Race 1 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BENCHMARK 76 HCP (1430 METRES)

MY WORDIS - held up rounding final turn.

CORONATION KEITH – travelled wide throughout.

HELLOVA KNIGHT - held up rounding final turn until near the 250 metres

SHAMPZ AGAIN – hampered after start and lost ground

Rider T Baker (CORONATION KIETH) was observed to relax his ride approaching the end of the race when in contention for third placing - being beaten for that position by a nose. Mr Baker denied a consequential breach of Rule 131 (b) however after consideration of all relevant factors the Stewards found the charge proved. After further consideration as to penalty Mr Baker was fined \$750.00

Race 2 – HYGAIN MAIDEN (1430 METRES)

FOUR LETTER WORD – bounded on jumping and lost ground; lay out passing 200 metres and had to be straightened.

MISS NIC NAT – began slowly from wide draw; raced ungenerously early and middle stages.

SIRENE'S LILLY – travelled wide throughout.

LABBY ROCK, which was fractious in the barriers was declared a non-runner after being denied a start.

Deductions were 21 cents win – 18 cents place; 21cents place; 13 cents place.

Race 3 – LITTLE BEE FAMILY DAY FEB 11 MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

MAKIN A MINT – proved difficult to load and delayed the start – required to trial prior to next racing.

HELLOT – got back from wide draw then lost contact in the early and middle stages.

GEE GEES JOE BLOW – held up rounding the final turn.

SELKIE – steadied off heels 1,000 metres when tempo eased.

NICCO THE GREEK – lay in passing 250 metres and had to be straightened.

HEATHERS MEMORY – lay in throughout final straight.

SHAMMGOD- hung in throughout final straight.

FRYER HILL - travelled wide throughout.

GEE GEE RAINDROPS – lay in throughout final straight.

Race 4 – LADBROKES SWITCH MDN/CL1 (2100 METRES)

INDIGO GIRLS – got back after the start.

NORTHERN SPIRIT - raced wide rounding first turn.

Rider J Maskiell was dislodged from HAS THE LOOK after passing the post after breaking a stirrup leather. Mr Maskiell was attended by the medical personnel in attendance and passed fit to continue riding.

RACE 5 – THE MILLS NEW NORFOLK ELWICK STAKES (1100 METRES)

DECISIVE CHOICE – underwent a veterinary examination at the barriers and was passed fit to run after being contacted by another runner.

BELLO BEAU – jumped out abruptly at start and bumped.

REMUDA – proved very difficult to load- warned racing manners.

GALAN – badly hampered on jumping and lost ground.

HAPPY CLAN – jumped out at the start and bumped heavily.

ELLA EXCEEDS – began very awkwardly and shifted in and bumped heavily.

ESPUR – jumped in abruptly at start and bumped heavily.

Following the race rider J Maskiell reported feeling unwell and after a medical assessment was stood down from his remaining engagements. Mr Maskiell was advised that he will require a medical clearance before next riding.

RACE 6 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS LADY LYNETTE (1100 METRES)

G Catania replaced J Maskiell on DEROCHE.

ENTRAPPED – was a late scratching at 3:35pm after breaking through the barriers and becoming entangled in the front of its gate. Trainer Mr G McCulloch was advised that ENTRAPPED must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing. In addition a veterinary clearance being provided.

BOOM DOT COM – travelled 3-wide throughout. lay out passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

SUNSET GUN – hampered after the start.

LAKE BLED – hampered after the start.

HANNAH’S SONG – shifted out at the start.

JAJA CHABOOGIE – crowded wider passing the 150 metres.

DEROCHE -rider questioned – could offer no tangible excuses.

MISS TUPPENCE – crowded wider passing the 150 metres.

Apprentice C Jordan (BOOM DOT COM) was reminded of her obligations when riding out after permitting to shift ground out passing the 150 metres crowding runner to her outside wider on the track.

Stewards questioned rider G Catania with respect to the run of the well supported DEROCHE which was unplaced. In reply Miss Catania stated that after receiving a good run throughout, the mare had failed to let down when pressured.

RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE THOUSAND GUINEAS (1600 METRES)

MISS CHARLIE BROWN – stood flat-footed on jumping losing considerable ground.

KRUPT CANDY - travelled wide throughout- lay in final straight.

LADY MONACO – slow to begin

FANCIFUL FLYING – began awkwardly; over-raced in the lead; gave ground from 500 metres- post race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate and slow recovery.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK SUMMER CUP (2200 METRES)

TAVIRUN (NZ) – compounded passing 450 metres; checked when weakening 350 metres

WHITE HAWK – travelled 3 wide early stages; travelled 5-wide from 1,200 metres.

CREATIVE HERO – badly checked when on heels passing the 400 metres.

SWOOP DOG – held up 350 metres; raced in restricted room for short distance passing 150 metres.

SKYWAY STAR – had to steady passing 350 metres.

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – held up passing 400 metres; shifted ground inward passing 300 metres to continue to improve.

Stewards enquired into an incident passing the 350 metres where CREATIVE HERO was checked when awkwardly near the heels of the weakening SIR SIMON. After questioning riders and viewing video of the incident, it was established that passing the 400 metres, CREATIVE HERO was attempting to improve its position around the weakening TAVIRUN, however in doing so then became very awkwardly placed near the heels of SIR SIMON, which was compounding at this point. This resulted in rider B McDougall having to heavily restrain CREATIVE HERO off the heels of SIR SIMON, and when doing so CREATIVE HERO shifted in making heavy contact with TAVIRUN, with this resulting in both CREATIVE HERO and TAVIRUN becoming badly unbalanced. This incident was deemed beyond the control of any rider.

RACE 9 –WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 1 HCP (1430 METRES)

FAYERRA – travelled wide throughout.

AMANCAYA – held-up passing 400 metres.

PUNK PRINCESS – over-raced middle stages.

LAYLOW PLUCK – rider questioned – short back-up may not have suited.

Stewards questioned rider D Pires regarding the run of LAYLOW PARK which gave ground over the concluding stages. In explanation Mr Pires could offer no excuses other than the short back up may have proved detrimental to the gelding's chances today.
