RACE 1 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK DASH BM76 HCP (1,00 METRES)

BANDINELLI – bumped on jumping away; rider fined- failing to ride to end of the race.

DON'TBUCKME OFF – bumped on jumping away; hung out from 600 metres.

Rider Ms S Carr (BANDINELLI) was observed to relax her ride approaching the post when in contention for 3rd placing, eventually finishing 4th. Ms Carr admitted a resultant breach of Rule 131 (b) with the particulars being that she failed to ride the gelding out to the end of the race. After considerations of all factors, including Ms Carr's previously clear record with respect to this rule, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$750.00

RACE 2 – BEC THOMAS MAYOR OF GLENORCHY MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

ENCOSTA TORONADO – stood flat-footed at the start and settled well back- warning placed.

NINTH ANGEL - bumped at start.

DIVINE GYPSY – shifted in on jumping and bumped; hung in throughout final straight.

GEE GEES REBEL – denied clear running passing the 150 metres.

NIGHT MISSILE – travelled wide without cover throughout.

BROADWAY BABE – travelled 4-wide early stages.

HOT 'N' SWEATY – gave ground over final stages- veeterinary check revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 3 – LADSBROKES FAST WITHDRAWALS MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

VELOCE AQUILA – fractious in barriers prior to the start.

HAMPTON BAY – raced keenly in the early stages.

FIFE AND DRUM – crowded wider passing 500 metres.

FOUR LETTER WORD – bounded at the start; travelled 4-wide until the 800 metres; crowded wider passing 500 metres; made finishing run wide rounding the final turn- rider reported that the mare filly lay out from 500 metres and became unbalanced making the turn.

MISS NIC NAT – over-raced for a distance passing the 1,200 metres.

Stewards questioned Apprentice Miss E Byrne-Burke regarding FOUR LETTER WORD making the final turn wide on the track. In explanation Miss Byrne-Burke stated that after being crowded wider passing the 400 metres, FOUR LETTER WORD, which was inclined to lay out, then became unbalanced for distance, prior to regaining its stride once straightening for the run to the post. Miss Byrne-Burke's explanation was noted.

RACE 4 – SKIN LASER CLINICS MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

I'M KRUPT – bumped at start.

WAYNE'S ON STRIKE – bumped heavily at start and lost ground.

ZADE'S STORIES – hampered at start.

ALPINE LEDGEND – bumped at start

STARS OF GOLD - rider reported that the filly hung out throughout- veterinary check revealed no abnormality.

TENNESSEE BEACH – travelled wide throughout; had to steady near post when tightened.

Apprentice Miss T Johnstone (I'M KRUPPT) was severely reprimanded under AR 131 (a) after permitting her mount to shift inwards over the final stages and into the running of TENNESSEE BEACH which had to steady.

RACE 5 – MADELEINE OGILVIE MP MDN/CL1 (1600 METRES)

NOZTRABEEL – jumped away awkwardly; crowded approaching the post and had to steady.

ESSEX – lay out passing 200 metres

HELLOT – lay in under pressure throughout final stages.

NORTHERN SPIRIT -travelled 3-wide in the early stages.

PORT BERRY(NZ) – raced in restricted room and crowded passing 250 metres having to steady.

SPEED ROCK – travelled 3-wide throughout

Stewards inquired into an incident approaching the finish NOTRABEEL (B Muhcu) had to steady when inside HELLIOT (G Catania) which shifted in when laying in. Ms Catania was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.

Following the event rider Ms G Catania was stood-down for one race by the track medical personnel after suffering from breathing difficulties.

RACE 6 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 1 (1200 METRES)

D Pires replaced G Catania on Lake Bled

SHE'S RAUNCHY was a late scratching at 10:34pm due to no rider being available.

TWO DOLLAR TOM – travelled 4-wide throughout.

COPPER CHARM – rider questioned regarding performance – failed to respond when pressured. Veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.

POWERFUL PEBBLES – had to shift ground outwards passing the 100 metres to continue to improve.

SOCIETY BILL – blundered passing the 950 metres.

MY DIANA – began awkwardly

Stewards questioned Ms S Carr the rider of COPPER CHARM which performed below market expectations. In explanation Ms Carr could offer no tangible explanation. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.

RACE 7 – THE MILLS NEW NORFOLK THOMAS LYON STAKES (1400 METRES)

AND BEYOND - underwent a veterinary examination and cleared to start after becoming fractious following being loaded away- warning placed. Bounded on jumping and lost several lengths.

MANDELA EFFECT – steadied off heels 1,100 metres.

JUSTCANTA (NZ) – travelled 3-wide throughout; bumped passing 150 metres.

BLAZE FORTH – lay out passing the 200 metres.

SHOT OF IRISH – buffeted for some distance passing the 150 metres; raced in restricted room final stages; rider dropped whip passing the 200 metres.

BIOMETRIC (GB) – held up for the majority of the final straight, only obtaining clear running approaching the post.

SWOOP DOG – raced greenly throughout final straight; bumped heavily passing 150 metres.

DEROCHE – post race veterinary inspection revealed an elevated heart rate.

Stewards inquired into general tightening which occurred passing the 150 metres where SHOT OF IRISH was buffered on two occasions when racing in restricted room to the inside of SWOOP DOG.

After review it was established that passing the 200 metres, LIM'S CRUISER, when taken into clear running, was crowded wider out into the line of SHOT OF IRISH when outside the heels of BLAZE FORTH which was laying out under pressure. Simultaneously, SWOOP DOG, which was racing greenly, shifted in and bumped with SHOT OF IRISH, this resulting in SON OF IRISH being buffeted for a short distance. A little further on, SWOOP DOG shifted ground outward and bumped with JUSTACANTA, with this resulting in SWOOP DOG shifting back in and bumping heavily with SHOT OF IRISH which was unbalanced. Given the tractability of SWOOP DOG throughout the final straight, together with the general tightness of the field, no further action was warranted.

Ms G Catania (SHOT OF IRISH) accidentally dropped her whip passing the 200 metres.

Rider Ms S Carr (MANDELLA EFFECT) admitted a breach of Rule 132 (7) (a) (ii) the particulars being that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. After consideration of all factors Ms Carr's licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing today, up to and including racing on Sunday 20th February 2022. Additionally, Ms Carr was fined the sum of \$1,500.00

RACE 8 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS BM62 HCP (1400 METRES)

MAGIC KHAN – travelled 3-wide throughout.

Stewards questioned trainer Mr J Blacker with respect to the improved performance of race winner SILVER ROAD. In explanation Mr Blacker stated that a favourable draw and back racing on the Elwick track had assisted the gelding on this occasion.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES HOBART CUP (2400 METRES)

WHITE HAWK – steadied off heels passing the 1,550 metres when the tempo eased.

GLASS WARRIOR – held up briefly passing the 500 metres.

SH'BOURNE RENEGADE – steadied off heels passing the 1,600 metres when the tempo eased; post-race veterinary inspection revealed slow recovery.

CREATIVE HERO – travelled wide in the early stages.

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – travelled wide from the 1,600 metres.

SO ASTOUNDING – one nostril bleed- must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing.

EASTENDER – which finished well back, underwent a post-race veterinary which revealed no abnormality.

RACE 10 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS MB62 HCP (2,100 METRES)

CLIFTON DANSEUR – tightened at the start

TORICAIN – travelled 3-wide throughout.

Trainer Mr S Brunton representing himself and trainer Ms T Keyes, admitted a breach of Rule 106 (1), in that being the person in charge of ONE LOTTO and BANCA SYD did present both runners with the incorrect saddles and saddlecloth. After considering all factors, including Mr Brunton's previously clear record, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$300.00
