Comments / Explanations:

Explanation accepted for the late declaration of I Toker in race 1.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES EASY FORM MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Bell Ringer Boy – Late scratching at 12:38pm due to there being no available rider. The following deductions were ordered:

Need to Be Unique (1st) – 1 cent a win & 1 cent a place.

Soulita (2nd) – 4 cents a place.

Eight Margaritas (3rd) – 4 cents a place.

Belmista (G Catania) – Raced fiercely and shifted out near the 700 metre mark, bumping with Labby Rock. Shifted out entering the home straight and bumped with Our Sonny Boy.

Need To Be Unique (D Pires) – Layed in under pressure from the 150 metre mark until the winning post.

Sensational Chi (T Doyle) – Raced wide throughout.

Labby Rock (D Ganderton) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it hadn't raced for 12 months and was passed fit to compete. Inconvenienced near the 700 metre mark, when Belmista commenced to over race and shifted out, bumping with that mare. Had to be steadied off the heels of Belmista approaching the 550 metre mark. Shifted wider on the track on the home turn to obtain a clear run.

Soulita (B Muhcu) – Shifted out on jumping, bumping with Maywyn Is The Word.

Etosha (D Parish) – Hung out throughout the event and was hampered in the final 100 metres when Needs To Be Unique hung in on several occasions.

Pop A Honda (T Baker) – Slow to begin.

Our Sonny Boy (P Lui) – Bumped when Belmista shifted wider on the track at the home turn. Layed in at the 300 metre mark.

Miss Red (I Luximon) – Raced three wide without cover.

Maywyn Is The Word (E Byrne Burke) – Raced greenly in the early and middle stages.

RACE 2 – TASMANIAN EQUINE DENTISTRY BENCHMARK 74HCP – 1880 METRES

Up Wind (B Louis) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin, shifted out to obtain clear running making the home turn carrying Wineglass Bay wider on the track. As a result, Costero had to be steadied off the heels of Wineglass Bay. B Louis was reprimanded under AR 131(a) for careless riding for carrying Wineglass Bay wider on the track when not clear to do so. Layed in near the 100 metre mark.

Dixie's Boy (E Byrne Burke) – Over raced in the early stages, brushed by Red Fiore which layed out entering the home straight.

Red Fiore (P Lui) – Raced three wide in the middle stages to take up the position outside the leader. Red Fiore layed out on the home turn and entering the home straight, brushing with Dixie's Boy.

Costero (T Baker) – Steadied off the heels of Wineglass Bay on the home turn.

Wineglass Bay (I Luximon) – Carried wider on the home turn by Up Wind.

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP MDN/CL1 – 1880 METRES

Sizzkye (T Doyle) – Slow to begin.

Tassie Miss (E Byrne Burke) – Jumped awkwardly and shifted in.

Tiny Timmy (B Louis) – Layed in under pressure in the home straight.

Luce Della Luna (I Luximon) – Was tightened between Captain Morgan, which shifted out and Sienna's Word, which shifted in on jumping, then bumped with Captain Morgan and lost ground. Luce Della Luna was unable to take up a position further forward in the field.

Who's The Rider (G Catania) – Rider, G Catania, reported that the mare layed in throughout today's event and did not respond to her riding from the 600 metre mark. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1650 METRES

Irish Shotgun NZ (G Catania) – Layed out on the home turn.

Northern Spirit (T Baker) – Carried wider on the home turn by Irish Shotgun. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor abrasion to the mouth.

Spihro (B McCoull) – Veterinary clearance received to race as a 12 year old with stewards permission. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to compete. Raced three wide in the early stages.

Dunmining (D Parish) – Tightened on jumping when Irish Shotgun NZ shifted out and Turk Delight shifted in.

RACE 5 – DEAN RAWLINGS SENIOR MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1009 METRES

The start of this race was delayed approximately 1 minute due to a mainland race running late.

Le Cadeau (D Ganderton) – Slow to begin.

Trojan Storm (T Stalker) – Slow to begin. Rider reported that its below market expectations performance may been due to coming back from 1150 metres to 1009 metres and also that the extra pace did not suit the gelding. Trainer C Thompson stated the gelding may not have backed up from last weeks race.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP – 1350 METRES

Freelancer (D Ganderton) – Caught wide in the early stages.

The Beekeeper (E Byrne Burke) – Jumped awkwardly and shifted out.

So I'm Dreaming (P Lui) – Bumped at the start by Boss Cheyenne.

Boss Cheyenne (B Muhcu) – Checked shortly after the start when The Beekeeper shifted out on jumping and carried that mare outwards until it bumped with So I'm Dreaming.

Hampton Street (G Catania) – Rider reported that her whip had broken rounding the home turn.

RACE 7 – THAI IMPERIAL BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1350 METRES

Gee Gee Plane (T Baker) – Layed in under pressure over the concluding stages.

GENERAL

Stewards opened and adjourned an inquiry today into an incident at the Spreyton Racecourse. This occurred on September 4 2021. Evidence was taken from licenced participants Miss H Van Dongen and Mr L O'Shannessey.
