GENERAL

Stewards received a medical certificate from M. Ulucinar after being indisposed at the TRC meeting on the 23 January 2022

Stewards questioned trainer Mr J Blacker with respect to the acceptance, and subsequent scratching of the top weight GLASS WARRIOR from the Armidale Stud Sydeston Cup at today's meeting. Particularly in light that Mr Blacker accepted with multiple runners.

In explanation, Mr Blacker stated that his intention, when accepting GLASS WARRIOR for the Sydeston Cup, was to use this race as a final lead to the Hobart Cup, particularly because he believed the gelding had peaked prior to the finish in his previous run at Hobart on the 23rd of January. However, Mr Blacker stated that because GLASS WARRIOR's trackwork, subsequent to acceptances, had exceeded his expectations he determined that no further racing would be required in preparation for the Hobart Cup.

While Mr Blacker's explanation was noted he was nonetheless reminded of obligations under ARR74.

Race 1 - EXAMINER / MERCURE KAWANA WATERS FASHIONS ON THE FIELD MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

DREAMALIL DREAM – stood flat-footed then raced erratically, dislodging rider: must trial prior to next racing.

FRYER HILL – raced greenly for a short distance after the start.

SEA NYMPH – tightened after jumping and lost ground.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – jumped out at the start and bumped

MIKAYLA'S PARIS – travelled 3-wide throughout; hung inward final straight.

DISCLEVABOY – held up rounding the final turn until passing the 150 metres. throughout.

RUSTIC CHARM – travelled 4-wide throughout; hung inward from 600 metres.

VAMP - rider questioned regarding performance; raced greenly throughout and reluctant to improve into a run passing 150 metres.

DREAMALIL DREAM, (Miss T Stalker) which stood flat-footed when the start was made, and then dislodged rider Miss T Stalker, must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing. Miss Stalker was examined by the course doctor and medical personnel and passed fit to continue riding.

Race 2 – LADBROKES PUNTERS ASSIST MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

FIGHTING GRACE – bumped at start and got back.

GREYLING – slow to begin; inclined to race greenly throughout.

KATENJAMMER – travelled very wide throughout.

LAGO APPROACH – travelled 3-wide throughout.

I'M KRUIPT – raced fiercely on heels for some distance in the middle stages.

SILLEACT – tightened and lost ground passing 150 metres.

WALL STREET BELLE – crowded and steadied passing the 600 metres.

BELL RINGER BOY – lay in throughout final straight; dislodged rider after the line.

GISELLE'S DANCE – crowded wider passing the 600 metres.

BE KINDER -travelled 4-wide throughout.

Stewards inquired to an incident passing the 150 metres where SILLEACT was tightened when between I'M KRUIPT, which shifted out and BELL RINGER BOY which, when improving, shifted in.

After questioning riders, and reviewing vision of the incident, it was established that I'M KRUIPT, which was hanging out prior to the incident, again shifted out despite Apprentice T

Johnstone's efforts to straighten the gelding, and in doing so crowded SILLEACT out into the running of BELL RINGER BOY, which simultaneous to I'M KRUPPT's hanging outward, shifted in abruptly at this point. Given all circumstances, including the intractability of I'M KRUPPT and BELL RINGER BOY Stewards determined no rider culpable.

Stewards inquired into an incident passing the 600 metres where WALL STREET BELLE was compelled to steady when racing awkwardly to the outside of GISELLE'S DANCE. After questioning riders and reviewing vision of the incident rider T Baker (GREYLING) was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131 (a) in that when shifting out to improve his position he was not clear of GISELLE'S DANCE which was directed off its rightful line of running and out onto WALL STREET BELLE which had to steady in consequence. In consideration of this matter the Stewards recognised both the remedial actions taken by Mr Baker, and GREYLING's tendency to race greenly at this point.

Apprentice Miss T Johnstone, in the presence of her employer Mr T Wells, was shown vision of the middle stages of the race for instructional purposes, after her mount, I'M KRUPPT, raced on raced near heels for some distance.

Following his engagement in Race 2, Jockey D Pires was examined by the course doctor and medical personnel relating to a finger injury. Mr Pires was stood down from his remaining engagements, with him requiring a medical clearance prior to next riding.

Race 3 – FASHIONS FOR FILLIES 20TH FEBRUARY MDN/CL1 (2100 METRES)

HAS THE LOOK – refused to jump away on terms losing considerable ground (50 metres); not persevered with thereafter- must trial prior to next racing.

HEZA CHARMER – tightened after start and got back.

Race 4 – STEVE'S LIQUOR BENCHMARK 62 HCP (1600 METRES)

HAMOGANY – held up rounding the final turn.

NEEDS TOASTING – over-raced in early and middle stages.

UBRIACO – held up rounding the final turn.

TORICAIN – over-raced middle stages

MARIPOSA – travelled wide in the early stages.

SAN YOU – lost near-hind plate near the 50 metres.

RACE 5 - GORGE SCENIC CHAIRLIFT ALFA GOLD SOVEREIGN STAKES (1200 METRES)

REMUDA – fractious behind the barriers and very slow to load- must trial; tightened after the start and lost ground; raced keenly passing 600 metres and had to be restrained.

ELLA EXCEEDS – travelled 3-wide in early stages.

OLA CAPRI – travelled 3-wide throughout.

Rider **B McCoull** (BELLO BEAU) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after moving inward passing the 1,000 metres when not fully clear of BOLD INSTINCT.

REMUDA, which proved difficult to load and delayed the start, must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing.

RACE 6 – ROY & DORA COGLAN MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1400 METRES)

M Ulucinar replaced D Pires on ARGYLE BEACH

SH'BOURNE REBEL – travelled 3-wide in the early stages.

DATE NIGHT – travelled 3-wide throughout

WARDELL – not persevered with over final stages; rider reported gelding felt indifferent in its actions; veterinary check revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 7 - LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP 23RD FEBRUARY 0-62 (1400 METRES)

SO I'M DREAMING was a late scratching at 1:45pm after the gelding was unable to be loaded on the horse transporter and bought to the meeting.

M Ulucinar replaced D Pires on SON OF FAITH.

TILTHEREWASYOU – fractious in the barriers- warning placed; travelled very wide throughout.

TEZLAH (NZ) – stood flat-footed on jumping losing considerable ground; raced ungenerously middle stages and had to be continually steadied off heels; checked passing 600 metres when attempting a marginal run.

DEEP KNEAD – jumped inward at the start and bumped.

GEE GEE DEVONBOY – travelled wide throughout.

Stewards inquired into an incident passing the 600 metres where TEZLAH (C Rawiller) was compelled to steady when racing between DEEP KNEAD (E Byrne-Burke) and TILTHEREWASYOU (B Louis). After questioning riders and reviewing vision of the incident, it was established that after passing the 650 metres TEZLAH had attempted to improve into a marginal run to the outside of DEEP KNEAD, and in doing so contacted the hind quarters of that runner. Shortly after DEEP KNEAD shift out and tightened TEZLAH which had to steady in consequence. After consideration of all factors, rider C Rawiller was reminded of his obligations with respect to attempting to improve into a run which had not fully developed, and Miss Byrne-Burke was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

Stewards questioned Mr J Keys the trainer of race winner HOT RELATION with respect to the gelding's improved performance. In explanation Mr Keys could offer no finite reason for the improvement, other than HOT RELATION may have benefitted from a reduced workload at trackwork.

RACE 8 – ARMIDALE STUD SYDESTON CUP (2100 METRES)

CREATIVE HERO – inclined to over-race in middle stages.

VALLABAR – raced in restricted room rounding the final turn.

Following the event DEROSA was attended to by the course veterinarian after suffering from heat stress. Trainer Mr C Thompson advised that DEROSA would now be retired from racing.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES ODDS BOOST EXOTICS BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1200 METRES)

GEE GEE TRUE STORY – bounded at the start and lost ground. held up for the majority of the final straight.

SUMMER FIRE – bounded at the start and lost ground

WARRIOR PRINCE – rider questioned- left a little flat footed rounding the final turn when tempo increased.

BANDINELLI – travelled 3-wide throughout.

GEE GEE QUEEN BEE – raced fiercely during middle stages.

AZARA – travelled 4-wide throughout.

Stewards questioned Apprentice Miss E Byrne-Burke regarding the run of well supported WARRIOR PRICE which was unplaced. In explanation Miss Byrne-Burke stated that the gelding had been left a little flat-footed when the tempo increased passing the 400 metres, however had thereafter made ground through to the finish. Miss Byrne-Burkes explanation was noted.
