Victorian riders were unavailable due to COVID 19 restrictions.

P Lui was indisposed fro medical reasons.

Broadway Babe, Trainer S Brunton was fined \$100 for the late rider alteration due to M Ulucinar being a dual engagement.

RACE 1 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BENCHMARK 74 HCP – 1400 METRES

Rising Hsiang (C Jordan) – Raced fiercely in the early stages.

RACE 2 – LEVENDI STANDING AT BROADMARSH STUD 2021 BENCHMARK 74 HCP – 1200 METRES

Don'tBuckme Off (C Jordon) – Stewards queried, trainer C Jordon, on the below market expectations performance. C Jordon stated that, Don'tbuckme Off failed to finish off over the concluding stages of the race was also up in class today. Trainer, J Luttrell stated that Don'tbuckme Off will be spelled.

Gympins NZ (G Catania) – Slow to begin. Approaching 150 metre mark, elected to take an inside run behind Jeremiah, which then rolled in slightly, resulting in G Catania having to shift out to obtain a run to it's outside.

RACE 3 – THE MILLS NEW NORFOLK MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Prince of Passion declared a late scratching at 12.03pm as there was no available rider. No deductions were ordered.

She Decides (E Byrne Burke) – declared a late scratching at 1.01pm on veterinary advice after dislodging the rider in the preliminary before being captured then breaking free and galloping for a considerable distance. E Byrne Burke was examined by the Medical Officers and declared fit to fulfill her remaining engagements. All monies invested on She Decides were ordered to be refunded in full with deductions on successful wagers of 9 cents for the win and 10 cents the place.

Hampton Bay (B Muhcu) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered atrial fibrillation and it will now be stood down to a completion of a 1000 metre gallop, satisfactory ECG and Veterinary Certificate.

Broadway Babe (M Ulucinar) – Stood flatfooted and missed the start by approximately four lengths. A warning has been placed on the starting manners of this mare. Over raced in the early stages of the event. Layed in over the concluding stages.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES BET TICKER BENCHMARK 60 HCP– 1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed by 3 minutes due to a hurdle race at Coleraine running late.

Freak On A Lead (B Louis) – Blundered on jumping and lost ground.

Fitzwilliam (I Luximon) –carried wider by Ghosted near the 500 metres. Fitzwilliam then rolled wider on the home turn and raced wide in the home straight. Apprentice , I Luximon believed that the gelding did not handle the track conditions today.

Luca Bratzi (G Catania) – Steadied off heels near the 800 metres and commenced over race. Steadied in the home straight by its rider when inconvenienced by Strategic Agenda near the 100 metres when that mare shifted ground outward marginally. T Baker was advised exercise more care when shifting ground.

Strategic Agenda (T Baker) Layed out near the 100 metres.

Kel's Star (M Ulucinar) –slow to begin (2L).

Zagame NZ (B Muhcu) – Shifted out abruptly on jumping.

RACE 5 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS MDN/CL1 – 1600 METRES

Little Hot Missile – Declared a late scratching at 12.03 as there was no available rider. No deductions ordered.

Zegrey (B Louis) – Slow to muster early speed. Over raced in the early stages of the back straight.

Encosta Toronado (M Ulucinar) – Slow to begin.

The Executive (G Catania) – Raced wide throughout.

Auntie Florrie (I Luximon) – Stewards questioned the tactics on Auntie Florrie, when that mare raced on the pace today. Trainer, B McShane, stated they had instructed that she not be pushed out in the early stages, however, from the inside barrier she began to race keenly and took up a position further forward than intended. His explanation was noted.

RACE 6 – HYGAIN BENCHMARK 66HCP– 1600 METRES

The start of this race was delayed by approximately 12 minutes, due to a participant being injured in the race day stalls requiring treatment by the ambulance officers.

Flourishing Future (I Luximon) –Raced fiercely in the early stages.

Nev's Boy (C Jordan) – Stewards queried apprentice Cody Jordon on the apparent disappointing performance Nev's Boy today. She believed that the gelding may not have appreciated the extra distance at this stage of its preparation. Trainer J Luttrell confirmed that the gelding will now be spelled.

Dunmining (T Baker) – Slow in the stride (1L). T Baker reported Dunmining hung in for the majority of the home straight. As a result, he was unable to ride his mount out fully. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 7 – AVRIL KELLY KITTY KAT KUP CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

John's Lad (C Jordon) – Shifted wide at the 500 metres to obtain clear running.

Punk Princess (I Luximon) – Ianish Luximon pleaded guilty to charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii), in that he used the whip 10 times prior to the 100 metres, which was twice the permitted limit. After taking consideration, his submissions on penalty, his recent good record, and the totality of his whip use, stewards issued a fine of \$400.00.

Seguimentos (T Baker) – Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 8 – Kevin Sharkie BM 60 HCP– 2100 METRES

Costero (I Luximon) –Crowded at the start.

Dixie's Boy (E Byrne Burke) – Jumped inwards at the start, tightening Hunch, then shifted in further tightening, Costero.

Hunch (D Pires) –tightened on jumping.

Uncovered (B Muhcu) –Slow to begin.

Licensed trainers A Fulton and P Luttrell were cautioned under AR 228 on their social media comments regarding I Luximon's riding future in Tasmania.

An inquiry into trainer B McShane's comments on social media was adjourned to a date to be fixed.
