Comments / Explanations:

The Stewards accepted the reasons for the late notifications for tonight's meeting.

RACE 1 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS JIM OSBORNE LONGFORD CUP NEW YEARS DAY MAIDEN (1220 METRES)

Mikayla's Paris (P. Lui) –Bumped by Sea Nymph when shifting out near the 400 metres and then held up for a clear run until passing the 250 metres.

Step Too Far (I. Toker) –Shifted in approaching the 800 metre turn crowding Miss Sleuth which became buffeted between it and Peace Be Upon Him. I Toker was reprimanded for careless riding under the

provisions of AR 131(a) for allowing his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear. Compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be dehydrated.

Peace Be Upon Him (D. Pires) –Crowded and buffeted near the 800 metres.

Auntie Florrie (Ms T. Johnstone) –Tightened on jumping between Step Too Far and Sea Nymph which shifted out.

Be Kinder (Ms C. Jordan) –Momentarily held up for a clear run approaching the 150 metres.

Dolce Casa (T. Doyle) –Race three wide without cover. Hung in over the concluding stages.

Miss Sleuth (T. Stalker) – Crowded and buffeted near the 800 metres.

Rapid Effect (B. Louis) –Slow to begin.

Swift Milou (G. Catania) –Raced wide throughout.

Silent Love (D. Parish) –Slow to begin.

Sea Nymph (T. Baker) –Shifted out abruptly approaching the 400 metres and bumped with Mikayla's Paris

RACE 2 – JACKSON SECURITY TASMANIAN NEWMARKET 1ST DECEMBER Class 1 Hcp (1220 METRES)

Gee Gee Als Prince (T. Baker) - Raced wide throughout.

Perkins (B. Louis) –Shifted out near the 1000 metres when not clear of Innocent Pegg, resulting in that mare clipping heels severely unbalancing the rider. At a subsequent inquiry B Louis was found guilty of careless riding under AR 131(a) for allowing his mount to shift out when not clear of Innocent Pegg. After considering the extent of the shift and the higher level of the interference B Louis licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date from midnight 14/11/21 to midnight 17/11/21.

Bondi Tiff (M. Ulucinar) –Bumped with Tiltherewasyou near the 700 metres.

Get The Trip (B. Muhcu) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near fore. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before trialling or racing again.

Twee (T Johnstone) –Fractious in the barriers a warning has been issued. Layed in making the 800 metre turn tightening Skilendra. Skilendra which was over racing then tightened the running of Tilttherewasyou which lost its position and to its inside Geegee Luckyjess had to be restrained.

Geegee Lucky Jess (S Carr) –Tightened at the start by Epic Song shifting out. Slow to begin. Shifted out near the 100 metres tightening the running of Twee. S Carr was issued with a severe reprimand under AR 131(a) for careless riding for shifting out when not clear.

Innocent Pegg (T Stalker) - Tightened for room and clipped heels, severely unbalancing T Stalker near the 1000 metres when Perkins shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be dehydrated.

Skilendra (D Pires) - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Tightened near the 800 metres by Twee laying in.

Summer Fire (E Byrne Burke) - Raced wide throughout.

Tilttherewasyou (P Lui) –Tightened near the 800 metres by Skilendra shifting in and appeared to clip heels and lose its position. Commenced to over race and bumped with Bondi Tiff near the 700 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a muscle tear injury, and the mare has been stood down from trialling and racing until a veterinary certificate of soundness is received.

RACE 3 – BOOK YOUR CHRISTMAS FUNCTION NOW CLASS 1 HCP (1420 METRES)

Ubriaco (C Jordan) – Layed in entering the home straight.

Needs Toasting (B McCoull) – Slow to begin. Held up for a clear run approaching the 300 metres until the near the 200 metres, when obtaining an extremely tight run to the inside of Champagne Cinders and contacting the running rail. B McCoull was advised to exercise more care when attempting to gain a run than he had done on this occasion.

Iris West (S Carr) – Compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the mare had suffered muscle myositis (tied up).

Gee Gee Rhythm (T Doyle) -Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES MAIDEN – 1420 METRES

Gee Gee Enuf Speed - Declared a late scratching at 5.45pm when the filly was injured during transport to the course. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before trialling or racing. Stewards ordered the following deductions

1st Heza Charmer - 14c win. 14c place

2nd Queen's The Word - 16c place

3rd Alpine Blast - 13c place

Heza Charmer (B McCoull) – Slow to begin. Layed in under pressure over the concluding stages.

Disclevaboy (T Stalker) –Layed out making the 800 metre and home turn.

Special Guest (T Doyle) – Steadied off heels near the 1200 and 1000 metres.

Our Sonny Boy (B Louis) –Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

RACE 5 – MCB DEVELOPMENT 3YO CUP 1ST DECEMBER BENCHMARK 68 HCP 1220METRES

Aspirate (T Doyle) - Slow into stride. Steadied off heels approaching the 800 metres.

Red Letter Lady (B McCoull) - Over raced near the 800 metres.

Sidorova (C Jordan) - Over raced near the 800 metres.

Huon Chief (T Johnstone) - Raced three wide from the 800 metres.

RACE 6 – STEVE'S LIQUOR MDN/CLASS 1 2150METRES

American Jewel (D Parish) - Bumped with Launnie Nights approaching the 1800 metres and commenced to over race.

Launnie Nights (M Ulucinar) - Caught three wide in the early stages and bumped with American Jewel near the 1800 metres.

Tavisplash (NZ) (D Ganderton) - Elected to work forward after being caught wide in the early stages.

Sizzkye (C Jordan) - Slow to begin.

Steer For Lady (T Stalker) - Held up for a clear run to the inside of Dial Range making the home turn.

RACE 7 – BUCKBY MOTORS BENCHMARK 68 HCP 2150 METRES

Red Fiore - Declared a late scratching at 4.10pm due to being injured on the float when being loaded. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before trialling or racing. Stewards ordered the following deductions

1st The Risk Factor - 6c win. 5c place

2nd Perun - 8c place

Overplay (T Johnstone) - Fractious in the barrier, removed from the gates and passed fit to run. Raced three wide throughout and compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. The gelding has been stood down from racing for its barrier manners until it completes a satisfactory barrier trial.

Freelancer (D Ganderton) - Caught three wide in the early stages. Compounded over the concluding stages, a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have an elevated heart rate and to be dehydrated.

Perun (NZ) (B Louis) - Crowded on jumping between The Risk Factor and Overplay.

Dixie's Boy (E Byrne Burke) - Compounded over the concluding stages, a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have respiratory noises with further diagnostics recommended.

RACE 8 - MATT GARWOOD 17TH NOVEMBER BENCHMARK 62 HCP 1620M

Coronation Glade - Declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 9.41pm after connections were not satisfied the gelding was sound after being cleared to run earlier in the night by the veterinary surgeon. This was after having a shoe removed and re fastened. Stewards ordered the following deductions

1st Need To Be Unique – 15c win. 13c place.

2nd Red Helmet – 17c place.

Red Helmet (M Ulucinar) - Over raced in the early stages.

Forex (NZ) (B Muhcu) - Slow to begin

Anacreon (E Byrne Burke) - Raced three wide early and then inclined to over race.

Reann's Diamond (T Doyle) - Slow to begin

GENERAL

E Byrne Burke pleaded guilty tonight to two charges under AR 132(7)(a)(ii), firstly for using her whip 10 times prior to the 100m on Belmista in Race 4 at the TRC meeting on 2/11/21. The second offence being in Race 1 at the TTC meeting on 3/11/21 when riding Gee Gee Plane where she again used the whip 10 times prior to the 100 metres. After taking submissions on penalty, she was issued with a fine of \$500 on each count.
