HARNESS RACING STEWARDS REPORT

Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

Runners which had raced at Hobart on Friday July 2, 2021 underwent veterinary examinations and were passed fit to start.

RACE 1 – LAUNCESTON BELMONT – 1680 METRES

FLO JO CARVALHO – Led until surrendering the lead after 400 metres.

LORIMERTYRRELL – Worked forward from the one out line to take over the lead after 400 metres.

HIVOLTAGE GLENWOOD – Raced in four back peg line trailing position until shifting out to lead the one wide line approaching the 1000 metre point. Raced roughly for a short distance on the final turn.

CODYS LEGACY – Broke free of interference racing into the first turn then raced greenly on a number of occasions throughout the race. Having considered the filly's race record Stewards ordered that CODYS LEGACY be stood down from racing for 14 days and until the completion of two consecutive satisfactory trials. Placed back in the draw mobile barrier races.

RACE 2 – SUNRISE BAKERY STAKES – 1680 METRES

This race started approximately 5 minutes behind the schedule starting time due to a false start being declared when Shady Story broke in the score up checking other runners.

FURY DAN – Raced behind the leader until shifting out to lead the one wide line after 400 metres.

SHADY STORY – Broke in the score up checking other runners resulting in a false start being declared - placed out of the draw in mobile barrier races. Held up for clear running until the latter stages of the home straight – finished strongly/not fully tested.

BUDVAR EYRE NZ – Commenced to give ground from the 450 metres. Checked by a galloping runner on the final turn.

VONNS ANGEL – Led the one wide line until obtaining one out one back trail after 450 metres.

MONTANA STORM NZ – Commenced a three wide run from towards the rear of the field approaching the 1000 metre point.

GOPATI NZ – Tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 160 metres. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination of the gelding which revealed it to have suffered a cardiac arrhythmia. Acting under the provisions of AHRR101C (2)(a) GOPATI NZ is stood down from racing for 14 days and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. A veterinary certificate which includes an ECG report will need to be submitted prior to the gelding being eligible to trial.

DYSLEXIC NZ – Was out of position when the start was effected - will continue to be placed out of draw in mobile barrier races. Three wide two back from the 1000 metre point. Broke free of interference near the 350 metres - placed on its last chance to race truly.

DOLLARSIGN – Three wide from one back from the 1000 metre point. Placed back in the draw in mobile barrier races.

LORD BAZALUP – Tired over the concluding stage to be beaten in excess of 61 metres - placed on its last chance to race competitively. Will be placed out of the draw (ODM) in mobile barrier races rather than right out of the draw (RODM) in mobile barrier races.

RACE 3 – MUSTAD AUSTRALIA PACE – 2200 METRES

BALDASARRE – Led the one wide line until obtaining a one out one back trail after 450 metres.

OUR RAINBOW BLUE – Raced three wide for the first 400 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field.

WHO SAID YOU SAID – Raced three wide in the first 400 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field. Tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 60 metres. Three wide one back from 950 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. On veterinary advice WHO SAID YOU SAID is stood down from racing until a veterinary certificate is submitted.

TACTIC STRIDE – Broke free of interference approaching the 2000 metre point. Worked forward three wide whilst severely over racing to take over the position leading the one wide line approaching the 1600 metre point. Choked down and fell near the 1200 metre point. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered a cardiac arrhythmia. On veterinary advice TACTIC STRIDE is stood down from racing for 14 days and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. A veterinary certificate which includes an ECG report will need to be submitted prior to the gelding being eligible to trial.

IDEN DELIGHT – Raced roughly in the latter stages of the score up and again raced roughly shortly after start was effected - will continue to be placed out of the draw in the mobile barrier races. Commenced a three wide run from midfield approaching the 1000 metre point.

VIN DAN – Broke approaching the 2000 metre point, having considered the colts recent race record Stewards ordered that VIN DAN be stood down from racing for 14 days and until the completion of two consecutive satisfactory trials. The gelding has been placed back in the draw in mobile barrier races.

RACE 4 – TRAINERS ENCOURAGEMENT PACE – 1680 METRES

SEA SKY – Declared a late scotching on veterinary advice at 6:05 PM.

MAJOR DAVVIN – Commenced a three wide run from midfield near the 1000 metre point.

WANDARY MUSCAT – Led the one wide line until obtaining a one out one back position near the 1100 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination at the request of trainer Wesley Targett resulting in no significant findings.

STEPPING STONES – Raced three wide until working forward to take over the position leading the one wide line near the 1100 metres.

BOULDER CITY – Led then gave ground over the concluding stages.

SOMEHOWSOMEWAY – Three wide one back from the 1000 metre point. Driver, Mr Paul Williams, was fined \$200, Mr Williams having pleaded guilty to a charge issued under provisions of AHRR156(2)(a) in that in the home straight on the final occasion he utilised his whip with more than a wrist only flicking motion with force generated from his elbow.

BRIGHTON PRINCE – Three wide two back from the 1000 metre point.

SMILE LYLE – Held up for clear running until the latter stages of the home straight. - finished strongly once clear.

ROWLEY NZ – Three wide three back from the 1000 metre point.

RACE 5 – ELDERS INSURANCE LAUNCESTON STAKES – 2200 METRES

RANIERI NZ – Held up for clear running until the latter stages of the home straight - finished strongly once clear.

KADAR – Raced three wide for the first 400 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field.

TAURISI – Had difficulty obtaining a clear run to the finish – not fully tested.

AHA REACTION NZ – Broke in the score up and out of position when the start was effected – placed out of the draw in mobile barrier races. Pulled hard throughout the middle stages of the race. Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish – untested.

CARDINAL RINGO – Commenced a three wide run from midfield near the 1100 metres.

EARL JUJON – Three wide one back from the 1100 metres.

SOMEDAN – Three wide two back from the 1100 metres.

HEZA BROMAC NZ – Placed back in the draw in mobile barrier races.

RACE 6 – CARLTON DRAUGHT FREE FOR ALL – 2200 METRES

BLACK OPS – Led the one wide line and until a one out one back trail near the 1400 metre point.

RACKETEERS BOY NZ – Led then gave ground in the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 39 metres. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination of the gelding which failed to reveal any apparent abnormalities. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding, trainer Mr T Hillier told the Stewards that he was not overly disappointed with the run, given that the gelding was not suited by the early speed that the gelding had to show to maintain the lead. Mr Hillier went on to tell the Stewards that he would be getting an analysis done on the gelding's blood, in order to ascertain whether all is well with the gelding. Hung in and contacted a marker peg whilst giving ground entering home straight on the final occasion- a warning was issued.

BLACKBIRD POWER – Raced in four back peg line position until shifting out to lead the one wide line near the 1400 metre point.

ILLEGAL IMMIGRANT NZ – A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. When questioned regarding the gelding's performance, trainer Mr Troy Hillier told the stewards that he was extremely disappointed with its run and that he will be having blood taken on the gelding for analysis to investigate whether something may be amiss with the gelding.

RACE 7 – 4YO / 5YO CLASSIC – 2200 METRES

AUSSIE ROCK – Withstood in early for challenge for the lead.

MONTANA LAD NZ – Mounted an unsuccessful early challenge for the lead whilst withstanding an early challenge for the position leading the one wide line.

YORKSHIRE NZ – Raced three wide for the first 350 metres whilst mounting an unsuccessful three wide challenge for a more forward position then restrained to a one back position. Had a tendency to over race

throughout the middle stages of the race. When questioned regarding the performance of YORKSHIRE NZ, driver Mr Rodney Ashwood told the Stewards that he felt the gelding may have been a little disappointing however, he went on to say that this was a superior class of race to those in which the horse had been competing. He added that in this race YORKSHIRE NZ was not well suited when unable to take up the leading position which it had done in its previous three starts.

THE SHALLOWS – Commenced a three wide run from the rear of the field near the 1100 metre point. Dropped in to a one out one back position near the 800 metres.

RACE 8 – CROWN LAGER PACE – 1680 METRES

SPORTS CANDY – Which led then shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish. Driver Mr Connor Cook was fined \$100 under the provisions of AHR162(1)(www) for allowing SPORTS CANDY to shift out in the run to the finish which advantaged another runner.

PINK PONDER – Raced three wide for the first 450 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field. Over raced throughout the middle stages of the race.

BETTER AMOUR – Obtained an inside run to the finish.

BRIAN WHO – Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish – untested.

MACHS MARETA NZ – Raced three wide for the first 450 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field. Commenced the three wide run from towards the rear of the field near 1100 metres.

PERFECT MACH – Three wide one back from the 1100 metre point.

ENDEAVOUR STRIDE – Three wide two back from 1100 metre point.

THE DUDE NZ – Was held up for clear running until the latter stages of the home straight - finished strongly once clear – not fully tested.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES RACING CENTRE STAKES – 2200 METRES

RICHMOND TIGER NZ – Withstood an early challenge for the lead.

IDEN GORGEOUS – Mounted an unsuccessful early challenge for the lead and then obtained a one out one back trail after 400 metres. Commenced a three wide run from one out one back near the 950 metre point.

IDEAL KARALTA – Worked forward three take over the position leading the one wide line after 400 metres.

ONEOFTHELADS – Three wide one back from the 1100 metre point. Three wide two back from 950 metre point.

EMJAYS BLACK CHIP – Commenced a three wide run from towards the rear of the field approaching the 1100 metre point. Three wide one back from the 950 metres.

HEZ RAZOR SHARP – Held out for clear running until the latter stages of the home straight - finished strongly once clear.

RAINING ON RINGO NZ – Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish – untested.
