SUPPLEMENTARY

TASMANIAN RACING CLUB – Sunday 14th November 2021

Race 3: Rick's Plaster Benchmark 62 Hcp

Stewards today concluded an inquiry into an incident near the 1,000 metres where LADY MARINA (B Mccoull) had to steady when crossed by STELLADONA (D Parish) which shifted ground inwards when not sufficiently clear.

After consideration the Stewards found Mrs D Parish guilty of a breach of ARR 131 (a) with her licence to ride in races being suspended for the conclusion of racing today, up to and including racing on Sunday 28th November 2021. (One riding day).

GENERAL

Following the running of Race 5, riders attending the meeting were addressed with respect to the Stewards expectations of all riders when competing in races.

Race 1 - ROTARY CLUB OF CENTRAL LAUNCESTON CLASS 1 HCP (1,620 METRES)

HEZA CHARMER – shifted out on jumping and bumped heavily-losing ground; over-raced passing 1,000 metres; held up passing 600 metres; crowded passing 350 metres when attempting to improve.

PERKINS – raced wide without cover to 800 metres.

LADY – bumped at start.

READILY REWARDED – help up passing 350 metres; unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

CATCH ME PADDY – hung inwards throughout.

WOOD'S POINT – lay in through the early part of the final straight.

Rider **M Ulucinar** (CATCH ME PADDY) was reminded of his obligations with respect to shifting ground, after permitting his mount to shift inward near the 300 metres resulting in crowding to HEZA CHARMER.

Race 2 – JACKSONS SECURITY TASMANIAN NEWMARKET 1ST DECEMBER MAIDEN (1,120 METRES)

GEE GEES BUZZ – bounded at the start and lost ground

REAL BRAZEN – crowded after the start and lost ground.

BAHEERA – raced wide in the early stages.

DOLCE CASA – inconvenienced passing 1,200 metres.

UPSET – held up passing the 600 metres and only obtained clear running passing the 200 metres.

HEAVEN'S MIRACLE – raced greenly throughout.

Race 3 – BECOME A MEMBER & REAP THE REWARDS MAIDEN MDN-SW (1,120 METRES)

ROHZHAE -was a late scratching at 6:02pm after sustaining an injury enroute to the meeting. Stewards ordered the following deductions.

1st Tappa Pass 17 cents win & 11 cents place

2nd Husavik 16 cents place

3rd Gee Gee Miss Quita 22 cents

GEEGEESCARLETBEE – began awkwardly and was slow away.

SILENT LOVE – began awkwardly; buffeted passing 800 metres. Gave ground latter stages. Veterinary check revealed lameness left forelimb- clearance required.

HUSAVIK -shifted out on jumping and bumped.

GEE GEE MISS QUITA- bumped at start; raced wide throughout.

GEE GEE SCARLET BEE bounded at the start and was slow to begin.

BE KINDER over-raced passing the 750 metres.

TAPPA PASS – hung in over final stages.

Apprentice B Louis was issued with a warning under ARR 131 (b) after he relaxed his ride over the concluding stages. Stewards were satisfied that notwithstanding Apprentice Louis's failing to ride through to the finish of the race, his mounts chances of finishing in a higher placing were not compromised.

Immediately following the event co-trainer Mr Trent Wells (GEE GEE MISS QUITA) viewed vision of the final stages with consideration of lodging a protest against first placed TAPPA PASS. Mr Wells elected not to proceed.

Race 4 – MEMBERS JACKPOT EVERY WEEK MAIDEN
MDN-SW (1,620 METRES)

PRINCE OF PASSION – shifted out shortly after the start and bumped heavily.

HOBART – hampered after the start; raced in restricted room passing 450 metres.

MAYWYN IS THE WORD – slow to begin.

DISCLEVABOY – raced wide in the early and middle stages; compounded passing 500 metres; made heavy contact and went off-stride; not persevered thereafter; post-race veterinary check revealed no abnormalities.

LABBY ROCK – reluctant to approach the barriers – warning issued; severely hampered 450 metres.

SURPRIZE EFFECT – badly hampered 450 metres.

GEE GEES ARIEL – raced in restricted room and bumped heavily passing 450 metres.

Stewards investigated an incident near the 450 metres where DISCLEVABOY, SURPRIZE EFFECT; LABBY ROCK and GEE GEES ARIEL were checked or hampered. After questioning all riders concerned and viewing the vision of the incident, it was established that passing the 500 metres HOBART had improved into a narrow run to the inside of GEE GEES ARIEL, which was then placed in restricted room and awkwardly near the heels of DISCLEVABOY. Near the 450 metres DISCLEVABOY yielded ground quickly and came back through the field, bumping heavily with GEE GEES ARIEL. DISCLEVABOY then became badly unbalanced and shifted out badly hampering LABBY ROCK which in turn shifted out hampering SURPRIZE EFFECT.

After considering all factors the Stewards determined that the principal factor in this incident was DISCLEVABOY coming back through the field and causing general tightening to several runners in consequence.

Race 5 – KELVIN LUCAS MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 62 HCP (1,220 METRES)

GYMPINS – slow to begin; unable to obtain clear racing room throughout the final straight.

TOUGH BOY – began awkwardly and got back; held up rounding final turn and early part of the straight; shifted in and bumped 150 metres.

MAGIC KHAN – race wide throughout.

ZAGAME – held up round the final turn.

GEE GEE JOSIE – held up passing the 500 metres until passing the 200 metres.

ALFIE ALL TALENT – checked passing 150 metres when weakening.

Miss E Byrne-Burke (TOUGH BOY) admitted a breach of [ARR 131(a)] with the particulars being that passing the 150 metres, when shifting inward to improve, she took the line of ALFIE ALL TALENT which was checked. After considering all relevant factors Miss Byrne-Burke's licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 1st December 2021 up to and including racing on Wednesday 8th December 2021. (Two riding days).

Race 6 – MEMBERS HANDICAP BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1,420 METRES)

BANCA NIP – Slow to begin; held up 400 metres to 150 metres.

RISING HSIANG – raced wide in the lead.

GREGORIAN CHANT – hung out passing the 600 metres.

Stewards questioned rider I Toker with regards to his tactic of racing wider on the track when leading during the middle stages. In explanation Mr Toker stated that, in his opinion, the going three of the fence was more preferable than closer in, and as such he had elected to remain wider. Mr Toker's explanation was noted.

Stewards enquired into an incident near the 500 metres where BANCA NIP (S Carr) contacted the hind quarters of SCRUTINEER (B Louis) which became briefly unbalanced.

After questioning riders and reviewing vision of the incident, it was established that as a consequence of the indifferent tempo, BANCA NIP had become awkwardly placed near the heels of WARDELL passing the 500 metres and when being restrained had shifted out and become awkwardly placed inside the hindquarters of SCRUTINEER, making contact with that runner. Given all circumstances no further action was taken, other than to remind Ms Carr of her obligations when in similar circumstances.

Race 7 – MCB DEVELOPMENTS 3YO CUP 1ST DECEMBER 0-62 (1,420 METRES)

FOREX – slow to begin.

HAMOGANY – raced wide for the majority.

CLIFTON DANSOUR - crowded for room and steadied 350 metres when weakening.

SHEWEARSTHEPANTS – hung in rounding the final turn.

Rider **M Ulucinar** was issued with a warning under ARR [131 (a)] after permitting his mount SON OF FAITH to shift ground out rounding the final turn resulting in CLIFTON DANSOUR being crowded for room and having to steady.

Race 8 – BOOK IN FOR YOUR CHRISTMAS FUNCTION 0-62 (1,420 METRES)

STEFANIDI – slow into stride.

SILVER ROAD – crowded for room and lost ground passing 1,200 metres.

BOGAN BILL – crowded and lost ground passing 1,200 metres.

Stewards opened and adjourned an investigation into SILVER ROAD and BOGAN BILL losing momentum passing the 1,200 metres.

Race 9 – YOUNG RACING TASMANIA BENCHMARK 76 HCP (2,450 METRES)

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – rider lost whip passing 300 metres.
