All race times were rescheduled and put back one race with Race 10 re-scheduled for 6.48pm. Rider T Doyle was transported to hospital for observation after being dislodged from his horse behind the barriers prior to the start of race 1.

RACE 1 – CONCEPT LOGISTICS INTERSTATE TRANSPORT MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

THE POODLE – Bounded out on jumping slow to begin (3L). Raced ungenerously throughout.

UPSET – Held up rounding the home turn, layed out under pressure in the home straight. Rider S. Carr was advised to exercise care when shifting ground outwards over the concluding stages.

RUSTIC CHARM – Fractious in the barriers. Slow to begin, restrained off heels of Selkie shortly after jumping. Warning has been placed on the gelding's barriers manners.

DRAMAZING – Fractious in the barriers. Warning continued on barrier manners, raced three wide throughout, bumped with Words of Kindness at about the 900 metres.

SHAMMGOD (NZ) – Raced in restricted room at about the 400 metres between Vivre Is The Word and Stars In The Night. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a puncture wound to the right fore cannon and a compression bandage was applied.

SOULITA – Crowded on jumping between Words of Kindness and Stars In The Night. Raced three wide with cover throughout.

WORDS OF KINDNESS – Over raced early and middle stages, bumped with Dramazing at about the 900 metres.

GOBBLE'EMUP – Reared over behind the barriers prior to the race dislodging rider T Doyle, under-went a veterinary examination which revealed abrasions to the left fore knee. Declared a late Scratching @ 1.05pm by order of the Stewards, stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Rider T Doyle was transported to hospital for further observation. Rider T Doyle must provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

All monies placed on the late scratching were to be refunded in full. All successful bets on horses prior to the time of withdrawal are subject to the following deduction in the dollar from the face value of the ticket.

RAEHEARTED – Shifted out on jumping

SELKIE – Caught wide early, checked entering the home straight.

Rider G Catania pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless Riding. The particulars of the charge were when shifting wider approaching the home turn (350M) Ms Catania allowed her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of SELKIE (A Darmanin). Resulting in rider A Darmanin checking his mount and losing his rightful position in running. Stewards took into account Ms G Catania's guilty plea and her good record under this rule. Ms Catania's licence to ride in races was suspended from midnight 2nd March until midnight the 9th March. Rider G Catania was advised of her rights of appeal.

RACE 2 – ELITE RACING SOULITIONS MAIDEN - 1400 METRES

ENCOSTA TORONADO – Stood flat footed and was slow to begin, warning continued on the gelding.

SWINGAPINGA – Raced three wide throughout with cover.

VELOCA AQUILA – Jumped awkwardly.

WARICA – Raced three wide throughout, over raced early and middle stages.

BROADWAY BABE – Checked at the 100m

ZEVA ROYALE – Raced three wide throughout with cover.

MONTE BIANCO – Layed in over the concluding stages

VAMP – Raced greenly in the final straight, rider reported that there may have been something amiss with the filly behind. Under- went a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormality could be detected.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Shifted in about the 100 metres

Rider E Byrne Burke (Another Prediction) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless Riding for allowing her mount to shift in at about the 100 metres, resulting in B McDougall (Broadway Babe) checking his mount. In not taking further action stewards were of the opinion that her mount may have been dictated to by the improving Saxon Mist which was to her outside and that rider B McDougall may not have had total purchase of the run to the inside of Another Prediction.

RACE 3 – SHEDCORPTAS CLASS 1 1400 METRES

DEEP KNEAD – Jumped awkwardly.

UNVANQUISHABLE – Jumped awkwardly and lost ground. Raced wide throughout.

ENSNARE – Raced back from the wide barrier, layed out rounding the first turn, raced wide throughout.

RICH CLAN – Raced wide throughout.

NINTH ANGEL – Jumped outwards at the start.

HERMAN'S BELL – Jumped awkwardly.

ELIZA'S GOLD – Stood flat footed and was slow to begin.

RACE 4 – TRANSMO TASMANIAN BM66 HCP – 2100 METRES

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – Fractious in barriers.

JOHN'S LAD – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

PERUN (NZ) – raced three wide throughout, layed in when placed under pressure in the home straight. Stewards spoke with rider Ms C Baker in relation to her whip use in the home straight with her master Mr B Baker. Stewards suggested in this instance she may have been better to ride hands and heels than use the whip.

COSTERO – Declared a late scratching @ 3.14pm on veterinary advice, the gelding was found to be lame in the off hind and will require a veterinary clearance prior to trialling or racing again.

All monies placed on the late scratching were to be refunded in full. All successful bets on horses prior to the time of withdrawal are subject to the following deduction in the dollar from the face value of the ticket

TINY TIMMY – Put its head down and missed the start as a result was slow to begin, settled well back

LET IT RIP REGGIE (NZ) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormality could be detected.

INDIGO GIRLS – G. Catania was accidently struck with the whip approaching the 100m.

RACE 5 – PFD FOOD SERVICES 3YO CLASSIC – 1200 METRES

TURK WARRIOR – Raced three wide early, over raced until the 800 metres, inclined to lay in in the home straight. Stewards questioned rider I Toker in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider I Toker stated that when placing the gelding under pressure at the 400 metres and again at the 100 metres that the gelding didn't show it's usual turn of speed and could offer no further explanation.

EPIC SONG – Slow to begin.

ETOSHA – Rolled in marginally at the 200 metres momentarily tightening Emily. Rider stopped and straightened.

EMILY – Momentarily held up behind Etosha entering the home straight. Tightened momentarily at the 200 metres when Etosha rolled in.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE ROYAL RAMBO QLTY– 1200 METRES

LIFFEYBEAU – Layed in under pressure in the home straight.

STREET TOUGH – Hampered by Le Cadeau which shifted in at the start and was slow to begin, held up home turn.

LE CADEAU – Jumped in at start and bumped with Street Tough.

FRAGMENT – Bumped with Our Little Ted at the start, raced three wide throughout.

GALENUS – Over raced early stages, shied away from the running rail approaching the 100 metres.

HELLOVA NIGHT – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

OUR LITTLE TED – Bumped with Fragment on jumping.

RACE 7 – ARMIDALE STUD VAMOS STAKES - 1400 METRES

DEROCHE – Tired from the home turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormality could be detected. Trainer B Campbell advised that the mare would now be retired.

YES BABY YES – Restrained off heels at about the 1200 metres.

QUEEN LA DIVA – Raced three wide throughout.

TAKE THE SIT - Bumped with Cha Boogie near the 150 metres.

ESTORIL PARK – restrained off heels off the tiring Deroche approaching the home turn.

BOOM DOT COM – checked off heels of Estoril Park on the home turn.

JAJA CHABOOGIE – Bumped with Take The Sit near the 150 metres and became unbalanced momentarily.

AYAHUASCA – Shifted in under pressure entering the home straight before being steadied and then shifted out.

QUEENS NEEDS – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

MISS TUPPENCE – Over raced early, restrained off heels of BOOM DOT COM at the 800 metres.

Rider A Darmanin (DEROCHE) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless riding for shifting in at about the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of YES BABY YES (B McDougall). Resulting in that rider having to restrain off heels.

Stewards reviewed an incident entering the home straight where Boom Dot Com had to check. After reviewing the incident stewards believe that Estoril Park (R Downey) had to momentarily restrain off heels of the tiring Deroche resulting in rider C Jordan (Boom Dot Com) then checking off the heels of Estoril Park which had rolled in marginally. Stewards did not attribute the blame to anyone rider.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP – 2400 METRES

HO HO KHAN (NZ) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

IN A TWINKLING – Raced wide to the 800 metres.

WHITE HAWK – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

EASTENDER - Tired from the 600 metres, beaten 38.7 lengths, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormality could be detected. Trainer B Campbell advised that the gelding would now be retired.

CAPTAIN COOK (GB) - Pulled hard early, Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormality could be detected.

SH'BOURNE RENEGADE – Raced three wide throughout.

SO ASTOUNDING - Jumped awkwardly at the start.

RACE 9 – STEVE LIQUOR MOWBRAY STAKES – 1600 METRES

LIM'S CRUISER – Bumped with Biometric on jumping.

MANDELA EFFECT – Restrained off heels of MYWORDIS at about the 800 metres. Obligated to shift wider entering the home straight to obtain a clear run.

JUSTACANTA (NZ) – Held up from the 400 metres until entering the home straight.

SHOT OF IRISH – Raced three wide early.

BIOMETRIC (GB) – Bumped with Lim's Cruiser on jumping.

BALERIC - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be lame in the left fore. A veterinary clearance will be required prior to the geldings next race start.

SWOOP DOG – Held up for a clear running approaching the 400 metres, steadied off heels near the 100 metres.

ETHICAL DILEMMA – over raced approaching the 800 metres and restrained off heels of Biometric then shifted wider on the track, raced wide from there onwards.

MYWORDIS – Layed out home straight.

AND BEYOND – Tightened for room between Mandela Effect and Lim's Cruiser at about the 200 metres.

DARK WANDERER – Rider B Muhcu was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the line.

RACE 10 – CITY OF LAUNCESTON BM62 HCP – 1200 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when stewards wished to view the official patrol films and speak with the official starter in relation to the manners of Gee Gee Bay Watch at the start. After viewing the patrol films and speaking with the starter. Stewards were satisfied that Gee Gee Bay Watch had not been denied a fair start and correct weight was given on the judges numbers.

FIVEFINGERDISCOUNT (NZ) – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with Freak On A Lead.

DEBRIEF - Slow to begin

THE MASTER SPEED – Shifted out abruptly at the 700 metres.

FREAK ON A LEAD – Bumped with Fiverfingerdiscount at the start. Took a tight run between Gee Gees Teardrop and Fighting Styx entering the home straight.

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – Dropped it's head on jumping unbalancing rider T Johnstone and was very slow to begin. The gelding must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormality could be detected.

FIGHTING STYX – Fractious in barriers.

KOOKABURRA – Over raced early and middle stages.

RACE 1

Trainer G White advised stewards that Selkie had a minor abrasion to the near side shin after its run.

RACE 5

Trainer G Stevenson (Turk Warrior) advised stewards that he was having blood tests done and will advise of results. Stewards to follow up further.

Trainer P Luttrell advised stewards that Alarah had bled from both nostrils in trackwork. Stewards advised Mr Luttrell of the provisions of AR79 (4)(b) in that the horse can not start in a race for 3 months and only after the completion of a satisfactory gallop over a 1000 metres in the presence of a steward.
