrol films regarding IM JAKS TELLER NZ contacting marker pegs around the home turn. After viewing the patrol films and taking evidence from driver Mr D Ford, Stewards were satisfied that although IM JAKS TELLER NZ had contacted a number of marker pegs around the home turn, no advantage had been gained and the all clear was given on the judges numbers.

IM JAKS TELLER NZ hung in and contacted marker pegs rounding the home turn. IM JAKS TELLER NZ has been placed on its last chance to race truly regarding hanging throughout the race.

FULL SPEED AHEAD NZ which showed gate speed to race outside the leader throughout before tiring to be beaten in excess of 57 metres has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

HEZA BROMAC NZ was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile barrier draw.

HEZA BROMAC NZ who tired in the run to the finish to be beaten in the run to the finish to be beaten in excess of 98 metres. has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 7 – CLUBS TASMANIA PACE – 2090 METRES

OZZIE MAJOR galloped out and has been placed outside the draw in future standing start events.

ANDREW JAY galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the draw in future standing start events

After beginning satisfactorily, PUNCHINELLO has been placed back in the draw in future standing starts.

HEZA RUMMAGE NZ galloped out and has been placed outside the draw in future standing start events

After tiring to be beaten in excess of 149 metres ANDREW JAY underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormalities could be detected. ANDREW JAY has been stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

KEEP PLAYING underwent a post-race veterinary examination after breaking free of interference on the home turn and no apparent abnormalities could be detected. KEEP PLAYING has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

RACE 8 – CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE – 2090 METRES

WEERROOK HARRY raced roughly throughout the event before breaking in the home straight. WEERROOK HARRY has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

Driver Mr C Crook (WEERROOK HARRY), was fined the sum of \$400 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a) for utilising his whip with more than a wrist only flicking motion.
