### **RACE 1 – CITY OF LAUNCESTON MAIDEN – 1400 METRES**

**Aussie Warrior** (D Pires) – When queried on the below market expectation performance of the gelding D Pires stated that after travelling well Aussie Warrior failed to respond to his riding from the 500 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed minor soreness in the lower back muscles.

**Cashmore** (I Luximon) – Jumped awkwardly and shifted out at the start and lost ground. Raced wide throughout.

**Willow Wood** (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride.

**Bynance** (D Ganderton) – Shifted outwards on jumping. Shifted wider at 500 metres carrying Sh'bourne De Lago wider on the track.

**Glavya Onice** (D Parish) –Bumped at the start when Bynance shifted out.

**Pop A Honda** (T Baker) - Fractious in the barriers, Trainer C Thompson was cautioned on the gelding's manners. Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

**Sh'Bourne De Lago** (B Louis) – Raced three wide in the early stages. Carried wider near the 500 metres when Bynance shifted wider on the track.

### **RACE 2 – LADBROKES MAIDEN – 1200 METRES**

**Brazen Guy** (P Lui) – Inconvenienced at the start between Romary, which shifted out and Hobart, which shifted in. Checked behind Gee Gee Snowflake passing the 500 metres and shifted out and bumping with Hobart, which became unbalanced. Brazen Guy then shifted back in behind the heels of Gee Gee Snowflake and had to be checked again by its rider. Apprentice, Peter Lui was advised that he must

exercise better judgement than he had done on this occasion when endeavouring to improve his position and far greater care when restraining his mount.

**Sushi Express** (M Ulucinar) – Was bumped at the start by Rich Clan which shifted out. Raced wide throughout.

**Auntie Florrie** (I Luximon) –Hampered at the start when bumped by Shushi Express and obliged to race back in the field.

**Meigetsu** (I Toker) – Jumped outwards at the start. Compounded entering the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

**Nufen Special** (B Louis) –Inconvenienced by Meigetsu, which jumped outwards at the start.

**Romary** (C Jordan) – Jumped outwards at the start, inconveniencing Brazen Guy. Shifted out under pressure near the 100 metres resulting in Auntie Florrie having to be steadied and shift wider at this point. C Jordan was reprimanded under AR 131(a) for careless riding.

**Van D'Oro** (T Baker) – Jumped outwards at the start bumping with Rich Clan, which was carried out onto Sushi Express.

**Rich Clan** (D Pires) –Bumped by Van D'Oro at the start.

**Spelling Bee** (S Carr) – Race three wide throughout.

**Gee Gee Enuf Speed** (S So) –Checked on the home turn when it was held up for a clear run behind the tiring Meigetsu. Gee Gee Enuf Speed then shifted out and bumped with Nufen Special, which became unbalanced. Scarlet So was advised, in similar circumstances, she should endeavour to restrain and maintain her line.

**Hobart** (D Parish) –Bumped and became unbalanced when Brazen Guy shifted out near the 400 metres. Held up for a clear run behind Spelling Bee entering the home straight.

### **RACE 3 – BOOK NOW FOR YOUR XMAS FUNCTION CLASS 1HCP - 1200 METRES**

The start of this event was delay by approximately 3 minutes, when Fun N' Frolic was a late scratching at 7:10pm, when it got its head under the front gates and broke through before being recaptured. Subsequently the mare was scratched by the club's veterinary surgeon. Fun N' Frolic has been stood down to a veterinary certificate of soundness and a satisfactory barrier trial before racing again

The following deductions on the late scratching were ordered:

Rich Clan (1<sup>st</sup>) - 2 cents a win & 2 cents a pace

Romary (2<sup>nd</sup>) - 2 cents a place

The Poodle (3<sup>rd</sup>) - 2 cents a place

**Ubriaco** (C Jordan) – Had to be checked near the 50 metre mark, when held up for a clear run behind Tidal.

**Gee Gee Can Win** (D Ganderton) –Slow to begin, which resulted in it racing further back in the field.

**Geegeeluckystar** (I Toker) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

**Apollo Rocket** (T Baker) – Bumped approaching the winning post, when Lady obtained a tight inside run, then shifted out, tightening its running.

**Tally Mo** (I Luximon) –Shifted in after the start bumping Mrs Whitten. Shifted in under pressure approaching the 50 metre mark and had to be corrected by its rider.

**Lady** (T Stalker) – Obtained an extremely tight run passing the 100 metre mark to inside of Apollo Rocket. Brushed with Apollo Rocket and then laid out over the concluding stages. Apprentice, Tayah

Stalker, was reprimanded for careless riding under AR 131(a) for taking a run where there was insufficient room and allowing her to mount to shift ground over the concluding stages.

#### **RACE 4 – THE EXAMINER BENCHMARK 62 HCP– 1200 METRES**

**Gregorian Chant NZ** (C Jordan) –Layed out rounding the home turn.

**Gee Gee Josie** (E Byrne Burke) – Slow to begin and raced three wide.

**Perkins** (B Louis) – Blundered at the start and lost ground.

**Gee Gee Ladybird** (I Luximon) – Was slow to begin, raced four wide in the early stages and then three wide in the middle stages.

#### **RACE 5 – RF FERGUSSON MEMEORIAL CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES**

**Dark Wanderer** (T Johnstone) – Bumped with Vallabar on jumping. Near the 450 metres laid in momentarily, tightening the running of Le Cadeau. T Johnstone was advised to exercise more care when her mounts shift ground.

**Gee Gee Lanett** (I Toker) – Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a respiratory sound with suspected discharge in the trachea, however no veterinary stand down was recommended.

**Boom Dot Com** (C Jordan) – Raced three wide in the early stages.

**Le Cadeau** ( B Muhcu) – Had to be steadied momentarily when tightened by Dark Wanderer near the 450 metres.

**Apriano** (S So) – Bumped with Boom Dot Com on jumping. Apriano hung out throughout the event.

#### **RACE 6 – Carlton & United Breweries MDN/CL1 – 1200 METRES**

**Captain Morgan NZ** (B Muhcu) –Brushed with Steer For Lady entering the home straight.

**One Lotto** (D Pires) – Jumped out at the start and bumped with Hampton Street. Over raced near the 1600 metres when restrained.

**The Guilty Party** (B Louis) – Shifted out near the 1000 metre mark to a three wide position and commenced to over race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery rate. Rider reported that the gelding over raced and changed strides throughout the race.

**Catalanic** (P Lui) – Was slow to begin and muster early speed.

**Southern Wind** (S Carr) – Bumped with Steer For Lady leaving the home straight on the first occasion.

**Sienna's Word** (D Parish) – Shifted out at the start bumping with Bullock NZ.

**Steer For Lady** (T Baker) – Bumped with Southern Wind leaving the home straight on the first occasion. Brushed with Captain Morgan(NZ) entering the home straight.

#### **RACE 7 – DULUX & INSPIRATIONS PAINT BENCHMARK 62 HCP– 1400 METRES**

**Hot Relation** (D Pires) – When queried on the below market expectations performance, David Pires reported the strong pace of the race and the handicapping weight may have been factors in his mount failing to run on from the 500 metre mark. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**Gee Gee Goldenlass** (C Jordan) – Slow to begin.

**Iskra** (T Stalker) – Shifted out on jumping and bumped with Weldborough, which was carried outwards and in turn, bumped with Divisor. Stewards advised Apprentice, Tayah Stalker, that she should endeavour to keep her mount straight over the concluding stages as she had shifted from the rail to a three wide position.

**Reann's Diamond** (D Parish) – Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin.

### **RACE 8 – TASRACING BENCHMARK 68 HCP – 1600 METRES**

**Assaranca** (C Jordan) – Slow into stride.

**Irish Shotgun NZ** (G Catania) – Jumped awkwardly. Rider reported the gelding hung in throughout.
