***Comments / Explanations:***

*Rider D Parish was indisposed for today's meeting after an incident at trackwork. A medical clearance prior to riding trackwork, trials or races will be required.*

*Race 6 – Trainer S Brunton was fined \$50 under the provisions of LR.13.3 for the late rider declaration of AMANCAYA.*

**RACE 1 – MONOTONE 2YO MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)**

**HAPPY CLAN** – Jumped awkwardly and bumped with JUST A NEEDS, raced wide throughout.

**SHARE THE GOLD** – Over raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

**ZULU ANGEL** – Lay in nearing the 600 metres.

**ELMAJAY** – Layed out approaching the winning post.

**JUST A NEEDS** – Bumped at the start, raced wide throughout.

**PIIINK BEAUTY** – Stewards questioned rider C Jordan in relation to the below market performance of the filly. Rider C Jordan stated her instructions were to get cover, rider reported the horse failed to respond under pressure. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**SHE'S BLUFFING** – On returning to scale it was reported the horse was galloped on, on the off hind during running.

**STARCADIA** – Slow to begin then shifted in abruptly and had to be straightened. Had to be steadied and lost ground at the 600m, held up on the home turn, raced greenly throughout.

## **RACE 2 – LADBROKES LIVE BETTING MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)**

**AFRICAN THUNDER** – Tightened at the start by SH'BOURNE DE LAGO.

**BANCA TOM** – Jumped outwards at the start tightening FLICKA ON.

**EAGLE STREET** – A course announcement was made that the gelding would be racing in Blinkers first time.

**GEE GEES JOE BLOW** – Raced wide to the 600 metres, over raced middle stages of the race.

**MOVE LIKE JAGGER** – Jumped out at the start and bumped with I'M BACK.

**SWINGAPINGA** – Raced wide throughout.

**SH'BOURNE DE LAGO** – Shifted out abruptly on jumping and tightened AFRICAN THUNDER. Bumped with I'M BACK shortly after when shifting back in. Bumped with I'M BACK at the 1000 metres and carried wider.

**ZADE'S STORIES** – Shifted out abruptly on jumping & tightened GOLD PROOF.

**FLICKA ON** – Jumped awkwardly at the start and tightened by BANCA TOM.

**I'M BACK** – Bumped with SH'BOURNE DE LAGO at the start, raced wide throughout.

**GOLD PROOF** – Tightened at the start by ZADE'S STORIES and was slow to muster early speed. Over raced in the early stages, layed in and raced greenly throughout. Stewards questioned rider T. Stalker on the tactics adopted today due to the horse's poor performance. Rider T Stalker said she was placed at a disadvantage due to the horse laying in and racing with a high head carriage throughout. Rider T Stalker said she believed the horse reacted to the cross-over nose band which had been a gear change made prior to racing. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

## **RACE 3 – LADBROKES EASY FORM MDN/C1 - (1600 METRES)**

**MELITON** – Jumped awkwardly throwing its head in the air. Hung out making the 1400 metre turn.

**JUST FOR CURIOSITY** – Slow to begin.

**NINTH ANGEL** – Raced four wide in the middle stages due to the slow pace.

**STRIKE IMPACT** – A course announcement was made that STRIKE IMPACT wore blinkers which was not shown in the official race program.

**WORDS OF KINDNESS** – Rider C. Baker was reprimanded under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(i) for using her whip on consecutive strides on one occasion prior to the 100 metres.

**VAMP** – Layed in making the 600 metre turn.

## **RACE 4 –SALTERS HIRE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1200 METRES)**

**REDOLLIX** – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 8.27am after injuring itself at the trainer's property. Trainer S Carr was advised a veterinary certificate will be required prior to racing again.

**FAYERRA** – The rider reported the horse hung out throughout the race.

**OLYMPIC HONOUR** – Slow to begin.

**CRYSTAL PALLAZO** – Resaddled behind the barriers delaying the start by two minutes. Jumped inwards tightening OLYMPIC HONOUR at the start.

**LE MONDE DE LUCAS** – Rider T Baker reported the horse felt uncomfortable in the run. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Follow up required.

**GEE GEE SNOWFLAKE** – Held up from the 400 metres until entering the home straight. Had to be steadied off the heels of Needs a Flutter at about the 250 metres.

**ROCKYMOUNTAINHIGH** – Rider A Darmanin advised that the mare failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

**NEED A FLUTTER** – Raced three wide throughout. Rider C. Jordan was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless Riding in that approaching the 250 metres she allowed her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of GEE GEE SNOWFLAKE. In determining penalty Stewards took into account the shift from the inside.

#### **RACE 5 – AVISO TAS PINK CUP DAY MAY 22 CLASS 3 HANDICAP - (1400 METRES)**

**IMAGINE HOWE** – Correct weight was delayed when rider B. McCoull (IMAGINE HOW) wished to view the official patrol films for alleged interference on the home turn. After viewing rider B. McCoull did not proceed with his objection and correct weight was declared on the judge's numbers. Brushed with FREAK ON A LEAD entering the home straight. Shifted wider in the home straight and brushed with FREAK ON A LEAD on two occasions inside the 200 metres

**FREAK ON A LEAD** – Brushed with IMAGINE HOW entering the home straight. Shifted wider on the track in the home straight and brushed with IMAGINE HOW on two occasions inside the 200 metres.

**SET PLAY** – Under-went a post-race veterinary examination for poor performance which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. The gelding has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial over a distance greater than 800 metres. Trainer advised stewards the gelding will now be retired.

**MERV DECIDES** – Held up from 400 metres until entering the home straight.

**STEFANIDI** – Slow to begin, checked off heels of SET PLAY which shifted out shortly after the start, slow to muster early speed.

#### **RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 62 HCP (1100 METRES)**

**IVORYMAN (NZ)** – Held up for a clear run on the home turn behind KEEPER'S TOUCH then held up again from the 200m to the 100m behind ENSNARE.

**COPPER CHARM** – Rider A Darmanin advised that the filly failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer J Flannery advised stewards that the filly would now be spelled.

**AMANCAYA** – Bounded on jumping.

**OUR SHINKANSEN** – Jumped awkwardly, checked off the heels of Ensnare shortly after the start.

**BETHPAGE** – Blundered on jumping, raced wide throughout.

#### **RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 76 HCP - (1200 METRES)**

**FIRST ACCUSED** – Held up from the 400 metres until entering the home straight.

**WARRIOR PRINCE** – Bumped with FLOURISHING FUTURE shortly after the start and then bumped with DON'TBUCKME OFF shortly after.

**DON'TBUCKME OFF** – Jumped outward at the start and crowded WARRIOR PRINCE out onto FLOURISHING FUTURE. Raced three wide to the 600 metres.

**FLOURISHING FUTURE** – Bumped with WARRIOR PRINCE shortly after the start. Tired in the home straight. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

**RACE 8 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM 76 HCP (1600 METRES)**

The start of this race was delayed due to the Sunshine Coast running behind schedule.

**SHAMPZ AGAIN** – Slow to begin.

**STORMONT** – Slow to begin, under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities. Follow up with trainer required.

**ALINJER** – Slow to begin and raced ungenerously in the early stages.

**RACE 9 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BM 62 HCP - (2100 METRES)**

**ONE LOTTO** – Slow to begin, raced three wide to the 1400m

**GOOD LUCK BOB** – Slow to begin.

**GEE GEE CAN WIN** – Raced three wide to the 1400 metres, then again from the 800 metres.

**RED FIORE** – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to take its place in the field.

**HELLOT** – Fractious in the barriers, bumped with INDIGO GIRLS on jumping and over raced in the early stages.

**INDIGO GIRLS** – Bumped with HELLOT on jumping.

**STELLADONI** – Rider T Baker reported that the mare was running over the distance for the first time and failed to run the distance.

## **ADDENDUM**

### **TASMANIAN TURF CLUB 9 March 2022**

#### **RACE 6**

Stewards concluded an inquiry into the reasons POWERFUL PEBBLES, UNVANQUISHABLE and BLACK EAGLET all checked approaching the 1200 metres. It was ascertained that NEEDS MORE LOVE had thrown its head in the air and had started to race ungenerously as FINXY ridden by D Pires had attempted to cross and sit outside the leader. On viewing the official patrol films stewards were satisfied that FINXY had been clear to cross. Stewards took no action due to the racing manners of NEEDS MORE LOVE.

### **DEVONPORT RACING CLUB 18 April 2022**

#### **RACE 7**

Stewards spoke with trainer G Stephenson and rider C Baker in relation to the tactics adopted on GREGORIAN CHANT (NZ) after previously winning at Launceston on 6 April 2022. Rider C Baker stated that her instructions were not to push the mare too hard early as it would affect her racing manners due to her being difficult to ride. It was rider C Baker's intentions to sit behind ROCK THE BOWLER and be carried into the race. However, rider C Baker found it difficult to maintain a position closer to the field without riding in a manner contrary to which she had been instructed. Stewards then questioned trainer G Stephenson who confirmed the instructions given on the day. Also confirming that the horse is a difficult horse to ride. After confirming with both rider and trainer stewards accepted the explanation given.
