Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – THE MILLS NEW NORFOLK MAIDEN - (1100 METRES)**

GEE GEES BLOW JOE – Raced four wide throughout, restrained off heels of ELMAJAY approaching the 600 metres.

MOVE LIKE JAGGER – Bumped with Enchanted Spy at the start.

NICCO THE GREEK – Jumped awkwardly at the start and was slow to begin. Bumped with BROADWAY BABE at about the 500 metres.

WANE'S QUEST – Under-went a post-race veterinary examination when returning to the mounting yard and blood in its mouth. Post- race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormality. Trainer advised that the horse's teeth had been done during the week.

BROADWAY BABE – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Bumped with **NICCO THE GREEK** at about the 500 metres.

ELMAJAY – Raced wide throughout, shifted in approaching the 600 metres when not fully clear. Rider C Jordan was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless riding. In not taking further action stewards took into account that her horse started to lose ground at the stage.

ENCHANTED SPY – Stewards granted permission for rider S Carr to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Bumped with **MOVE LIKE JAGGER** at the start.

RACE 2 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS MAIDEN - (1400 METRES)

AFRICAN THUNDER – Jumped awkwardly at the start and raced wide throughout.

ALPINE AVIATOR – Over raced early and middle.

DISCLEVABOY – Bumped with **FURTHER SHE GOES** shortly after the start.

SCOFFED – Checked off heels of **SPEEDROCK** at the start when **FLICKA ON** shifted in. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

ARCUCCI – Held up for a clear run at the 450 metres.

FLICKA ON – Four wide approaching the 600 metres and three wide thereafter.

FURTHER SHE GOES – Bumped with **DISCLEVABOY** shortly after the start.

SH'BOURNE DE LAGO – Raced wide to the 600 metres.

RACE 3 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK CLASS 1 HCP - (1400 METRES)

I'M BACK – Bumped with NINTH ANGEL about the 400 metres.

FOUR LETTER WORD – Slow to muster early speed.

GOLD CHORUS – Slow to muster early speed.

LE MONDE DE LUCAS – Rider T Baker advised that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure, over raced early stages, hung out home turn.

NINTH ANGEL – Raced wide throughout, bumped with I'M BACK at about the 400 metres.

LAKE BLED – Over raced early and middle stages. Rider G Catania was advised to exercise care when shifting ground outwards on the home turn when not fully clear of ROCKYMOUNTAINHIGH.

ROCKYMOUNTAINHIGH – Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 4 –LADBROKE IT! TASMANIAN SIRES PRODUCE – (1400 METRES)

GEEGEE JET BY – Stewards spoke with rider I Toker in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider I Toker stated that his mount didn't handle the track conditions and when placed under pressure, failed to respond to his riding. Trainer S Gandy advised stewards that he believed the gelding may not have performed to what he had hoped and believes that the closure of the Brighton track for three days may have impacted on the horse's performance. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities. Rider I Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100m. Rider I Toker was suspended from riding in races for one Tasmanian race date commencing on midnight the 15th May until midnight 22nd May, 2022. In determining penalty stewards took into account his record under this rule. Rider I Toker was reminded of his right to appeal. Rider I Toker was also reprimanded under the provisions of AR132(7)(a) (ii) for using his whip on consecutive strides on three occasions prior to the 100 metres.

SHARE THE GOLD – Over raced early, raced three wide throughout. Stewards spoke with rider A Darmanin in relation to the below market performance. Rider A Darmanin stated that the gelding pulled hard early and when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding. Trainer G White explained that the performance may have been impacted by the training track being closed due to the recent weather conditions. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

HAPPY CLAN – Slow to begin, held up on the home turn behind JUST A NEEDS.

ZULU ANGEL – Slow to begin.

UNIQUE GLOW – Raced three wide throughout.

JUST A NEEDS – Held up on the home turn behind FROLAND, layed in in the home straight.

STARCADIA – Declared a late scratching at 1.31pm on starters advice after the filly refused to load into the barriers. Trainer J Luttrell was advised the filly must complete a satisfactory trial and load to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on STARCADIA be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 1.31pm:

2 cents in the dollar for the win # 3 HAPPY CLAN
10 cents in the dollar for the place #3 HAPPY CLAN
5 cents in the dollar for the place #7 UNIQUE GLOW
11 cents in the dollar for the place #8 JUST A NEEDS

RACE 5 – GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS MDN/CL1 - (2100 METRES)

GOOD LUCK BOB – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Slow to begin. Rider G Catania advised stewards that she believed there was something amiss with the gelding as it didn't feel comfortable in the run, underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

MELITON – Jumped awkwardly at the start, over raced early and middle stages. Stewards spoke to rider B McCoull in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider B McCoull stated that it was his intentions to ride the gelding wide as he had a tendency to over race. Rider B McCoull believes the gelding may have come

to the end of its preparation. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with trainer.

JUST FOR CURIOSITY – Raced wide throughout.

WORDS OF KINDNESS – Slow to begin, sustained an injury at about the 1200 metres and was eased out of the event. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the mare to have suffered a fractured off hind cannon and was subsequently humanely euthanised.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE 3YO AUTUMN CLASSIC – (1400 METRES)

TURK WARRIOR – Rider I Toker advised stewards that there was something amiss with the gelding. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery. Trainer G Stevenson advised stewards that the gelding would now be spelled. Rider I Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres. On two separate occasions on 4 occasions on the first and 3 on the second occasion. In determining penalty stewards took into account his record under this rule. Rider I Toker was fined the sum of \$300. Rider I Toker was advised of his right to appeal.

RICH CLAN – Over raced early stages of the race, bumped with Gee Gee Snowflake on a number of occasions from the 1000 metres to the 800 metres.

FINXY – Held up home turn.

POPEYE THE SAILOR – Tightened on jumping when FINXY shifted out. Raced four wide throughout. A course announcement was made that the gelding would be wearing blinkers which was not listed in the racebook.

GEE GEE SNOWFLAKE – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin, bumped with RICH CLAN on a number of occasions from the 1000 metres to the 800 metres. Layed in in the home straight, under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

RACE 7 – THE TASMANIAN WINE CENTRE OPEN HCP - (1400 METRES)

SIR SIMON – Connections advised stewards that it was their intentions to have the horse ridden more conservatively today and attempt to take a sit. - Tactics adopted.

TAVIRUN (NZ) – Layed in home straight.

VALLABAR – Jumped awkwardly at the start and steadied off heels of SIR SIMON shortly after. Held up near the 400 metres.

STORMONT – Bounded on jumping.

RACE 8 – CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES CLASS 3 HCP - (1600 METRES)

NEED TO BE UNIQUE – Tightened at the start by YARRA MASTER, raced three wide, layed in in the home straight.

TRUE SCOTSMAN (NZ) – Raced three wide throughout.

ENSNARE – Shifted out at the start and bumped with TERRACOTTA.

YARRA MASTER – Shifted in on jumping tightening NEED TO BE UNIQUE.

TERRACOTTA (NZ) – Tightened between ENSNARE and NEED TO BE UNIQUE at the start.

AMANCAYA – Layed in in the home straight.

FRENCH HEIRESS – Stewards granted permission for rider S Carr to ride the gelding 1kg over the allocated weight.

RACE 9 – HAPPY 40TH BIRTHDAY DAMIAN BM62 HCP - (1100 METRES)

The start of this race was delayed six minutes due to two horses being loose on the track.

DON'TBUCKME OFF – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Jumped out at the start and bumped heavily with HEAVEN'S MIRACLE.

SHARMA RAMA – Bumped with TIESTO at the start.

VETLANDA – Brushed with SILVER ROAD shortly after jumping. Stewards queried rider C Jordan in relation to the below market performance of the filly. Rider C Jordan stated that filly failed to handle today's track conditions when placed under pressure. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

TIESTO – Bumped with SHARMA RAMA at the start.

MAKE A DECISION – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 4.39pm after rearing behind the barriers and breaking free. Trainer S Cotton was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on MAKE A DECISION be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 4.39pm:

25 cents in the dollar for the win # 4 SHARMA RAMA
14 cents in the dollar for the place #4 SHARMA RAMA
21 cents in the dollar for the place #2 KUROSET
12 cents in the dollar for the place #11 ZAGAME

GEE GEE JOSIE – Lunged at the gates hitting its nostrils on the gates when the blindfold was released. Had signs of blood in the left nostril in returning to the mounting yard. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. No stand down was applied.

SILVER ROAD – Brushed with VETLANDA shortly after jumping.

HEAVEN'S MIRACLE – Bumped with DON'TBUCKME OFF at the start, hung in in the early stages of the race, raced wide.

WEALLSTUCKATHOME – Late scratching at 7.56am due to an elevated temperature. Trainer J James was advised a veterinary certificate will be required prior to trialling or racing again.

GENERAL

Mr Sam Lefebvre, Stablehand/Racing Manager for Brunton Racing was issued with a fine of \$200 under the provisions of AR16b(iii) for negligence in engaging a rider for Broadway Babe in race 1. Rider D Ganderton confirmed that he had not been contacted in relation to the riding engagement.
