Comments / Explanations:

Trainer S Brunton was fined the sum of \$100 for the late notification of E Bryne Burke (SirSimon) in race 6 under LR 13.3

RACE 1 – TH EXAMINER BENCHMARK 62HCP – 1200 METRES

Late scratching Huon Chief at 12:15pm, veterinary reasons. The following deductions were ordered

- 1st Our Shinkansen 5c win 5c place
- 2nd Magic Khan 8c place
- 3rd Seguimeintos 6c place

Gympins was a late scratching at 4:57pm for late arrival on course due to traffic conditions. The following deductions were ordered

- 1st Our Shinkansen 4c win 4c place
- 2nd Magic Khan 5c place
- 3rd Seguimeintos 4c place

Gee Gee Plane (E Bryne Burke) – jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

Seguimientos (B Louis) – disappointed for a clear run in the home straight and was held up between Majic Khan and Son Of Faith from the 250m, until approaching the 100m.

Bogan Bill (I Luximon) – Slow to begin. Raced three-wide in the early and middle stages. Commenced a forward move near the 600m and was inconvenienced when Gee Gee Plane shifted out and making contact with its near-side shoulder, I Luximon became briefly unbalanced. E Bryne-Burke was

reprimanded under AR 131(a) for careless riding for allowing her mount to shift when insufficiently clear of another runner.

Son Of Faith (M Ulucinar) – Raced three-wide without cover. Carried wider approaching the 100m mark when Majic Khan shifted out under pressure, carrying.

Fighting Faith (S Carr) – Carried wider near the 100m when Son Of Faith had been shifted wider on the track.

Gee Gee Josie (J Curtain) – Jumped awkwardly, raced three-wide and then progressed four-wide approaching the 800m.

RACE 2 – THE ADVOCATE MDN/CL1 – 1600 METRES

Babe's Boy (I Toker) - stood flat-footed and was slow to begin.

Cashmore (I Luximon) - was slow to begin. Cashmore and Kay Oh Ell bumped on jumping.

Lady (T Stalker) – raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

Hobart (D Parish) – jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Stewards will conduct an inquiry at a date to be fixed into the reasons Hobart had to be steadied and lose its position making the home turn.

Madame Benedict (G Catania) – tailed the field in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination no obvious abnormalities.

Stike Impact (E Bryne-Burke) – The Veterinary Surgeon reported that the gelding to have bled from one nostril. It has been stood down from racing until it completes a satisfactory 1000 metre gallop in the presence of a Steward pursuant to AR 79(8).

Track downgraded to a soft 7 at 6:06pm.

RACE 3 – BURNIE NEWSAGENCY MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Oromocto (D Ganderton) – Rider reported the gelding did not handle today's track conditions.

Baheera (B Louis) – Jumped awkwardly. Bumped making the home turn when Shake Your Tooshy shifted out.

Shake Your Tooshy (B Muhcu) – Bumped with Gee Gees Rebel at the start. Slow to begin, raced three-wide without cover. Shifted out on the home turn bumping with Baheera. B Muhcu was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

Meigetsu (C Jordan) – Over-raced in the early stages and had to be continually steadied off the heels of Leica Starlet from the 1000m mark until passing 700m.

Correct weight was delayed when rider of Upset (S.Carr) wished to view the film. After doing so she was satisfied, and correct weight was given.

RACE 4 – RIVERSIDE NEWS & LOTTO MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Noztrabeel (T Johnstone) –Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

Dadorable (T Doyle) – Slow to begin.

Ninth Angel (T Keys) – Raced three-wide without cover.

Shamzou (T Stalker) – Threw its head in the air upon jumping. Raced three-wide in the early stages.

Magic Typhoon (M Ulucinar) – Magic Typhoon and Sushi Express brushed upon jumping. Approaching the winning post Magic Typhoon was crowded between Sushi Express which was shifting in and Ninth

Angel which had shifted ground outwards. Stewards advised all riders to exercise caution when their mounts shift ground.

Broadway Babe (D Pires) – Over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 5 – NORWOOD NEWSAGENCY 3YO MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Kaytee Valiente (D Ganderton) – jumped inwards abruptly at the start making heavy contact with Chosen Eagle. The gelding then shifted out soon after the start carrying Dawn Eagle slightly wider on the track. Shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

Alpine Affair (M Ulucinar) – Jumped awkwardly.

Needs Remembering (B McCoull) – Raced wide throughout.

Confused (T Doyle) Slow to begin

Swingapinga (T Stalker) – jumped inwards at the start carrying Gee Gee Snowflake inward.

Hellfire Eagle (E Bryne-Burke) – shifted out on jumping and was then tightened when Dawn Eagle shifted outward.

Gee Gee Snowflake (T Johnstone) – Tightened at the start, over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 6 – GEORGETOWN NEWS XPRESS OPEN HCP – 1400 METRES

Creative Hero was a late scratching at 7:17pm due to the downgrade in the track. The following deductions were ordered

1st Sir Simon 12c win 8c place

2nd Queen La Diva 17c

Permission given for M Ulucinar to ride Super Swoop 1kg over its allotted weight.

Sir Simon (E Bryne-Burke) – Was tightened for room at the start when Baleric shifted in and White Hawk shifted out. Shortly after the start Sir Simon shifted out momentarily tightening Baleric. E Bryne-Burke was advised to exercise care when her mounts shift ground in future.

Baleric (D Ganderton) Momentarily tightened by Si Simon shifting out after the start. Stewards advised D Ganderton to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the finish line.

RACE 7 – LONGFORD NEWSAGENCY BENCHMARK 62 HCP – 1400 METRES

Queens Needs was a late scratching at 6:21pm due to the downgrade of the track. The following deductions were ordered

1st Gregorian Chant 12c win 10c place

2nd Gee Gee Manpower 12c place

3rd Generalmaintenance 15c place

Gregorian Chant (NZ) (C Jordan) – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

Forex (B Muhcu) – Slow to begin when inconvenienced by General Maintenance shifting in at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Gee Gee Manpower (T Baker) – over-raced in the middle stages.

RACE 8 – KINGS MEADOWS NEWS & LOTTO BENCHMARK 76 HCP – 1100 METRES

Aspirate Declared a late scratching at 5.45pm due to the track downgrade. The following deductions were ordered

1st Our Little Ted 1c win 5c place

2nd Dark Wanderer 4c place

Gee Gee Lanett (E Bryne-Burke) – jumped awkwardly, shifted out and brushed with Gee Gee True Story. Over-raced in the early stages.

Dark Wanderer (T Johnstone) – raced wide without cover in the early stages.

RACE 9 – CHARLES ST CENTRAL NEWSAGENCY & LOTTO BENCHMARK 68 HCP – 1600 METRES

Full Knots Ahead was a late scratching at 9.47pm after suffering a laceration to its right ear after becoming fractious in the swabbing stall.

The following deductions were ordered

1st Assaranca 2c win 12c place

2nd Travelling Gigolo 20c place

3rd So Astounding 18c place

Luka Bratzi (E Bryne-Burke) – Slow to begin.

Brandum Bay (T Stalker) – Slow to begin.

Travelling Gigolo (T Baker) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Banca Syd (B Louis) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Sir Da Vinci (D Pires) – Rider reported that he felt something amiss with the horse's action in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination the gelding had suffered a tendon injury to the near foreleg. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before Sir Da Vinci trials or races again.

GENERAL

Trainer B McShane pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 228(a) for conduct prejudicial to the interests of racing for posting social media comments in August 2021. After considering submissions on penalty stewards issued a fine of \$500 with \$250 suspended for 12 months on condition that Mr McShane does not reoffend under this rule. He was advised of his rights to appeal.
