GENERAL

Stewards questioned Licensed trainer Mrs N Webberley regarding a social media post showing her mounted on a horse in the practice starting barriers at the Brighton track when not wearing a safety vest and helmet. Mrs Webberley acknowledged her wrongdoing and subsequently admitted breaching the provisions of AR122 (1) – failing to wear a helmet and AR123 (1) – failing to wear a safety vest.

After consideration submissions as to penalty, the Stewards imposed a \$200.00 fine with respect to AR 122 (1) and a \$200.00 with respect to AR123 (1) with \$100.00 of each being fully suspended for 12 months pending no further breaches of gear related rules.

RACE 1 - W L SHIELDS MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

BAVARIAN FLYER – began awkwardly

BLACK EAGLET – improved on to heels and had to steady near 350 metres.

GEE GEE LITTLE JO – crowded passing 200 metres.

SHAMMGOD – hung out rounding final turn; held up until near 200 metres where it was taken wider to continue to improve.

GEEGEEPOWERPLUS – travelled 4-wide throughout.

HEAVENS HEARTBREAK – travelled 3-wide throughout.

Race 2 – LITTLE BEE EDUCATION CARE BM62 HCP (1100 METRES)

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – travelled 3-wide in early and middle stages.

GEE GEE ROY BOY – jumped in at the start and bumped.

GYMPINS (NZ) – slow into stride and got back.

SHARMA RAMA – travelled wide during early stages

UNCLOUDED (GB) – tightened at the start and lost ground.

SEGUIMIENTOS – hung out rounding the final turn.

Race 3 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS CLASS 1 HCP (1390 METRES)

UNVANQUISHABLE – began very awkwardly and lost ground; threw its head in the air when being steadied near the 1,000 metres,

GEE GEE CAN WIN- crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and got back; held up for a short distance passing the 250 metres.

UNDER HIS EYE – travelled wide in the early stages.

Stewards questioned Apprentice P Lui regarding his riding of KRUPPT CANDY from the 800 metres until the 400 metres, where there appeared an opportunity for Mr Lui to improve the filly from a rearward position. In explanation Apprentice Lui stated he believed that he would be best advantaged by following UNVANQUISHABLE into the race when it made its anticipated move forward. However, Apprentice Lui stated that UNVANQUISHABLE had not quickened as anticipated and this had left him further back than desired. Apprentice Lui's explanation was noted.

Race 4 – GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS STRUTT STAKES (2100 METRES)

MISS CHARLIE BROWN – trainer questioned regarding improved performance.

BUNDLE OF FUN – held up and unable to improve until passing the 150 metres.

GEE GEE MISS QUITA – over-raced in the early stages.

SILENT LOVE – tightened after the start and got back.

Stewards questioned trainer Mr A Trinder regarding the improved performance of winner MISS CHARLIE BROWN which was unplaced at its most recent run. In explanation Mr Trinder stated that the addition of blinkers and the step up in distance had proved beneficial on this occasion.

RACE 5 – CARBINE CLUB 3YO HCP (1100 METRES)

CHAMPAGNE CINDERS – travelled 4-wide throughout.

NEUTRALIZE -travelled 3-wide throughout.

EPIC SONG – trainer reported that the gelding got its tongue over the bit during the running.

Apprentice Miss E Byrne-Burke (CHAMPAGNE CINDERS) was observed to relax her ride approaching the finish, being beaten for 5th position by a nose.

Miss Byrne-Burke admitted a subsequent breach of AR131 (b) in that she failed to ride her mount out to the end of the race. After consideration of all factors the Stewards imposed a fine of \$300.00

RACE 6 – SCHWEPPE TASMANIAN DERBY (2200 METRES)

ASHY BOY – travelled wide early stages.

TANAKA SON – bumped heavily at start

MEDAL (NZ) – bumped heavily at start.

DODGY ONE – bumped at start

BOND STREET BEAU (NZ) - bumped at start

NO SURPRISES – raced keenly during middle stages.

THE NEPHEW - travelled 3-wide without cover throughout.

RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE BOW MISTRESS (1200 METRES)

FLORESCENT STAR – bumped on jumping away.

TAKE THE SIT – jumped out at the start; travelled 4-wide throughout.

REITE DEN BLITZ – bumped on jumping away.

JAJA CHABOOGIE – hampered at start; steadied off heels passing 900 metres; held up rounding the final turn; shifted in passing 150 metres to improve.

MISS TUPPENCE – travelled 3-wide throughout.

RACE 8 – LADBROKE IT! BM69 HCP (1600 METRES)

VIDEMANETTE – tightened rounding the first turn and lost ground.

FIGHTING FLOYD – had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the final straight.

STELLADONI – travelled 3-wide throughout.

IVORYMAN - performed below market expectations - veterinary check revealed no abnormalities.

WE DESERVE THIS – performed below market expectations - veterinary check revealed no abnormalities.

Stewards inquired into an incident rounding the first turn where VIDEMANETTE was tightened and lost ground when racing near the lead.

After questioning riders and viewing vision of the incident, it was established that negotiating the turn, WE DESERVE THIS (D Pires) had established a position one off the rails with HAMOGANY (E Byrne-Burke) to its outside, with VIDEMANETTE (B Vorster) racing tight to its outside and STELLADONI (T Johnstone) tight to the outside of VIDEMANETTE.

As the quartet left the apex of the turn, WE DESERVE THIS continued straight for a short distance while simultaneously STELLADONI was attempting to circle the runners to its inside and progress forward. This resulted in general tightening and VIDEMANETTE having to be checked out of its rightful line of running.

Stewards deemed no rider solely responsible however riders were reminded of their obligations that they leave sufficient room when in similar circumstances.
