Race 1 – PETER SHIPTON MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

BABY BOOM – jumped awkwardly; steadied off heels passing 800 metres when over-racing.

BE KINDER -jumped out at the start; travelled 4-wide throughout

GREYLING – hampered after the start and got back.

DADORABLE – hung in when making the first turn.

UPSET – lay out under pressure final straight and unable to be ridden to full advantage.

Race 2 – JACK BLAKE MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

GEEGEEPOWERPLUS - crowded and compelled to steady passing the 800 metres.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – slow over early stages.

GEE GEES BUZZ – stood flat-footed at the start; rider lost iron after the start with gelding losing ground when rider was recovering his iron.

Apprentice Miss T Johnston (ANOTHER PREDICTION) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131 (a) after permitting her mount to shift ground inward passing the 850 metres when not clear of VIVRE IS THE WORD which had to steady.

Apprentice Miss K Quilty (STATUE OF DREAMS) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131 (a) after permitting her mount to shift ground inward passing the 800 metres when not clear of GEEGEEPOWERPLUS which had to steady.

Race 3 –DOUG TOWNS CLASS 1 HCP (1200 METRES)

MY DIANA was a late scratching at 2:00pm due to no suitable rider being available.

ENSNARE – jumped out at the start and bumped heavily losing ground; travelled wide throughout.

UNDER HIS EYE – steadied off heels of weakening runner passing 400 metres.

ELIZA'S GOLD – slow away.

ETOSHA – travelled 3-wide during early and middle stages.

TILTHEREWARSYOU – fractious in barriers prior to start.

HOT RELATION – lost contact in middle stages- rider reported that despite pressuring the gelding there was little response, however of the latter stages HOT RELATION regained ground and found the line well. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no abnormality.

Race 4 –DICK BERTRAM MDN/CL1 (1600 METRES)

OXY DREAM – inclined to over-race in the lead.

PORT BERRY – jumped awkwardly.

DI'S A DANCER – slow in early stages.

ONE MORE PARTY – travelled wide throughout.

RECOMPENSA – bumped passing 200 metres.

RACE 5 – BILL DUNSTONE MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 62 HCP (2100 METRES)

TINY TIMMY- began very awkwardly and lost ground; raced wide from the 700 metres.

WINEGLASS BAY – over-raced in the middle stages; taken forward 1,300 metres when racing keenly.

BANCA SYD -raced keenly during early and middle stages.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE LAUNCESTON GUINEAS (1420 METRES)

MEDAL – jumped out at the start and lost ground.

HELLFIRE EAGLE – raced greenly through the home straight on the first occasion; raced wide from the 1,200 metres; compounded passing the 500 metres and not persevered with over final stages – veterinary check revealed no obvious abnormality- must trial before next racing.

ALPINE AFFAIR – crowded inward shortly after leaving the barriers; held up passing 400 metres until near 200 metres.

BUNDLE OF FUN – began awkwardly.

CHINCHERO -laid out under pressure throughout final straight.

Rider S Miller (MEDAL) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after moving inward shortly after leaving the barriers and bumping with ALPINE AFFAIR.

ASHY BOY was treated by the course veterinary following the race after suffering an episode of thumps.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES STAKES (1200 METRES)

DATE NIGHT – jumped out at the start and bumped.

AND BEYOND – underwent veterinary check and passed fit to run after becoming fractious when loaded into the barriers; raced fiercely through early and middle stages, refusing to settle, and constantly being restrained off heels.

GEE GEE SECONDOVER – hampered on jumping away.

LE CADEAU – hampered on jumping away; raced in restricted room in early part of the final straight.

ETHICAL DILEMMA – over-raced middle stages.

Stewards questioned trainer Mr M Trinder with respect to the improved form of race winner LIFEYBEAU. In response Mr Trinder stated that at its previous start on 14th January at Launceston, the gelding had been disadvantaged by its saddle slipping near the 800 metres and on 29th December 2021, despite finishing 6th, had been only 1.9 lengths from the winner. Mr Trinder added that he had expected a forward showing from LIFEYBEAU tonight. Mr Trinder's comments were noted.

RACE 8 – ROD THIRKELL-JOHNSTON AM CLASS 3 HCP (1400 METRES)

SAINT MAHJONG – travelled 3-wide throughout.

OUR SHINKANSEN – crowded shortly after the start and had to steady.

PRIVATE PAUL – raced 3-wide in early stages.

Apprentice E Byrne-Burke (OUR SHINKANSEN) was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground after permitting her mount to move outward passing the 200 metres when not fully clear of STELLADONI.

RACE 9 – JIM OSBOURNE OAM CLASS 3 HCP (1100 METRES)

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – tightened at start and got back when runners either side shifted ground.

RHYME WRITER – travelled 3-wide throughout.

Mr S Brazendale representing trainer Mr S Brunton admitted a breach AR 106 (2) in that being the person in charge of KEEPER'S TOUCH and REITE DEN BLITZ presented both runners with incorrect saddlecloths. After consideration of all factors, including Mr Brazendale's previously clear record, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$300.00
