Comments / Explanations:

J Blacker's explanation for the late rider declaration was accepted.

RACE 1 – YOUNG RACING TASMANIA OPEN HCP – 1350 METRES

The Inevitable (E Byrne Burke) – Slow to muster early speed. Bumped by Fragment near the 200 metres, which had rolled out then layed in from the 200 metres.

Ruettiger NZ (S Carr) – Over raced in the early stages. Was obliged to steady off heels near the 400 metres.

Fragment (C Jordan) – Over raced in the early and middle stages and was caught wide throughout. Bumped The Inevitable when laying out near the 200 metres.

Ethical Dilemma (B Muhcu) – Shifted wider on the track to obtain a clear run near the 400-metres momentarily tightening the running of Ruettiger. B Muhcu was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

RACE 2 – LENDING 4 U BENCHMARK 74 HCP – 1650 METRES

Up Wind (B Louis) – Slow to muster early speed. Layed in over the concluding stages. Stewards queried Apprentice, B Louis, on his tactics in the early middle stages. Mr Louis stated that he rode the gelding in a similar manner than he had done when he won on it on the 11th July 2021. He also believed the pace was high at the front of the race and he rode his mount to ensure that he get the best out of it as it only had a short sprint. Stewards noted his explanation.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Velino (S Carr) – Rider reported that she had difficulty with the gelding hanging out on the home turn. She believed that the bit had slipped through the horse's mouth.

Apollo Landing (B Muhcu) – Slow to muster early speed.

Golden Egg (G Catania) – Approaching the 150-metre, Golden Egg laid in under pressure. Compounded passing the 200-metre mark. The rider reported that the mare had made a respiratory noise in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a respiratory issue. A veterinary certificate, including the results of a dynamic scope examination will be required prior to its next start.

Sirocco Shamal (D Ganderton) – Shifted in under pressure passing the 200 meters.

Warrior Lass (M Ulucinar) – Stood flat footed at the start and was very slow to begin. Stewards issued a warning on the mares starting manners.

Gee Gee Snowflake (P Lui) – Shifted in abruptly away from the heels of Golden Egg near the 150-metre mark.

RACE 4 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – 1350 METRES

Arapaho Chief (T Baker) – Caught wide throughout and compounded over the concluding stages to be beaten a considerable distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities. Stewards have issued a warning on the poor performance of this gelding today.

Gold Gown (T Doyle) – Raced wide throughout.

French Kiss (C Jordan) – Raced three wide and hung out on the home turn.

RACE 5 – KEVIN SHARKIE MDN/CL1 – 1880 METRES

Karnak Kid (B Muhcu) – Caught wide in the early and middle stages before working forward to the lead.

Red Roger (D Ganderton) – Shifted out passing the 200-metres to obtain a clear run when Zegrey layed in under pressure.

Tassie O'Reilly NZ (B Louis) – Steadied off the heels of Karnak Kid passing the 800-metres, shifted out abruptly bumping with Sienna's Word. B Louis advised that in future he should endeavour to restrain back off heels and not allow his mount to shift out.

Zegrey (M Ulucinar) – Shifted out on jumping, bumped with Signal Hill. Zegrey from its wide barrier, was unable to take up a position further back in the field and the rider elected to work forward to the lead. Stewards spoke to trainer J Blacker, on the tactics adopted today and he explained that the gelding got further back than anticipated in its previous start. He had expected it to be further forward today, however, he did not believe that it would lead. Stewards noted his explanation.

Bullock NZ (P Lui) – Shifted in on jumping, bumping Red Roger.

Signal Hill (E Byrne Burke) – Raced wide throughout and passing the 800 metres bumped with Sienna's Word.

Sienna's Word (T Baker) – Raced three wide throughout, bumped heavily with Tassie O'Reilly NZ passing the 800 metres when Karnak Kid crossed the rail and the pace eased.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1650 METRES

Needarein (S Carr) – Slow to begin, held up for a clear run approaching the 200-metres between Submit Another and Wardell before shifting back to the inside to obtain clear running.

Submit Another (E Byrne Burke) – Raced three wide without cover.

Dunmining (T Baker) – Stumbled on jumping and shifted out. Over raced in the early stages, held up for clear running near the 400-metres.

San You (B Muhcu) – Momentarily inconvenienced by Needarein when rider, S Carr, shifted in to obtain clear running. S Carr was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

Sizzkye (P Lui) – Slow to begin.

Jack's Choice (T Doyle) – Slow to begin.

RACE 7 – CARLTON AND UNITED BREWERIES CLASS 1 HCP – 1350 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when the rider of the third placed horse, Gee Gee Can Win (D.Ganderton), wished to view the official film with regard to lodging the protest. After doing so, the protest was lodged against the winner, Has The Look(B.Louis), alleging interference near the 200-metre mark. After taking evidence from all parties and viewing the official films, Stewards were of the opinion that the interference suffered exceeded the margin at the finish therefore upheld the protest. Judges places were amended accordingly. At a subsequent inquiry B Louis (Has The Look) was found guilty of a charge under AR 131(a) Careless Riding for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 200 metres when not clear of Gee Gee Can Win resulting in that gelding losing its rightful running, clipping heels and being severely checked. B Louis licence to ride in races has been suspended for two Tasmanian race dates from midnight 29 August 2021 to midnight 12 September 2021. In assessing penalty Stewards took into consideration his record under the rule, the high level of interference suffered and the effect on the race results.

Gee Gee Can Win (D Ganderton) – Checked and clipped heels near the 200-metre mark when Has The Look shifted in when not clear.

Has The Look (B Louis) – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight near the 200-metre mark checking Gee Gee Can Win.

Port Berry NZ (P Lui) – Trainer advised change of tactics to be ridden further forward. The tactics could not be complied with as the mare was slow to muster early speed and raced back in the field thereafter.

RACE 8 – THAI IMPERIAL 0-66 – 1350 METRES

Mywordis (B Louis) – Caught wide throughout and over raced. Shifted out marginally on the home turn.

Banca Nip (I Toker) – Slow to begin. Correct weight was delayed for this race when rider of Banca Nip (dead heat 1st) wished to view the film, with regard to lodging a protest. After doing so a protest against Mywordis (dead heat 1st) was lodged, alleging interference on the home turn. After taking evidence and viewing the official films, stewards believe that the interference was negligible when Mywordis rolled out when Banca Nip was following, therefore the protest was dismissed.

Raay Of Time (D Parish) – Late scratching at 2:24pm by order of Stewards on veterinary advice as the mare had been injured on route to the racecourse. Raay Of Time has been stood down to a veterinary certificate prior to racing again. The following deductions were ordered:

Mywordis (1st) – 0 cents a win & 6cents a place

Banca Nip (1st) – 0 cents a win 4 cents a place

Reward Achiever (3rd) – 2 cents a place
