Comments / Explanations:

Stewards will inquire into the reasons for M Lawrence notifying trainers that she would not be fulfilling the rides she had been declared on for tonight's meeting.

RACE 1 – BOOK NOW FOR EASTER FRIDAY LUNCH MAIDEN – 1600 METRES

There was a delay to Correct weight as Rider T Baker wished to view the official patrol films of the home turn. After doing so he was satisfied, and correct weight declared on the judges numbers.

ALWAYS A WINNER – Rider I Toker was issued with a severe reprimand under AR 131(a) for Careless Riding for crossing GEE GEE OTHERWORDS (C Jordan) when insufficiently clear near the 1250m.

HELLOT – Obligated to shift wider making the home turn to obtain clear running. Layed in under pressure in the home straight.

JUST FOR CURIOSITY – Bumped and carried wider on the home turn when, STRAWBERRY KISS shifted out.

SPEED ROCK – Held up for a clear run from the home turn until approaching the 200m.

STRIKE IMPACT – Carried out on jumping by GEE GEE OTHERWORDS.

GEE GEE OTHERWORDS – Checked near the 1250m.

GEE GEES FIFTHTEST – Stood flat footed and lost four lengths on jumping. A warning has been issued.

NOBLE HERO – Raced three wide in the early stages. Hung in entering the home and as a result B McCoull was unable to ride his mount out until the 100m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. A warning has been issued on the racing manners of the gelding.

BE KINDER – Hampered and held up for clear run entering the home straight, when Noble Hero hung in.

LADY OF VIENNA – Raced four wide in the early stages.

MISS SLEUTH – Commenced to over race and hang in when the pace eased near the 1200m tightening the running of ONE MORE PARTY.

ONE MORE PARTY – Placed in restricted room approaching the 1200 metre turn tightening YOUR SHUFFLE.

YOUR SHUFFLE – Tightened and steadied off the heels of ONE MORE PARTY near the 1200 metres.

STRAWBERRY KISS – Raced in restricted room on the home turn, before shifting out and bumping with JUST FOR CURIOSITY.

RACE 2 – LIVE OUTSIDE ENTERTAINMENT GOOD FRIDAY MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

URUGUAY – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to compete.

WILD DESTINY – Jumped awkwardly. Shifted in at the 1050m checking SOULITA. At a subsequent inquiry Rider I Toker was found guilty under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of SOULITA, resulting in that mare having to be checked by its rider. After considering rider I Toker's very good record under this rule and the severity of the interference his licence to ride in races has been suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date. This will commence midnight 15 April 2022 and expire midnight 18 April 2022.

WILD JACK – Compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer G Hodges was advised of the provisions of AR79(4), A horse which, in the opinion of the Stewards, has had an attack of bleeding must not, without permission of the Stewards: (a) be trained, exercised or galloped on any racecourse for a period of 2 months after the attack of bleeding; (b) start in any race for a period of 3 months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1,000 metres in the presence of a Steward.

BLITZEM TYCOON – Fractious in the barriers and bounded out at the start unbalancing the rider. A warning has been placed on the barrier manners of the mare.

SOULITA – Checked at the 1050m by WILD DESTINY crossing when not clear.

FIRE TIGERESS – Raced three wide. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a puncture wound to a blood vessel to the inside of the near hind cannon.

MYSTICAL VIXEN – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with URUGUAY. Raced four wide.

RACE 3 – GOOD FRIDAY FAMILY FUN DAY CLASS 1 HCP – 1100 METRES

VETLANDA –Contacted the running rail passing the 600m.

COPPER CHARM –Jumped awkwardly. Steadied making the 800m turn when LIKILIKU hung in.

LIKILIKU – Raced greenly and hung in throughout before compounding on the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

SWEETSOP – Rider A Darmanin was questioned on his riding tactics adopted on the mare as he had tailed the field and was beaten a considerable distance. He stated that after beginning fairly he had ridden with some vigour but due to the fast pace set by the leaders he had been unable to maintain contact with the field. He then elected not to ride out over the concluding stages as there was no chance of improving his position. He further added that he was disappointed with the performance but did not feel anything amiss with the mare today, and that dropping back to the 1100m may not have suited. A post-race veterinary examination of SWEETSOP revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4 – PETER RABBIT 2 ON THE BIG SCREEN GOOD FRIDAY CLASS 3 HCP – 1200 METRES

There was a delay to correct weight as Rider R Tan (TERRACOTTA) wished to view the official patrol films of the home straight. After doing so he was satisfied, and correct weight was declared on the judges numbers.

FIVEFINGERDISCOUNT – Hampered momentarily when crossed by Border Protection near the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

BORDER PROTECTION – Shifted in when not clear of FIVEFINGERDISCOUNT near the 500 metres. Apprentice P .Lui was issued with a severe reprimand under AR131(a) for Careless Riding in not taking more severe action the low level of the interference was taken into account.

PEACE UPON YOU – Tightened on jumping by Border Protection shifting out. Over raced in the middle stages when placed under pressure, bumped near the 50m by TERRACOTTA (NZ) shifting out.

TERRACOTTA (NZ) – Shifted out under pressure near the 50 metres.

RACE 5 – THANKS JANE HOWLETT MLC BM62 HCP – 1200 METRES

GEE GEE PLANE –Raced three wide.

HERO OF ROMANI – Rider E Byrne Burke was advised that she must ensure she rides her mount out fully to the finish.

ENSNARE –Jumped awkwardly.

TEZLAH (NZ) –Inconvenienced at the start when tightened by ENSNARE shifting out.

OUR SHINKANSEN –Held up on the home turn.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES EASY FORM CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

BELMISTA –Slow to begin.

DREAMING TORONADO –Inconvenienced at the start when EIGHTY EIGHT DAYS shifted out on jumping.

LE MONDE DE LUCAS –Over-raced in the early stages.

EIGHTY EIGHT DAYS –Jumped awkwardly and shifted outwards.

SWINGIN' GEORGE –Over raced and lost ground when being steadied near the 900m.

RACE 7 – FREE GATE GOOD FRIDAY RACING 0-62 – 1400 METRES

GEE GEE ALS PRINCE –Held up for a clear run on the home turn when attempting to progress to the inside of STELLADONI when there was insufficient room.

NEEDAREIN –Slow to begin

SILVER ROAD –Raced three wide from the 900m.

GEEGEES ROCK OPERA –Shifted out under pressure and raced very wide in the home straight. Stewards advised P Lui that he should be endeavouring to correct his mount to ensure he does not cover more ground than necessary.

RACE 8 – FREE KIDS GOODY BAG GOOD FRIDAY BM68 HCP – 1400 METRES

DATE NIGHT –Jumped awkwardly.

ASSARANCA –Over raced making the 800m turn.
