Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – JACKSON SECURITY TAS NEWMARKET DEC 1ST - 1620 METRES

The start of this race was delayed four minutes late due to Prince of Passion having to be re-saddled.

Babe's Boy (C Jordan) –Slow to begin.

Heza Charmer (B McCoull) –Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Poet Warrior (I Toker) – Raced three wide in the early and middle stages. I Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip in excess of 5 times prior to the 100 metres, namely 9. After taking into his account his very good record and submissions on penalties, Stewards fined I Toker the sum of \$200.

Tiny Timmy (S Carr) –Raced further forward tonight, Trainer A Brakey explained that her instructions at previous starts had been to race in a forward position.

Willow Wood (M Ulucinar) – Jumped awkwardly

Gold Gown (B Louis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Sizzkye (T Doyle) – Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin.

Madame Benedict (B Muhcu) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

American Jewel (I Luximon) – Stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. Stewards issued a warning on the starting manners of this gelding. Had to be steadied off the heels of Babe's Boy passing the 800 metres when the pace slowed. American Jewel then shifted out making contact with Poet Warrior.

Nils (T Baker) – Jumped awkwardly, unbalancing the rider and slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES – 1220 METRES

Prosecutor (T Stalker) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run. Threw it's head in the air on jumping and was slow to begin.

Skilendra (D Pires) –Slow to begin.

Geegee Lucky Jess (S Carr) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Held up for a clear run entering the home straight.

Tiltherewarsyou (P Lui) – Raced three wide without cover in the early an middle stages.

Gee Gees Jennia (T Johnstone) Held up from the 100 metre mark to the finish between Tidal and Geegeeluckystar, which layed in.

Gee Gees Punter (T Baker) – Was held up for a clear run from the 350 metres, until the 150 metre mark.

RACE 3 – BOOK YOUR CHRISTMAS FUNCTION NOW DIV 1 – 1220 METRES

Brazen Guy (P Lui) –Bumped with Sao at the start.

Sao (D Pires) – Jumped inwards in the start, bumping with Brazen Guy. Raced three wide in the early and middle stages. Passing the 300 metre mark, Sao laid in bumping Brazen Guy.

Star Wings (C Jordan) – Fractious in the barrier and slow to begin. A warning has been issued on the barrier manners of this gelding. Momentarily held up behind Sao, passing the 400 metre mark.

Well Read (B Louis) – Tightened shortly after the start by Spelling Bee shifting out.

Disclevaboy (T Stalker) –Slow to begin.

Spelling Bee (T Baker) – Jumped outwards carrying Well Read wider. Raced four wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Gee Gee Enuf Speed (B Muhcu) –Tightened shortly after the start by Spelling Bee carrying Well Read outward.

RACE 4 – ROTARY CLUB OF CENTRAL LAUNCESTON DIV 2 – 1220 METRES

I Luximon was declared unfit to fulfil his remaining riding engagements due to a foot injury he suffered in race two.

Maywyn Is The Word (D Parish) –Raced wide throughout.

Sushi Express – Declared a late scratching at 7:08pm as there was no available rider to replace the injured I Luximon.

The following deductions were ordered:

Summer Fire (1st) – 0 cents a wine & 2 cents a place.

Power Magnum (2nd) – 2 cents a place.

Alpine Affair (3rd) – 6 cents a place.

Alpine Affair (M Ulucinar) – Approaching the 300 metre mark was attempting to progress into a run outside Wheelknot. At the same time, as Summer Fire was attempting the same run. As a result, Alpine Affair was held up for a clear run and appeared to clip the heels Wheelknot at this point.

Power Magnum (B Muhcu) – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with Summer Fire, carrying it in onto Heavens Heartbreak. Bumped on several occasions approaching the 800 metre mark.

Wheelknot (S Carr) – Raced greenly and hung out in the early stages. Compounded in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding suffered mild thumps after the race, however no other abnormalities could be detected.

Confused – Reared twice in the mounting yard dislodging T Doyle, a warning has been placed on the pre-race manners of this filly. Declared a late scratching at the barriers at 7:32pm as the club's medical officers deemed apprentice T Doyle unfit ride.

The following deductions were ordered:

Summer Fire (1st) – 0 cents a wine & 1 cents a place.

Power Magnum (2nd) – 1 cents a place.

Alpine Affair (3rd) – 3 cents a place.

Gee Gee Snowflake (T Johnstone) – Slow to begin.

Summer Fire (B Louis) – Had to be restrained off the heels of Heavens Heartbreak approaching the 800 metre turn. As a result, it shifted out and bumped with Power Magnum on several occasions.

RACE 5 – JACKSON SECURITY TAS NEWMARKET DEC 1ST – 1120 METRES

Deroche (B McCoull) – Jumped awkwardly.

Fragment (B Muhcu) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 6 – STEVE'S LIQUOR – 1420 METRES

Red Helmet (M Ulucinar) – Approaching the 200 metre mark, Red Helmet shifted out to obtain a clear run carrying Readily Rewarded wider on the track as Gee Gee Goldenlass layed in. Readily Rewarded had to be restrained and lost its position. Stewards reprimanded M Ulucinar for careless riding under AR 131(a) and Brandon Louis was advised to exercise care when his mount shifted ground.

Gee Gee Goldenlass (B Louis) – Laid in and as a result, Readily Rewarded had to be restrained and lost its position. Raced three wide without cover early.

Techno Awards (P Lui) – Slow to begin.

Lady (T Stalker) – Slow to begin. Had to be steadied off the heels of Red Helmet when racing in restricted room approaching the 800 metre turn.

Readily Rewarded (S Carr) -Bumped by Red Helmet shifting out approaching the 200 metres. Shortly after had to be restrained and lost its position passing the 200 metres when racing between Red Helmet and Gee Gee Goldenlass which both shifted ground.

RACE 7 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS – 2150 METRES

Captain Morgan NZ (B Muhcu) – B Muhcu, pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used the whip on 10 occasions prior to the 100-metre mark. After taking submissions on penalty, including the totality of his whip use and his exemplary record over the past three years, Stewards issued a fine of \$200.

Costero (M Ulucinar) – Slow to begin.

Tassie Miss (D Pires) – When queried, D Pires reported that when placed under pressure from the 600 metres, the mare failed to respond. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the mare revealed a respiratory noise with further diagnostics recommended. Subsequent to the meeting Trinder Racing reported that the mare had pulled up without any abnormalities and would now be sent for a spell.

Bullock NZ (C Jordan) – Fractious in the barriers, slow to begin.

RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE – 1120 METRES

Party In Style (T Johnstone) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Rider then elected to make a forward move mid race three wide as a result of these circumstances

RACE 9 – BALMORAL ON YORK – 1620 METRES

Weldborough (B McCoull) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed increased lung noise in the left lung, the Veterinary Surgeon has recommended further diagnostics. Subsequent to the race meeting stable connections advised that the gelding was suffering from a virus and would be sent for a short spell.

Assaranca (C Jordan) – Fractious in the barrier. Raced fiercely in the middle stages.
