***Comments / Explanations:*****RACE 1 –KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP - (1009 METRES)**

**GEE GEES BUZZ** – Bounded on jumping, bumped with LIKILIKU shortly after, raced three wide throughout.

**DADORABLE** – Inclined to lay in throughout the home straight.

**LIKILIKU** – Commenced awkwardly shortly after bumped with GEE GEES BUZZ. Raced greenly approaching the 600m.

**RACE 2 – LADBROKES LIVE BETTING MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)**

**ALPINE AVIATOR** – Got its head up and over raced early and middle stages. Raced wide throughout.

**LION ACADEMY** – Rider M Ulucinar reported that the gelding layed in throughout the race. Entering the home straight the gelding layed in and inconvenienced VENTURA COUNTY which was carried in onto EGYPTAIN STRYKER. Raced wide throughout.

**ANJERO** – Declared a late scratching by the order of stewards at 8:28AM due to no available rider.

**EGYPTIAN STRYKER** – Restrained of the heels of SOULITA approaching the 800m. Bumped with ZEVA ROYALE approaching the 600 metres.

**EIGHT MARGARITAS** – Fractious in the barriers. A warning has been placed on the mare's barrier manners.

**HUSAVIK** – Shifted out on jumping bumping ZEVA ROYALE, EGYPTIAN STRYKER and SOULITA.

**QUEEN'S THE WORD** – Stewards spoke to Rider C Jordan, regarding the improved performance of the mare. Rider C Jordan stated that the mare had been spelled and dropped back in distance. She also stated that it wasn't her intentions to lead today however after jumping and travelling better than expected she decided to lead.

**SHAMMGOD (NZ)** – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early stages of the race.

**SOULITA** – Bumped with EGYPTIAN STRYKER at the start, over raced early and middle stages of the race.

**VENTURA COUNTY** – Over raced early and middle stages, carried wider approaching the 600m when SOULITA over raced and resulted in the mare stading of the heels of LION ACADEMY. Raced wide throughout.

**ZEVA ROYALE** – Bumped and tightened between EGYPTIAN STRYKER AND HUSAVIK which had shifted out on jumping. Hung out approaching the 600 metres and bumped with EGYPTIAN STRYKER. Hung out severely throughout the race, placing the rider at a disadvantage, made the home turn awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have neck soreness, however no stand period was applied. The mare has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial for its racing manners.

**CLOUDY NIGHTS** – Restrained of heels of ZEVA ROYALE on the home turn. Shifted out approaching the 100m carrying MISS ENTHUSIASM wider.

**MISS ENTHUSIASM** – Raced wide throughout.

### **RACE 3 – LADBROKES EASY FORM MDN/C1 - (1600 METRES)**

**ALMIGHTY VIRTUE** – Approaching the 1250 metres got its head up and shifted out abruptly making the turn awkwardly.

**BIG JOHN** – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

**NAMABAALÉ** – Raced three wide throughout. Stewards advised rider C Jordan to ensure she rides her mount out fully to the line.

**WILD DESTINY (NZ)** – Approaching the 1250m shifted out abruptly and bumped with OUR SONNY BOY.

**MISS SLEUTH** – Over raced in the middle stages of the race, raced wide throughout.

### **RACE 4 –SALTERS HIRE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1350 METRES)**

**SPIRITED TOFF** – Slow to begin, inconvenienced approaching the 1250 metres when having to be restrained from SILLEACT. Continued to over race and pulled hard throughout the early and middle stages. Stewards reprimanded rider E Byrne Burke under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless Riding in that she attempted a run to the inside of GEE GEE REAL DEAL and shifted ground inwards, resulting in BELMISTA checking out over heels.

**BLACK EAGLET** – Bounded on jumping and was slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

**BELMISTA** – Slow to begin, checked out over heels of SPIRITED TOFF approaching the 250m.

**SQUARE DONUT** – Stewards spoke to Trainer D Clark regarding the improved performance of the gelding. He stated that after the addition of blinkers, the favourable run after the tempo eased in the back straight and the gelding didn't handle the soft track last start all resulted in the improved performance.

**FANCIFUL FLYING** – Rider I Toker stated the filly raced flat and failed to respond to his riding from the 400m. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and revealed no abnormalities.

**SILLEACT** – Rider M Ulucinar was advised to exercise care when crossing to the lead.

**SWEETSOP** – Raced three wide throughout.

**ESSEX** – Slow to begin.

**RACE 5 – AVISO TAS PINK CUP DAY MAY 22 CLASS 3 HCP - (1400 METRES)**

**THE MASTER SPEED** – Rider M Ulucinar reported that the gelding failed to handle the track conditions. A post-race veterinary revealed no abnormalities.

**ROCK THE BOWLER** – Bumped with SO I'M DREAMING and was slow to begin.

**GEEGEE LUCKY JESS** – Raced wide throughout.

**SO I'M DREAMING** – Bounded on jumping, shifted out and bumped with ROCK THE BOWLER and was slow to begin.

**HOT RELATION** – Raced wide throughout.

**TEZLAH (NZ)** – Slow to begin. Over raced in the middle stages, raced wide throughout.

**GEE GEE GOLDENLASS** – Rider I Toker pleaded guilty of a charge under the provisions of AR32(7)(ii) in that he used his whip on 11 occasions prior to the 100 metres, with a totality of 16. Rider I Toker was fined the sum of \$300. In assessing penalty stewards took into consideration his very good record under this rule and his guilty plea. Rider I Toker was advised of his right to appeal.

**RACE 6 – CARLTON DRAUGHT BM62 HCP (1650 METRES)**

**DARGO** – Stewards found Rider D Ganderton guilty of a charge under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless Riding. The particulars of the charge are that about the 450 metres D. Ganderton rider of DARGO allowed his mount to shift out resulting in M. Ulucinar rider of NEEDAREIN having to restrain away from heels and being carried wider on the track. Rider D Ganderton was suspended for one Tasmanian race date, in assessing penalty stewards deemed the interference to be in the mid-range and they also took into account his exemplary riding record in relation to this rule. Rider D Ganderton was advised of his rights to appeal.

**ALWAYS A WINNER** – Over raced middle stages when being restrained by its rider.

**DRAMAZING** – Held up approaching the 400m.

**NEEDAREIN** – Stood flat footed and was slow to begin. Restrained approaching the 450 metres when DARGO shifted out.

### **RACE 7 – GO RACING TASMANIA BM68 HCP - (1500 METRES)**

**ARTUSO** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the barriers, rearing, and forcing the front gates open, and was passed fit to race. A warning was placed on the barrier manners of the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**FIGHTING PHOENIX** – Slow to begin, hung out approaching the 600 metres and made the turn awkwardly.

**TROJAN STORM** – Commenced awkwardly and bumped with LADY JOKER, raced wide throughout.

**LADY JOKER** – Bumped after the start with TROJAN STORM, raced wide throughout.

**GEE GEE ROYBOY** – Raced wide throughout.

### **RACE 8 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM 76 HCP (1600 METRES)**

**BARJEEL** – Hung in home straight.

**GEEGEE'S ROCK OPERA** – Layed out in the home straight, shifting wider under pressure approaching the finish post. Stewards spoke to Trainer T Wells regarding the apparent improved performance. T Wells stated that the mare was unlucky last start and the extra distance today all resulted in the improved performance.

**VIDEMANETTE** – Steadied off heels of RED FIORE at about the 1400 metres.

**RED FIORE** – Over raced early and middle stages. Compounded over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Trainer J Luttrell advised stewards that SET PLAY and LITTLE RIVER BOY would both now be retired.

Trainer R Hall advised stewards that STORMONT had pulled up well after the race and it was her intentions to continue to step the gelding up in distance. Trainer R Hall advised that the gelding was racing out of its class and required further distance.
