Blue Pelle underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. It's A Wonder underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Stewards spoke to trainer representative Mr E Medhurst in relation to It's A Wonder's race manners over the concluding stages. Acting on their own observations and viewing the official replays, Stewards were of the opinion that It's A Wonder had turned it's head inwards and made head or muzzle contact with Max Surprise and by doing so had marred the running of that greyhound pursuant to GAR 69(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(2)(a), It's A Wonder has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days Devonport only and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.
