***Comments / Explanations:***

*Rider B Muhcu was kicked behind the barriers and was unable to fulfil his riding commitments. Rider B Muhcu was advised he must submit a medical clearance prior to riding, trackwork, trials or race riding.*

**RACE 1 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BENCHMARK 76 HCP (1390 METRES)**

Correct weight was delayed when rider T Baker wished to view the official photo finish. After doing so he was satisfied and correct weight was declared on the judges numbers.

**TAVIRUN (NZ)** - Layed in under pressure from the 200m.

**VALLABAR** - Raced three wide in the early and middle stages.

**ROMARY** – Shifted out over the final 100 metres. Rider T Johnstone was advised to straighten her mount earlier than she had done on this occasion.

**SKYWAY STAR** - Held up over the final 50 metres when ROMARY shifted out marginally.

**RACE 2 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN (1390 METRES)**

The start of this race was delayed five minutes due to FURTHER SHE GOES being cast in the barriers.

Rider A Darmanin wished to view the official patrol films in the home straight prior to correct weight, after viewing correct weight was given on the judge's numbers.

**MACS RELAXED** – Fractious in the barriers, warning issued. Jumped inwards and then shifted out bumping with WORDS OF KINDNESS. As a result was slow to begin. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

**SWINGAPINGA** - Kicked out in the barriers. A pre-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Dipped on jumping.

**FURTHER SHE GOES** – Declared a late scratching at 1.51pm on veterinary advice after becoming cast in the barriers. The mare has been stood down from racing until a veterinary clearance and the completion of two satisfactory trials. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on FURTHER SHE GOES be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 1.51pm:

3 cents in the dollar for the win # 5 POP EYE THE SAILOR  
2 cents in the dollar for the place #5 POP EYE THE SAILOR  
11 cents in the dollar for the place #4 DISCLEVABOY  
12 cents in the dollar for the place #8 ROSE DE LUNE

**WORDS OF KINDNESS** - Slow to begin. Bumped with MACS RELAXED shortly after the start when that horse shifted out.

**CLARA KAREN** - Rider E Byrne Burke reported to stewards that the filly had started to choke down approaching the 600 metres. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow heart rate recovery.

### **RACE 3 –UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS MAIDEN (1200 METRES)**

**DASHING KNIGHT** – Under-went a post-race veterinary examination due to poor performance, however no obvious abnormality could be detected.

**GOLD PROOF** - Checked after the start when CORONATION VERONIC shifted in and it shifted out. Laid in and brushed the rail at the 400 metres. Under-went a post race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

**CRYSTAL PALLAZO** - When queried on the apparent improved performance today trainer Ms R Hall stated that the quality of today's field was weaker than previous races and that the rider had ridden to her instructions to a tee.

**DEB'S DREAM** – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination as the mare had not started in a race for in excess of 12 months. Declared a late scratching at 1.21pm as the mare showed signs of a heart irregularity. The mare will require a veterinary certificate with the satisfactory results of an ECG and a 1000 metre gallop in the presence of a steward.

**SH'BOURNE DE LAGO** - Raced three wide.

**CORONATION VERONIC** - Shifted in on jumping checking GOLD PROOF. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed small minor skin graze to the near hind pastern.

**HER THOUGHTS** - Held up near the 250 metres before shifting wider to obtain a clear run.

**ZULU ANGEL** - Shifted out on jumping and bumped with SH'BOURNE DE LAGO.

**RACE 4 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS MDN/CL1 (1600 METRES)**

**GOOD LUCK BOB** - Slow to begin, and slow to muster early speed. Carried wider on the home turn by DIVINE GYPSY shifting out. When queried rider reported he felt something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

**MELITON** - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**DIVINE GYPSY** - Change of tactics to be ridden further back. Tactics adopted.

**RACE 5 – LADBROKES SAME RACE MULTI BENCHMARK 62 HCP (1600 METRES)**

**UNVANQUISHABLE** - Over raced in the middle stages.

**RED FIORE** - Compounded over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

**RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 62 HCP (1390 METRES)**

**IRIS WEST** - Raced wide throughout. Rider P.Lui stated it's was his intentions to ride forward, however he ended up being caught wider than what he anticipated.

**DID YOU DECIDE** - Over raced and hung out making the turn at the 1200m.

**FREAK ON A LEAD** – Layed in under pressure entering the home straight.

**RICH CLAN** - Raced three wide throughout.

**RACE 7 – LITTLE BEE EDUCATION CARE BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1100 METRES)**

**REITE DEN BLITZ** - Bounded on jumping and slow into stride. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**ENTRAPPED** - Slow to begin.

**NEV'S BOY** – Stewards granted permission for rider I Toker to ride 1.5kg over the allocated weight as there was no other rider available. Rider I Toker was reprimanded

under the provisions of AR131(b) for using his whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

### **RACE 5**

Rider A Darmanin was found guilty of a charge under the provisions of AR129(2) for failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures on BE KINDER, from entering the home straight until the winning post. Rider A Darmanin’s licence to ride in races was suspended for four Tasmanian race dates. In determining penalty stewards took into account his record under this rule, his cooperation during the inquiry and the circumstances surrounding the race, including that the horse had jumped awkwardly and had settled well back. Rider A Darmanin was reminded of his rights of appeal.

## **TASMANIAN RACING CLUB MEETING 27th March, 2022**

### **RACE 7**

Trainer T Keys pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR106(1) for presenting Lucky Lil and Ravage into the mounting yard with the incorrect saddles and saddlecloth numbers. Trainer T Keys stated that she had been in charge of both horses when they were presented for racing. Trainer T Keys was fined the sum of \$300. Trainer T Keys was reminded of her right to appeal.

### **RACE 1**

ONE MORE PARTY – Trainer B McShane on returning to his stables advised stewards that the mare had pulled up lame in both front fetlocks. Trainer B McShane was advised that a veterinary certificate prior to racing would be required.
