Comments / Explanations:

G McCulloch's explanation for the late rider notification was accepted.

RACE 1 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN BENCHMARK 74HCP – 1880 METRES

Galway Girl (E Byrne Burke) – Shifted out making the 1200 metre turn and raced wide from that point on. Bumped by Dargo, approaching the 600 metre mark.

Up Wind (B Louis) – Stewards advised, apprentice B Louis, that he must ensure he rides his mounts fully to the line when in contention.

Dargo (S Carr) –Bumped at the start by Captain Morgan (NZ).

Odin's Folly NZ (G Catania) – Hung out approaching the 600 metre turn and tightened Dargo, which then shifted ground outwards, bumping with Galway Girl.

Captain Morgan NZ (B Muhcu) – Shifted out on jumping and bumped with Dargo.

Uncovered (I Luximon) – Slow to begin.

RACE 2 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1150 METRES

Artuso (P Lui) – Slow to begin then commenced to race keenly shortly after the start. When P Lui was queried on the tactics adopted today, he stated that he was unable to restrain his mount in the early stages due to his saddle slipping forward and placing him at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.

Need A Gin (D Ganderton) –Trainer reported when questioned that after being tested in the home straight D Ganderton had felt something amiss with the horses action. He also stated that the time run in todays event was faster than the gelding previous win and this may have been a contributing factor

in the below market expectations performance. A veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Vivilici (E Byrne Burke) – Passed pre race veterinary examination after suffering an abrasion to the off hind canon. Over raced in the middle stages. Approaching the 100 metres, Vivilici, which was hanging in, shifted ground inward bumping with Trojan Storm. Vivilici continued to hang in for the remainder of the event. E Byrne Burke was advised that she is to stop and straighten her mount sooner than she had done on this occasion.

Gee Gee Goldenlass (S Carr) – Lost near fore plate.

Trojan Storm (I Toker) – Bumped approaching 100 metre mark.

Rhyme Writer (C Jordan) – Raced keenly in the early stages and then elected to restrain when Artuso commenced to over race and crossed to the rail.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES 3YO MADEN – 1150 METRES

Start of this event was delayed one minute due to Coleraine running late.

Silleact (B Muhcu) – Had to be checked off heels approaching the 600 metres, when the pace eased.

Warica (C Jordan) – Raced greenly in the early stages of the event.

Crystal Eclipse (T Doyle) – Bumped with Khari on jumping when that filly shifted out. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Gee Gee Snowflake (P Lui) – Steadied off the heels of Silleact approaching the 600 metre turn. Shifted wider on the home turn to obtain clear running to the outside of Crystal Eclipse. Stewards advised P Lui, there had been a clear run to its inside and that his preferred option would have been to take this run. Hung in near the 200 metre mark.

Khari (G Catania) – Stumbled on jumping. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4 – CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES MAIDEN – 1009 METRES

Gee Royal Swan (T Doyle) – Compounded over the concluding stages.

Lord Whitegate (C Jordan) – Shifted out on jumping. Over raced in the early stages and hung out making the 600 metre turn.

Velino (S Carr) – Shifted out on jumping, bumping with Mystical Vixon. Raced wide throughout. Passing the 200 metres, shifted in under pressure, tightening the running of Sweetsop, before being corrected by its rider.

Golden Egg (I Luximon) –Fractious in the barriers. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration behind its left ear. Stewards spoke to the starter about the manners of Golden Egg in the barriers, when I Luximon reported to stewards that the horse had become fractious and hit its head. Starter G Armstrong explained that the horse got its head down in the gates, however it was not observed or reported to have hit its head, therefore was not subject to a pre-race veterinary examination. Stewards noted their comments.

Shammgod NZ (G Catania) – Hung out marginally making the 600 metre turn.

Soulita (B Louis) – Declared a late scratching at 10:59, due to trainer S Berger having difficulties processing the scratching online.

The following betting deductions were ordered:

Sweetsop (1st) – 0 cents a win & 3 cents a place

Velino (2nd) – 8 cents a place

Lord Whitegate (3rd) – 5 cents a place

Sweetsop (I Toker) – Tightened near the 200 metre mark, when Velino shifted in.

Warrior Lass (M Ulucinar) – Slow to begin and then failed to muster any early speed, tailed the event in the early stages.

RACE 5 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – 1650 METRES

Encosta Toronado (P Lui) – Slow to begin. Over raced leaving the front straight on the first occasion.

The Executive (G Catania) – Shifted out on jumping, bumping with Di's A Dancer. Bumped with Di's A Dancer shortly after the start.

Di's A Dancer (C Jordan) – Bumped by The Executive and shifted out on jumping. Hung in in the home straight.

Our Rossa (T Doyle) – Compounded in the home straight. Stewards have issued a warning for the mares poor performance.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 60HCP – 1650 METRES

Elisavet (P Lui) –Jumped awkwardly and shifted out after the start.

High Maintenance (C Jordan) –Tightened at the start by Geegees First Lady which had been carried out.

Red Fiore (I Luximon) –Shifted out on jumping and bumped Geegees First Lady. Commenced to over race when being restrained near the 1300 metres and shifted out inconveniencing Geegees First Lady.

Iskra (I Toker) – Held up for clear running near the 300 metres.I Toker was reprimanded under AR131(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish.

Geegees First Lady (D Parish) –Bumped on jumping by Red Fiore. Inconvenienced near the 1300 metres.

RACE 7 – THAI IMPERIAL BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1350 METRES

Sanction King (B Louis) – Apprentice, B Louis was reprimanded under AR131(b) for failing to ride his mount out to the finish.

Cheeky One (E Byrne Burke) – Shifted in under pressure approaching the winning post.

Georgian Chant NZ (C Jordan) – Slow into stride.

Banca Nip (I Toker) – Slow into stride.

Hot Relation (G Catania) – Brushed by Cheeky One approaching the winning post when that mare shifted in.

Lady Joker (D Parish) – Slow into stride.

RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1009 METRES

Kwai (C Jordan) – When questioned on the performance today C Jordan stated that the mare was having her first start since June and she blew considerably on pulling up.

Gee Gees Goldlogie (M Ulucinar) – Was slow to muster speed and then tailed the field throughout, to be beaten a considerable distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stewards have stood the gelding down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

Miss Tuppence (E Byrne Burke) – Raced wide throughout, until obtaining a position close to the rail near the 550 metre mark. Stewards questioned apprentice, E Byrne Burke on the below market expectations performance of Miss Tuppence. She stated that from a wide barrier she was unable to gain a favourable position. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Gee Gee Acehigh (D Parish) – Raced three wide throughout.
