**RACE 1 – ELITE RACING SOLUTIONS MAIDEN – 1100 METRES**

**A LITTLE DECEIT** - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding having blood in its mouth due to a dislodged incisor cap.

**MELITON** – Continuously fractious in the barriers, a warning has been placed on its barrier manners. Raced three wide throughout.

**THE EAGLE ROCK** – Fractious before the start. Jumped awkwardly, got its head in the air and lost ground. Carried wider by Unedited shifting out over the final stages.

**EGAO** – Raced fiercely in the early stages of the race.

**STATUE OF DREAMS** – Momentarily held up on the home turn, layed in over the final stages of the home straight.

**HUSAVIK** – Bumped by Silver Persuasion shortly after jumping.

**SILVER PERSUASION** - Jumped awkwardly, shifted in shortly after contacting the hind quarters of Husavik.

**UNEDITED** - Shifted out over the final stages carrying The Eagle Rock wider on the track.

**EGYPTIAN STRYKER** – Continually steadied off heels rounding the 800 metres, held up on the home turn and layed in over the concluding stages.

### **RACE 2 – MERCURE SUNSHINE COAST MDN/CL1 - 2100 METRES**

**ALWAYS A WINNER** – Raced three wide in the early stages.

**FIFE AND DRUM** – Shifted out and bumped with No Surprises at the start, tired from the 600 metres, under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.

**INNOCENT PEGG** – Held up behind Star Wings on the home turn, layed in home straight.

**STAR WINGS** - Rider G Catania (Star Wings) was advised that she must ensure she rides her mounts out fully.

**NO SURPRISES** – Bumped with Fife and Drum shortly after jumping, hung in over the heels of Di's A Dancer over the final stages and had to be restrained.

**PAGE** – Raced three wide in the early stages, layed in over the final stages.

### **RACE 3 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 3 – 1200 METRES**

**ENTRAPPED** – Reared on jumping, as a result rider C Jordan lost her offside iron placing her at a disadvantage in the early stages when the mare shifted wider on the track as she was regaining her iron. A warning placed on the mare for rearing at the start. Stewards spoke with Trainer G McCulloch and rider C Jordan in relation to her riding instructions on the mare. Rider C Jordan stated that she erred in not endeavouring to steady her mount more than she had passing the 800 metres.

**BERRUTI** – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

**IRIS WEST** – Over raced in the early stages of the race.

**EIGHTY EIGHT DAYS** – Slow to begin; momentarily held up home turn.

## **RACE 4 – MAGIC MILLIONS 2YO CLASSIC – 1200 METRES**

**JAGUAR STONE** – Brushed with Vokes near the 500 metres.

**VOKES**- Brushed with Jaguar Stone near the 500 metres.

**ZULU ROSE** – Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulucinar to ride 1kg over the allocated weight, slow to begin, shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

Trainer A Trinder and rider H Coffey wished to view the official photo finish prior to correct weight. After viewing the photo finish they were satisfied and correct weight was given.

## **RACE 5 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN OAKS 3YO FILLIES – 2100 METRES**

**ASHMANIA** – Raced three wide in the early stages before obtaining cover near the 1600 metres, approaching the 1200 metres shifted three wide to improve to take up a forward position.

**PEARL RAIN** – Bounded at the start.

**PROSPETTIVA (NZ)** –Stewards spoke to rider L Neindorf in relation to the below market expectations performance of the filly. Rider L Neindorf advised his mount hung in, in the home straight and failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

**FOUR LETTER WORD** – Obligated to shift wider at the 150 metres to obtain a clear run.

**SILENT LOVE** – After performing poorly under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the filly to have mild signs of tying-up.

Stewards inquired into Gee Gee Miss Quita (B Muhcu) appearing to be placed in restricted room when Miss Charlie Brown crossed that filly leaving the home straight on the first occasion. Rider B Muhcu stated that his horse had started to over race at that point when receiving some pressure from Ashmania which was travelling to his outside and that in his opinion Miss Charlie Brown (T Baker) was clear when crossing. After reviewing the official films Stewards noted his comments, however advised T Baker that he should ensure he is fully clear before crossing in future.

## **RACE 6 – MAGIC MILLIONS 3YO/4YO CLASSIC – 1400 METRES**

**WARRIOR PRINCE** – Rider B McCoull advised stewards that the gelding had failed to respond to his riding. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.

**GEE GEES JENNIA** – Slow to begin.

**AZARA** – Carried wider on the home turn by Amancaya shifting outwards, layed in home straight.

## **RACE 7 – WWW.ELITRACINGSOLUTIONS.COM.AU BM68 - 1400 METRES**

**ARGYLE BEACH** – Raced three wide until the 850 metres, Rider I Toker was questioned on the below market expectations performance of the gelding. Rider I Toker stated that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

**SANCTION KING** – Shifted out on jumping.

**FIGHTING PHOENIX** – Checked after the start when Sanction King shifted out on jumping.

### **RACE 8 – LADBROKES FAST WITHDRAWALS BM62 HCP – 1600 METRES**

**BARJEEL** – Slow to begin.

**UBRIACO** – Held up behind Mariposa passing the 400 metres.

**HIGH MAINTENANCE** – Raced four wide from the 1000 metres

**HOT RELATION** – Raced three wide throughout.

**LET IT RIP REGGIE (NZ)** – Layed in away from Ubriaco near the 100 metres resulting in Son of Faith being tightened momentarily between it and the running rail. Rider I Toker (Let It Rip Reggie) was advised to exercise more care when his mounts shift ground.

**SON OF FAITH** – Tightened for room approaching the 100 metres.

Stewards reprimanded rider B Louis (Hot Relation) under the provisions of AR132(6)(a) for using his whip forward of the shoulder when in restricted room rounding the home turn.
