GENERAL

Rider Mrs D Parish did not attend due to sustaining an injury at track work on Saturday morning.

Mrs Parish was replaced in -

- Race 1 on GEE GEE ZIPALON by P Lui
- Race 5 on HOBART by B Louis

Race 1 -T.A. BRICKNELL MAIDEN (1800 METRES)

Apprentice P Lui replaced D Parish (injured) on GEE GEE ZIPALON due to no senior rider being available.

AMERICAN JEWEL – stood flat-footed at the start losing considerable ground (20 metres) – must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing.

THE EXECUTIVE – travelled wide rounding the first turn.

WILD DESTINY – wide in the early stages; gave ground from 500 metres; rider stated that the step up in distance had proved detrimental. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

Race 2 -INCITEC PIVOT MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

Trainer Mr W McShane admitted a breach of Rule ARR 106 (1) and was fined \$200.00 after presenting PREWINGO with an incorrect saddlecloth.

SHAMMGOD – improved wide rounding the final turn

Upon returning to scale, Miss E Byrne-Burke (NIGHT MISSILE) re-entered the jockey's room without weighing in. The Stewards found no exceptional circumstance leading to this omission and in consequence, acting on the provisions of ARR 210 (2), NIGHT MISSILE was disqualified from the race.

An inquiry into Miss Byrne-Burke's obligations under Rule 210 was adjourned to Devonport meeting on Wednesday 5th January 2022.

Race 3 TASMANIAN LIVESTOCK SERVICES 0-62 (1400 METRES)

AMANCAYA – crowded and raced in restricted room passing the 1,000 metres when over-racing; tightened near 100 metres.

NEV'S BOY – checked passing 100 metres and lost momentum.

HAMOGANY – shifted in passing 100 metres and bumped heavily.

ISKRA – lay out near 100 metres and had to be straightened.

RAVAGE – travelled wide in middle stages.

SIR LOFT – bled both nostrils- 3 months stand-down from racing.

Apprentice **P Lui** was reprimanded under ARR 131(a) after permitting ISKRA to shift ground inward passing the 1,000 metres when not clear of AMANCAYA which was crowded and placed in restricted room for a short distance.

An investigation into NEV'S BOY being checked passing the 100 metres was adjourned to Devonport meeting on Wednesday 5th January 2022.

Race 4 - ROBERTS REAL ESTATE LONGFORD BENCHMARK 66 HCP (1400 METRES)

DOROSA -slow into stride; over-raced on slow tempo in middle stages.

IVORYMAN -over-raced when wide in middle stages.

FRENCH HEIRESS – got its head up when over-racing on slow tempo passing 1,000 metres

LESNAR – got head up when temp steadied passing the 1,000 metres.

Race 5 – ARMIDALE STUD BENCHMARK 62 HCP (1800 METRES)

B Louis replaced D Parish (injured)

HOBART – travelled wide for the majority of the event.

PROSECUTOR – raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres.

Race 6 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS JIM OSBORNE LONGFORD CUP (1800 METRES)

COSTERO -began awkwardly and got back

GOLD CHORUS – slow to begin

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – rider questioned re performance- first run in 5 weeks may have effected performance.

Race 7 – QUEENS ARMS HOTEL 0-62 (1400 METRES)

DINGA’S DELIGHT – slow to begin; travelled wide through middle stages.

NEEDAREIN – raced wide throughout.
