STARTER: A EMERY

Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES PACE – 2200 METRES

STYLISH TREND NZ – Driver Mr T McDonald fined \$100 under the provisions of AHRR162(1)(y) for exceeding the minimum time standards for the first half of the last mile, completed in 65.58 seconds.

HEIDI GO SEEK – Over raced throughout when leading the one wide line.

LITTLE CESSNA – Three wide, one back from the 900 metre point.

MY ULTIMATE MAJOR – Galloped out - continue out of the draw in standing start races. Three wide, two back from the 900 metre point.

OZZIE MAJOR – Commenced a three wide run near the 900 metre point.

RACE 2 – TASSIE WASH PACE – 2200 METRES

LA TOISON DOR – Had difficulty obtaining a clear run to the finish. - not fully tested.

BACCARAT – Led the one wide line before obtaining a one out one back trail after 400 metres.

MAJOR DAVVIN – Worked forward three wide to take over the position leading the one wide line after 400 metres.

STAR WATCHING – Led then gave ground over the concluding stages.

DAN OF STEEL – Commenced to tire from the 500 metres to ultimately be beaten in excess of 174 metres. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any apparent abnormalities. Having considered the gelding's recent race record Stewards ordered that DAN OF STEEL be stood down from racing for a period of 28 days and until the completion of 4 satisfactory trials.

ROCKOWSROAD – Raced three wide whilst being restrained to the rear of the field. Three wide two back from approaching the 1000 metre point.

COVEFFE HUSTLER – Raced three wide for the first 450 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field. Three wide, one back from approaching the 1000 metres.

FRANKIE BARKER – Enjoyed a three back trailing position throughout the race before commencing to tire from the 450 metre point to be beaten in excess of 85 metres. Having considered the mare's recent race record Stewards ordered that FRANKIE BARKER be stood down from racing for a period of 14 days and until the completion of 2 satisfactory trials.

ANDREW JAY – Sulky contacted from the rear by another runner in the front straight with a lap to travel. Pulled hard throughout the middle stages of the race.

SIGNORINA JUJON – Well out of position when the start was effected. Driver Ms J Chibnall was fined the sum of \$100, Ms Chibnall having pleaded guilty to a charge issued under the provisions of AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain her correct position until the start.

KARALTA COURAGE – Well out of position when the start was effected. Driver Mr R Hillier was fined the sum of \$100 under the provisions of AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his correct position until the start. Commenced a three wide run from mid-field approaching the 1000 metre point.

DOLLARSIGN - Well out of position when the start was effected - Continue out of the draw in mobile barrier races. Driver Ms B Miller was fined the sum of \$100, Ms Miller having pleaded guilty to a charge issued under the provisions of AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain her correct position until the start. Pulled hard throughout the middle stages of the race. Contacted a sulky of another runner and raced roughly in the front straight with a lap to travel.

RACE 3 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2200 METRES

MONDOOLEY MACH – Gave ground over the concluding stages.

HEZATOFF – Commenced to tire from the 500 metres ultimately being beaten in excess of 95 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination with no apparent abnormalities detected. HEZATOFF has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

LEFT A HURRIKANE – Led the one wide line before obtaining a one out one back trail near the 1100 metre point.

CHRIS BE QUICK – Raced three wide for the first 450 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field.

LOYOLA TRIOS – Raced three wide for the first 400 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field.

NINE DIAMONDS - Commenced to tire from the 750 metres ultimately being beaten in excess of 129 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination with no apparent abnormalities detected. NINE DIAMONDS has been stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

STORMONT STAR – Commenced a three wide run from mid-field near the 1300 metre point to take over the position leading the one wide line approaching the 1100 metre point.

PROFICIENT NZ – Commenced a three wide run from mid-field near the 850 metre point.

EL JAYS MYSTERY – Three wide one back from the 850 metre point.

DEADLY ASSASSIN – Commenced a three wide run from the rear of the field near the 1100 metre point. Three wide, two back from the 850 metre point.

RACE 4 – LEES ORCHARD STAKES – 2200 METRES

This race started approximately two and a half minutes behind the scheduled starting time due to holding for a Geelong greyhound race.

SMILE LYLE – Galloped away - placed out of the draw in standing start races.

DEVIL OF TYNE- Galloped away - placed on its last chance in the draw in standing start races.

ISLAND BLISS - Galloped away - placed on its last chance in the draw in standing start races. Led the one wide line before obtaining a one out one back trail after 500 metres.

LAKE EYRE NZ - Galloped away - placed out of the draw in standing start races. Worked forward three wide to take over the position leading the one wide line after 500 metres.

KRAFTY BOY – Commenced a three wide run from mid-field near the 1100 metre point.

ARTIFLASH – Galloped away - continue out of the draw in standing start races. Held up in the early stages of the home straight - finished strongly once clear.

CHRISTIAN JAZ NZ – Galloped away - continue out of the draw in standing start races. Three wide, two back from the 1100 metre point.

BLACK OPS - Galloped away - continue out of the draw in standing start races. Had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish – not fully tested.

COURAGEOUS KATEE - Galloped away – placed out of the draw in standing start races. Three wide three back from the 1100 metre point.

PERFECT MACH – Three wide, one back from the 1100 metre point.

RACE 5 – RARE EARTH STAKES – 1680 METRES

JACKSON NEPTUNE – Withstood an early challenge for the lead.

JO DINA – Mounted an unsuccessful challenge for the lead. Obtained a one out one back trail after 400 metres.

WANDARY MUSCAT – Raced three wide without cover for the first 600 metres prior to obtaining a three wide one back trailing position with a 1000 metres to travel.

EMJAYS BLACK CHIP – Raced three wide for the first 400 metres prior to restraining to a one out one back position.

BORDER CROSS – Worked forward three wide to take over the position leading the one wide line after 400 metres. Restrained to the position behind the leader.

MY CELEBRITY – Raced three wide for the first 400 metres before gaining a trailing position. It was noted that MY CELEBRITY dropped a shin boot near the 100 metre point.

RAINING ON RINGO NZ – Raced in a three wide, one back position for the first 450 metres before working forward four wide to take over the position leading the three wide line approaching the 1000 metre point.

THE DEAL – Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish.

VELOCITY STRIDE – Had a tendency to over race and hang out on a number of occasions during the race. Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish

SIR JUJON -. Pulled extremely hard in the middle stages of the race. Broke when checked by its driver near the 1100 metre point as the pace eased – SIR JUJON has been placed on its last chance to race truly. Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish. - untested.

PEPPERCORN SAM – Severely checked near the 1100 metre point. Three wide, three back from the 850 metre point.

RACE 6 – LONGFORD EQUINE CLINIC STAKES – 1680 METRES

KISSING GAME – Driver Mr D Ford spoken to advisedly in that he must further adjust his whip action in order to be fully compliant with the rules.

SQUATTER SHANNON –Driver Ms T Ford was counselled regarding her needing to further modify her whip action in order to be fully compliant with the rules.

TOPZAVSKI – Commenced to give ground from the 400 metres.

SHESTRYINGTACTICS – Well out of position when the start was effected - Driver Mr K Pratten reprimanded under the provisions of AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his correct position until the start. Three wide one back from the 1000 metre point. Three wide four back from the 900 metre point.

MACHAVELLI – Commenced a three wide run near the 900 metre point.

ISLAND ROCKNROLL – Held up behind a tiring runner from the 400 metre point, losing significant ground.

YELLOW TAXI NZ - Three wide one back from the 900 metre point. Accidentally locked sulky wheels with the sulky wheel of another runner for a short distance in the home straight on the final occasion.

HEAR THE CALL NZ – Accidentally locked sulky wheels with the sulky wheel of another runner for a short distance in the home straight on the final occasion.

BOOKER BAY – Commenced a three wide run from the rear of the field at the 1000 metre point. Three wide, two back from the 900 metre point. It was noted that the gelding had dropped a shin boot during the race.

General

Trainer Mr B Yole was reprimanded under the provisions of AHRR135(1) for failing to have his runners in the parade area by the designated time.

RACE 7 – NO APACHEMEE RETIREMENT CLAIMER – 2200 METRES

Two claims were lodged for KARALTA DAZZLER for \$5000. A ballot was conducted and the successful claimant was Mr B Yole of Sidmouth.

BRADS LUCK was claimed for \$7000 by Mr C Parker of Trevallyn.

TALLY OPERATOR – Stood flat footed at the start and then galloped away - placed on its last chance in the draw in standing start races.

FULL SPEED AHEAD NZ – Raced in a three back peg line trailing position until shifting out to lead the one wide line near the 1250 metre point.

KARALTA DAZZLER – Claimed. Swabbed.

BRADS LUCK – Swung sideways at the start, losing considerable ground - continue to be placed out of the draw in standing start races. The gelding gave ground from the 600 metres, beaten in excess of 166 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination with no apparent abnormalities detected. BRADS LUCK has been stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Claimed. Swabbed.
