Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – MCKAY TIMBER 2YO MAIDEN 900 METRES:

Full Zulu (E Byrne Burke) – Shifted out on jumping bumping with Elusive Princess.

Geegees Sunshine (T Baker) – Raced wide throughout.

Grand Pegasus (T Voorham) – Rider reported her mount raced greenly and hung out in the home straight.

Decisive Choice (T Doyle) – Shifted in on jumping and was slow to begin. Over- raced in the middle stages. Held up for clear running near the 450 metres before shifting wider on the track.

Ella Exceeds (C Jordan) – Hung in entering the home straight brushing on several occasions with Vokes. Continued to hang in for the remainder of the race.

Elusive Princess (M Ulucinar) – Bumped heavily at the start by Full Zulu shifting out and blundered unbalancing the rider. Rider reported the filly hung out throughout the race and he felt there was

something amiss. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near hind canon.

RACE 2 – DERWENT PARK PLUMBING MAIDEN 1200 METRES:

Bond Street Beau (NZ) (T Voorham) – Over raced in the early stages. Rider reported the colt hung in throughout.

Expensive Mistake (S Carr) – Slow to begin. Rider reported the gelding made a respiratory noise during the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Confused (T Doyle) – Reared in the preliminary harmlessly dislodging the rider. The filly then galloped free for a short distance before being caught and passed fit to run by the veterinary surgeon. Confused has been stood down from racing until it completes a test on its pre-race manners.

Geegeesscarletbee (T Johnstone) – Compounded from the 450 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormality. Rider reported the filly may not have handled today's track conditions.

Krupt Candy (C Jordan) – Layed in over the concluding stages.

Spelling Bee (T Baker) – Compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Shamzou (T Stalker) – Slow to begin and tailed the field in the early stages. When questioned on the improved performance trainer G McCulloch advised that an increase in the mares work regime as well as the addition of Blinkers may have contributed. Stewards noted his explanation.

RACE 3 – RICK'S PLASTER BENCHMARK 62 HCP 1200 METRES:

Don'tbuckme Off (T Johnstone) – Raced wide without cover.

Brinktop Lad (C Jordan) – Delayed the start when fractious in the barriers, withdrawn from the gates before being passed fit to run. A warning has been placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Apprentice C Jordan was reminded of her obligations under AR 131(b) in that she must ride her mounts out fully to the finish.

Fighting Floyd (B Louis) – Jumped awkwardly then tightened when Silver Road shifted out.

Silver Road (T Voorham) – Jumped outwards at the start tightening Fighting Floyd.

Little River Boy (T Stalker) – Hung out making the home turn.

Just Mooncoin (T Baker) – Tightened for racing room near the 1100 metres.

Off Peak (NZ) (T Doyle) – Over raced in the early and middle stages before shifting in near the 1100 metres tightening Just Mooncoin.

RACE 4 – PST POWER SOLUTIONS MDN/CL1 1600 METRES:

Moshama (B Louis) – Slow to begin then crowded by Surprise Effect(NZ) being carried out..

Sir Loft (NZ) (S Carr) – Rider reported the gelding failed to respond to her riding from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Blushed (T Baker) – Jumped outwards at the start crowding Surprise Effect(NZ).

Chi Mazel (D Pires) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages and raced wide without cover.

Lady (T Stalker) – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin. Rider reported the mare may not have handled today's track conditions.

Surprize Effect (NZ) (T Voorham) – Crowded on jumping by Blushed shifting out.

RACE 5 – PST POWER SOLUTIONS GOODWOOD HCP 1100 METRES:

Deroche (B McCoull) – When questioned on the below market expectation performance today the rider explained that after the start he had not been able to go forward and obtain a position wider on the track where he believed there was better going. The mare had then failed to run on. A post-race veterinary report revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Ruettiger (NZ) (E Byrne Burke) – Over-raced in the early stages.

And Beyond (T Voorham) – Advised to exercise care when shifting ground inwards as near the 900 metres she had crossed Ruettiger(NZ) when not fully clear.

Algernon (B Louis) – Jumped awkwardly.

First Accused (G Catania) – Threw its head in the air on jumping and was slow to begin. Layed in near the 900 metres when being steadied momentarily tightening Gee Gee True Story

Gee Gee True Story (T Baker) – Jumped awkwardly. Tightened near the 900 metres when First Accused layed in.

RACE 6 – TOMS COUNTDOWN BENCHMARK 68 HCP 1400 METRES:

Alinjer (B Louis) – Carried wider, tightened onto John's Lad and restrained passing the 400 metres when firstly carried outwards by Johnny Chutzpah shifting out and then when Johnny Chutzpah had been carried outwards by Flourishing Future.

Flourishing Future (T Stalker) – Shifted out passing the 400 metres carrying Johnny Chutzpah wider which in turn crowded Alinjer onto John's Lad. Alinjer had to be restrained at this point. Apprentice T Stalker was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131(a) for careless riding for allowing her mount to shift out when not fully clear of Johnny Chutzpah.

Johnny Chutzpah (B Muhcu) – Shifted wider and then carried wider near the 400 metres when Flourishing Future shifted outwards crowding Alinjer. B Muhcu was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground for the initial shift in this incident.

Rising Light (D Pires) – Layed in entering the home straight.

Nev's Boy (T Johnstone) – Declared a late scratching at 3.59pm by order of the Stewards when the gelding reared and fell behind the gates. Stewards ordered the following deductions

1 st Ivoryman	5c win	8c place

John's Lad (C Jordan) – Crowded passing the 400 metres by Alinjer which had been tightened at that point.

RACE 7 – CLENNETTS MITRE 10 BENCHMARK 62 HCP 2100 METRES:

Encosta Fiorente (T Johnstone) – Bumped at the start by Dunmining shifting in.

Dunmining (T Voorham) – Reared on jumping and bumped with Encosta Fiorente.

GENERAL

TTC 10/11/2021 Correction

The Veterinary Surgeon reported that Iris West in race 3 had pulled up suffering muscle myositis and had been treated. The stable connections advise that in fact this was Hannah's Song in race 5 that was treated for this condition and no abnormalities were detected with Iris West. Trainer /rider S Carr further advised that Iris West had not felt comfortable on the track conditions that night.
