GENERAL

Rider K Bohorun did not attend the meeting and was replaced on his engagements by R Tan.

Race 1 – CATARAQUI ANGUS MAIDEN (1,200 METRES)

SQUAZEEMOTO – hung out rounding final turn; hung out final 200 metres and could not be ridden to full advantage- warning placed on racing manners.

DARING FEELING – compounded passing the 200 metres- rider could offer no tangible explanation. Veterinary check revealed the gelding to be displaying respiratory distress and lameness in the near fore. Veterinary clearance required prior to next racing.

Race 2 – VT & GV HILL MEMORIAL CLASS B HCP (1,200 METRES)

EIGHTY EIGHT DAYS – slow to begin.

Race 3 – WAVERLEY STATION CLASS B HCP (1,400 METRES)

BROTHER BOOMER – fractious in barriers prior to start.

Race 4 –MANUKA PROPERTIES MAIDEN (1,600 METRES)

GAUDI GIRL – slow to begin; travelled wide from the 1,200 metres; hung in rounding the final turn; inclined to lay in throughout the final straight.

RELISHING TIME – lay out when over-racing passing the 1,000 metres.

LUCKY I'M HERE – crowded rounding the final turn.

LET IT RIP REGGIE – briefly inconvenienced rounding the final turn.

Race 5 – TRT PASTORAL CLASS B HCP (1,600 METRES)

KING MAWINGO was a late scratching at 11.49am after proving difficult to transport to the meeting.

MR ZIGMUND - lay out under pressure over the final stages.

PUSH PAUSE – made the final turn awkwardly.
