GENERAL

Trainer Mr S Gandy was fined \$50.00 under the provisions of LR13.3 for the late declaration of his riders for today's meeting in race 3.

Trainer Mr S Brunton was fined \$50.00 under the provisions of LR13.3 for the late declaration of his riders for today's meeting in race 3.

RACE 1 – EASTER GOOD FRIDAY RACING MAIDEN – 1120 METRES

VIVRE IS THE WORD – Checked off heels of Geegee Alpine Gold near the 700 metres. Stewards spoke with rider B McCoull in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider B McCoull stated that he thought the distance was too short for him, he also stated that his intentions were to be closer but was unable to due to the speed in the race. And then after receiving interference put him further back than anticipated. Stewards accepted his explanation.

YANOSHA – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival to the track as it had hit its head in the truck, superficial grazes to the left nostril, passed fit to race, raced three wide throughout.

MELITON – Over raced and got its head up and raced ungenerously about the 800 metres, Raced three wide throughout.

MOVE LIKE JAGGER – Shifted off the rail abruptly about the 600 metres, hung out throughout.

CORONATION VERONIC – Restrained at about the 150 metres, when Geegee Alpine Gold shifted wider on the track.

GEEGEE ALPINE GOLD – Hung out at about the 700 metres and lost ground. Hung out throughout, shifted out about the 150 metres to improve.

SWINGAPINGA – Hung out about the 600 metres.

Rider B McCoull was reprimanded under the provisions of AR208(2)(b) for failing to weigh in on returning to scale.

Rider P Lui was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift out about the 150 metres when not fully clear.

RACE 2 – CALL US FOR YOUR OUTSIDE CATERING MAIDEN – 1420 METRES

ENCOSTA TORONADO – Stood flat footed, slow to begin 3-4 lengths, trainer J Luttrell was advised must trial satisfactorily prior to racing again.

KATZENJAMMER – Raced three wide early.

RUSTIC CHARM – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, hung in approaching the 800 metres.

SILLEACT – Reared and jumped in the air unbalancing it's rider, slow to begin. Made contact with the hind quarters of Another Prediction on jumping. Trainer C Thompson was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

DRAMAZING – Raced greenly throughout.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Jumped outwards at the start, contacted on the hind quarters by Silleact.

RUNNING IN CIRCLES – Over raced in the early and middle stages, steadied off heels at about the 800 metres.

NIGHT MISSILE – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Stewards spoke with Trainer Mr C Thompson in relation to the manner in which he represented himself in the steward's room. Mr Thompson was advised in future to show respect and a professional manner when representing himself in the steward's room.

Stewards reviewed an incident after the winning post. Rider T Johnstone was advised that if racing tightly and receiving pressure she must ensure she calls and doesn't lay on the horse to her inside. Rider T Johnstone stated that her saddle had shifted marginally, and her horse started to lay onto Mr McCoull's mount. Stewards were satisfied that she had attempted to release the pressure by turning her horse's head outwards, however she was advised to ensure that she continues to ride in a manner after the post as not to cause any interference.

RACE 3 – LADBROKE LIVE BETTING 0-62 – 1620 METRES

Start of this race was delayed by two minutes due to the re-saddle of Hot Relation.

HOT RELATION – Re-saddled behind barriers prior to the start, raced three wide throughout.

TRAVELLING GIGOLO – Bumped with Skilendra at start, slow to begin.

RAVAGE – Eased off heels of Herman's Bells entering the home straight and shifted wider.

SILVER ROAD – Over raced early.

PHENOMENAL DANCER (NZ) – Steadied off heels of Ravage which had shifted wider to improve.

NORTHERN SPIRIT – Slow to muster early speed, over raced early stages.

SKILENDRA – Bumped with Travelling Gigolo on jumping, slow to begin. Held up behind Stelladoni approaching the 200 metres. Rider D Pires advised stewards that the mare failed to finish off and felt tight in front, under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be lame in the off fore. Trainer I Hay was advised that he must provide a veterinary certificate prior to the mares next start.

STELLADONI – Jumped awkwardly at the start and was slow to begin.

ALFRED STREET – Over raced early and middle stages.

Prior to correct weight rider C Baker (App) wished to view the official patrol films in relation to her horse's manners at the start. After viewing correct weight was declared on the judge's numbers.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES EASY FORM 2YO MAIDEN – 1120 METRES

GEEGEES SUNSHINE – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after making contact with Eased of heels of RavageDing Ding and was passed fit to race, hung out home straight.

SHOOTING NORTH – Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be dehydrated. Raced three wide throughout.

TOUGH IMPACT – Shifted out abruptly at the 700 metres off heels of Shooting North, raced greenly throughout.

DECISIVE CHOICE – Bumped with Ding Ding at the start.

DING DING – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked by Geegees Sunshine and was passed fit to race, jumped in at the start and bumped with Decisive Choice. Raced three wide throughout.

ESPUR – Rider dropped whip at about the 50 metres.

MISS PECULIAR – Bumped with Unique Glow at the start and shifted in abruptly.

UNIQUE GLOW – Bumped with Miss Peculiar at the start, shifted off the rail abruptly at about the 600 metres. Held up rounding home turn, bumped with Ding Ding in the home straight when attempting to improve.

RACE 5 – BECOME A MEMBER MDN/C1 - 2150 METRES

AMERICAN JEWEL – Slow to begin, raced fiercely middle stages, raced fiercely middle stages.

CASHMORE – Bumped with No Surprises at the start, got it's head up and over-raced early stages.

HAMPTON BAY – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

HAS THE LOOK – Raced three wide from the 1400 metres, hung out home turn.

LAUNNIE NIGHTS – Connections advised a change of tactics and that the gelding would attempt to be ridden further forward in tonight's event. Tactics adopted. Hung out over the final stages of the race.

PRINCE OF PASSION – Tired from the 600 metres.

STAR WINGS – Attempted to find cover and then caught wide throughout.

NO SURPRISES – Bumped with Cashmore at the start, over raced early stages, raced three wide from the 1400 metres.

RACE 6 – FOOT & PLAYSTED CLASS 1 - 1420 METRES

The start of this race was delayed for two minutes when on course staff had to remove a wallaby from the track at about the 600 metres.

BLACK EAGLET – Checked off heels of Unvanquishable at about the 1200 metres

MCSWEYN – Steadied off heels of Unclouded at about the 1200 metres

UNVANQUISHABLE – Checked at about the 1200 metres, had a tendency to over-race and raced greenly throughout.

POWERFUL PEBBLES – Checked at about the 1200 metres and got its head up.

UNCLOUDED (GB) – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with Needs More Love.

SWINGIN' GEORGE – Raced three wide throughout.

NEEDS MORE LOVE – Re-saddled behind barriers, jumped inwards at the start bumping with Powerful Pebbles which was then crowded for room between Needs More Love and Unvanquishable. Bumped with Unclouded shortly after.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES MEGA MULTI BM76 HCP - 1420 METRES

BOOM DOT COM – Steadied off heels of Sh'Bourne Rebel at about the 1200 metres.

SH'BOURNE REBEL – Crowded for room in onto BOOM DOT COM at about the 1200 metres.

ARGYLE BEACH – Bumped with Sanction King at the start.

GEE GEES QUEENIE – Shifted in when not clear at about the 1200 metres.

SANCTION KING – Bumped with Argyle Beach at the start.

Rider K Quilty (GEE GEE QUEENIE) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing her mount to shift in at about the 1200 metres, resulting in SH'BOURNE REBEL being carried in onto BOOM DOT COM which had to be steadied by its rider.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES CASH IN 0-62 - 1120 METRES

GEE GEE ALS PRINCE – Held up rounding the home turn attempted to shift wider to obtain a clear run to the outside of Little River Boy which was hanging and appeared to gallop on the heels of Little River Boy.

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – Jumped awkwardly unbalancing its rider and was slow to begin, Under-went a post race veterinary examination and was found to be distressed and had apparent pain in the hind quarters. Team Wells was advised that the horse must complete a satisfactory trial and submit a veterinary certificate prior to racing again.

SHARMA RAMA – Slow to begin

LITTLE RIVER BOY – Over raced in the early stages, hung out throughout, began to tire rounding the home turn, appeared to be galloped on by Gee Gee Als Prince. Trainer J Luttrell advised stewards on returning to his stables that the gelding had sustained an injury. Trainer J Luttrell was advised a veterinary certificate would be required to the geldings next race start.

STEFANIDI – Brushed the side of the barrier on jumping and was slow to begin.

RACE 9 – KEVIN SHARKIE BM68 HCP - 1220 METRES

GEE GEE LANETT – Shifted in at start bumping with Entrapped which had been crowded for room, held up rounding the home turn.

ALINJER – Slow to muster early speed, raced ungenerously in the middle stages, held up behind Gee Gee Lanett rounding the home turn and shifted wider to improve.

OUTBOUND – Jumped out at the start at the same time Gee Gee Lanett shifted in, crowding Alinjer and Entrapped, over-raced middle stages.

ENTRAPPED – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after rearing in the barriers and being taken out to examine. Passed fit to take its place. Jumped awkwardly at start and crowded for room shortly after, Trainer G McCulloch was advised that the mare must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

IRIS WEST – Raced three wide throughout.

TERRACOTTA (NZ) – Raced three wide throughout, held up over the concluding stages.

Stewards questioned rider I Toker in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider I Toker stated that the mare laid out badly and was on the wrong leg making it difficult to ride his mount out. Stewards noted his explanation.

RACE 5 – BE KINDER

Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin in relation to his tactics adopted on Be Kinder. Especially his vigour on entering the home straight and in the home straight. Rider A Darmanin stated that he had placed the mare under pressure to the 600 metres but it had failed to respond until he started riding quieter and his mount started to run on.
