### **RACE 1 - CONCEPT LOGISTICS MAIDEN - 1200 METRES**

**GLEN FORBES** – Rider A Darmanin reported he felt something amiss with the gelding's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. A veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing again.

**FLIGHT READY** – Slow to begin, over-raced in the early stage of the race. Layed in throughout the home straight.

**STARS IN THE NIGHT** – Shifted in when not fully clear of Yanosha approaching the 1000m. Stewards advised Rider M Ulucinar to exercise more care when crossing to lead in the future.

**CHEEKY WORD** – Knuckled on jumping.

**SALLY SUNSHINE** – Raced three-wide throughout the event.

### **RACE 2 – GOOD FRIDAY FUN DAY MAIDEN - 1400 METRES**

**GEE GEES FIFTHTEST** – Slow to begin.

**RUSTIC CHARM** – Hampered on jumping when Rose De Lune shifted out.

**SILLEACT** – Reared and became extremely fractious and broke through the front of the barriers. Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 6.18pm. All monies placed on the late scratching were to be refunded in full. All successful bets on horses prior to the time of withdrawal are subject to the following deduction in the dollar from the face value of the ticket.

- 12 - Monte Bianco 12cents win 4 cents place
- 4 - Swingapinga 7 cents place
- 14 - Silver Persuasion 7 cents a place.

A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. The gelding has been stood down from racing until the completion of two consecutive satisfactory trials.

Rider C Baker underwent a medical assessment by the on course doctor and Medical Edge attendants and was passed fit to fulfil her remaining riding engagements.

**ANOTHER PREDICTION** – Underwent a veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the barriers and was passed fit to race. Raced three wide, a warning has been placed on the mare's barriers manners. Shifted out on jumping bumping with Silver Persuasion.

**WORDS OF KINDNESS** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination, after slipping in the truck when being unloaded, passed fit to race.

**ARCUCCI** – Raced four-wide throughout the race.

**SILVER PERSUASION** – Hampered on jumping between Another Prediction and Rose De Lune.

### **RACE 3 – BILL RYAN MDN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES**

**GEE GEE CAN WIN** – Layed in the early stages of the event.

**GOOD LUCK BOB** – Hampered on jumping by Dramazing and lost its position. Over the final stages was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**DRAMAZING** – Shifted in on jumping and was slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running approaching and rounding the home turn behind Miss Pebbles which had shifted out.

**PORT BERRY (NZ)** – Hampered on jumping by Running on Circles and Saxon Mist.

**FURTHER NORTH** – Rider become unbalanced after being contacted by Miss Pebbles shifting out on the home turn.

**MISS PEBBLES** – Rider R Tan reported the mare locked its jaw approaching the 300m resulting in it shifting outwards abruptly, making heavy contact with Further North. Stewards spoke to Trainer J Blacker regarding the mares racing manners. The mare has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

**RUNNING IN CIRCLES** – Shifted out on jumping bumping with Port Berry, over raced early and middle stages.

#### **RACE 4 – LADBROKES LIVE BETTING CLASS 1 HCP – 1100 METRES**

Prior to correct weight, rider D Ganderton (Bynance, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetter) lodged an objection against Ensnare (M Ulucinar) being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference approaching the 250m. After considering the evidence, Stewards were of the view that Bynance had not established the run to the inside of Ensnare when the alleged interference took place and therefore the protest was dismissed.

**SQUARE DONUT** – Over raced in the middle stages of the race.

**GEEGEE ALPINE GOLD** – Bounded on jumping, resulting in the filly being slow away. Commenced to over raced in the early and middle stages.

**CAPTAIN DAVE** – Shifted in on jumping contacting Likiliku. Raced three wide throughout.

**LIKILIKU** – Crowded on jumping between Ensnare and Captain Dave.

#### **RACE 5 - PETER RABBIT 2 ON THE BIG SCREEN GOOD FRIDAY BM62 HCP – 1200 METRES**

**TIESTO** – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not started in a race for in excess of 24 months and was passed fit to race. Slow to begin.

**FREAK ON A LEAD** – Shifted in on jumping bumping with Needadollarbill. Tightened for running and bumped with Needadollarbill approaching the 100m.

**GEE GEES TEARDROP** – Commenced awkwardly and slow to begin as a result.

**DIAMOND BAY** – Commenced awkwardly and slow to being as a result. Layed in near the 800m as a result tightening Freak On A Lead. Raced wide early before commencing a three wide position passing the 800m.

Apprentice Chelsea Baker was found guilty of a charge under ARR 131(a) for careless riding at an inquiry into interference suffered by Lady Joker on the home turn. It was established that approaching the 300 metres, she permitted her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of Lady Joker, which was checked to avoid Diamond Bay's heels. Apprentice C Baker licence to ride in races was suspended for one Tasmanian race date to commence midnight 6<sup>th</sup> April and expire to expire midnight 10<sup>th</sup> April. In assessing penalty, stewards took into consideration her plea, inexperience, degree of carelessness and severity of the interference.

**STEFANIDI** – Slow to being and muster early speed.

#### **RACE 6 –MEMBERS JACKPOT DRAW BM62 HCP – 1400 METRES**

There was a delay to correct weight as Rider B Muchu wished to view the stewards Patrol Films after doing so he was satisfied, and correct weight was given.

**THE MASTER SPEED** – Shifted out on jumping bumping with French Heiress.

**SANCTION KING** – A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**ALINJER** – A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**MCSWEYN** – Bumped with Red Fiore and elected to settle back.

**GEE GEE ALS PRINCE** – Raced wide in the early stages.

**RED FIORE** – Bounded on jumping, shifted out contacting Mcsweyn.

**FRENCH HEIRESS** – Contacted and hampered by The Master Speed which shifted out on jumping.

### **RACE 7 – STEVE’S LIQUOR BM68HCP – 2100 METRES**

**ENCOSTA FIORENTE** – Fractious in the barriers, commenced awkwardly and was slow to begin as a result. Raced wide throughout the event.

**CLIFTON DANSEUR** – Slow into stride. Raced wide in the early stages of the event.

**ONE LOTTO** – Brushed the running rail near 1500m.

**PERUN (NZ)** – Stewards spoke to trainer A Fulton in relation to the apparent improved performance of the gelding. Trainer A Fulton stated that a drop back in class and a favourable run resulted in the improved performance of the gelding.

**INDIGO GIRLS** – Stewards granted permission for Rider S Carr to ride 1kg over the allocated weight. Shifted out on jumping and was slow to begin.

**SON OF FAITH** – Apprentice M Lawrence reported her gelding hung out throughout the race.

**GENERAL MAINTENANCE** – Over raced in the middle stages Held up approaching the 100m.

### **RACE 8 – BOOK NOW FOR GOOD FRIDAY LUNCH BM76 HCP – 1600 METRES**

**SUPER SWOOP** – Slow to begin.

**SH’BOURNE REBEL** – Layed in near the 1500m tightening Silver Road and Unvanquishable when obtaining a forward position. Rider B McCoull was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

**SILVER ROAD** – Bumped with Unvanquishable approaching the 1500m. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

### **TASMANIAN RACING CLUB – 27<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2022**

#### **RACE 2 - CREEK LODGE**

Trainer P Jones advised stewards that on returning to his stables that the gelding had some tenderness to its near side front leg.

#### **RACE 2 - A LITTLE SHADY**

Trainer S Lockhart advised stewards the filly pulled up shin sore and has now been sent for a spell.

#### **RACE 4 – SELKIE**

Trainer G White advised stewards that on returning to his stable the filly required four tooth caps to be removed.

#### **RACE 6 – SETPLAY**

Trainer J Luttrell advised stewards that on returning to his stable and the gelding performing poorly in its race that he requested a veterinary examination that revealed the gelding to have an abscess in its off side front foot. He advised that he will re-assess the racing future of the gelding after completing a satisfactory trial

#### **RACE 7 – NORTHERN SPIRIT**

Trainer S Carr advised stewards that the mare has been disappointing since winning her last start on the 13<sup>th</sup> February 2022. After crossing from a wide barrier and working hard to cross, the mare failed to respond once placed under pressure. The mare has now been sent for a spell.
