Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP NEW YEARS DAY MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Bell Ringer Boy (B Muhcu) – Bumped by Alpine Blast which was carried out near the 500 metres by Saxon Mist which overreacted and shifted away from Dial Range. Dial Range had been carried wider on the track by Bynance obtaining a clear run passing the 500 metres.

Fortitude Valley (T Doyle) – Slow to muster early speed and commenced to tail the field from the 800 metres, to be beaten a considerable distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness if the off foreleg. Fortitude Valley has been stood down from racing until a veterinary certificate of soundness is received.

Our Sonny Boy (S Carr) – Was inconvenienced at the start between Gee Gees Ariel which shifted out and Dial Range.

Surprize Effect NZ (T Stalker) – Threw its head in the air on jumping and shifted out hampering Auntie Florrie.

Auntie Florrie (D Parish) – Hampered at the start and slow to begin.

Dial Range (T Johnstone) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced three wide in the early and middle stages to obtain cover passing the 800 metres.

Alpine Blast (M Ulucinar) – Jumped awkwardly and shifted in bumping with Fortitude Valley.

RACE 2 – BECOME A MEMBER & REAP THE REWARDS CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Need To Be Unique (C Jordan) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Needs Toasting (B McCoull) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Moshama (M Ulucinar) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

Tavisplash NZ (D Ganderton) – When questioned on the below market expectations performance, rider reported that after being a little slow to begin, he was caught extremely wide in the early stages and was obliged to restrain his mount to race at the tail of the field. After this, he said the pace of the race did not suit and the mare was unable to make ground in the home straight.

Evelina Rose (D Pires) – Jumped awkwardly.

Velino (P Lui) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Blushed (T Baker) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider reported after being caught wide the mare failed to respond to his riding in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Destiny Force (D Parish) – Declared a late scratching at 11.03am For veterinary reasons. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to the mare trialling or racing again.

RACE 3 – FOOT & PLAYSTED BENCHMARK 62 HCP– 1200 METRES

Sellick (T Johnstone) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

Gee Gee Josie (J Curtain) – Bumped by Silver Road shifting in approaching the winning post.

Alfie All Talent (P Lui) – Jumped awkwardly.

Clifton Danseur (B McCoull) – Rider reported that after racing wide with cover the gelding failed to make ground in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Fighting Floyd (B Louis) – Jumped outwards at the start. Shifted out in the home straight to obtain a clear run to the outside of Fun 'N' Frolic. In doing so, made contact with Mrs Whitten, resulting in T Baker having to stop riding and bumping with Clifton Danseur to its outside. B Louis was issued with a severe reprimand under AR131(a) for careless riding.

Military Law (M Muhcu) – Was slow to begin.

Silver Road (M Ulucinar) – Approaching the winning post, Silver Road, layed in away from Military Law and made contact with the hindquarters of Gee Gee Josie.

Fun 'N' Frolic (T Stalker) – Raced three wide without cover and layed out making the home turn.

Mrs Whitten (T Baker) – Was slow to begin. Compounded over the concluding stages. Rider reported the mare failed to let down over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Schauffele (D Ganderton) – Raced wide throughout.

Be Kinder (C Jordan) – Race three wide without cover.

Dolce Casa (T Doyle) – Over raced in the early stages. Raced greenly and hung out making the 600 metre turn.

Peace Be Upon Him (D Pires) – Jumped awkwardly. Raced four wide without cover and shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

Real Monster (T Baker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Bumped with Geegeesscarletbee near the 600 metres and again near the 400 metres.

Geegeesscarletbee (T Johnstone) – Slow to begin. Raced greenly had to be steadied off heels approaching the 700 metres. Again, had to be steadied off the heels passing the 600 metres, commenced to race fiercely, shifted out bumping with Real Monster. Layed out and bumped with Real Monster again near the 400 metres.

Her Thoughts (G Catania) – Slow to begin. Hung out throughout.

RACE 5 – OWNERS RACE VIEWING NOW IN THE PUNTERS BAR MDN/CL1 – 2100 METRES

Northern Spirit (T Baker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider reported that the mare was inclined to lay out. A post-race veterinary examination of Northern Spirit revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Sienna's Word (B Muhcu) – Blundered on jumping. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a heart murmur. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before trialling or racing again.

Sizzkye (C Jordan) – Slow to begin.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP 23RD FEBRUARY BENCHMARK 76HCP – 1600 METRES

Arty Lucas (B Louis) – Over raced in the early and middle stages and bumped several occasions from the 1000 metres until the 600 metres with Coronation Glade which was racing tight to its outside. Entering the home straight, Arty Lucas shifted out marginally bumping with Coronation Glade.

Doroza NZ (T Stalker) –When questioned on the tactics adopted the rider reported that the gelding had raced fiercely in the early stages near the 1100 metres and then been off the bit and not suited to the strong pace. Stewards advised T Stalker however that she should have endeavoured to rider her mount along near the 800 metres in an effort to keep in contact with the field.

The Risk Factor (D Pires) – Laid in under pressure approaching the 200 metres mark.

Coronation Glade (S Carr) – Bumped with Arty Lucas several times approaching the 800 metres. On the home turn, Coronation Glade shifted in marginally and bumped with Arty Lucas.

RACE 7 – CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES BENCHMARK 68 HCP – 1400 METRES

Boom Dot Com (C Jordan) – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight before being corrected by its rider.

Barjeel (T Baker) – Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin.

Stinka (B Muhcu) – Slow to begin.

RACE 8 – PHIL HUGHES OFFICE SOLUTIONS 0-62 HCP – 1600 METRES

Submit Another (D Pires) – Layed in approaching the 800 metre turn. D Pires stated that Submit Another was disappointing tonight. His only explanation was that the horse may not be suited to turf tracks.

Launnie Nights (M Ulucinar) – Slow to begin.

Calingo (P Lui) – Slow to begin.

GENERAL

Trainer A Trinder was questioned over the reasons for scratching of Tassie Miss (race 8) after acceptances on Monday morning. He explained that after receiving a phone call around 10am from Steward Mr B Free advising of a request to scope the mare due to respiratory noises he decided it would not be in the interests of her welfare to perform this procedure close to race day. He subsequently scratched the mare and stewards were informed she would now be spelled.
