Comments / Explanations:

Rider S Carr was indisposed for today's meeting.

Rider L Annells will require a medical clearance prior to riding in trials or races.

Prior to the start of race 5, Rider L Annells was dislodged from her horse behind the barriers and was taken by ambulance to hospital for further observation. All races were then re-scheduled and times adjusted to allow the eight-race programme to be completed.

RACE 1 – IT'S WHY WE RACE OPEN HANDICAP - (1100 METRES)

SAVS FINALE – Raced three wide throughout.

IVORYMAN – Slow to begin.

RACE 2 – MCDONALD'S NORTH HOBART 3YO MAIDEN - (1100 METRES)

EXPENSIVE MISTAKE – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

NICCO THE GREEK – Bumped with WANE'S QUEST at the start, bumped with FIRE TIGERESS approaching the 500 metres when that filly shifted wider to improve, laid in from the top of the straight until the 200 metres. Stewards queried rider D Pires on the below market performance of the gelding. Rider D Pires stated that when he placed the gelding under pressure in the home straight it failed to respond to his riding.

TARKINE EAGLE – Raced three wide early to the 600 metres.

WANE'S QUEST – Bumped with NICCO THE GREEK at the start.

FAIRY MAGIC – Over raced in the early stages.

FIRE TIGERESS – Bumped with NICCO THE GREEK at about the 400 metres when attempting to improve, steadied off heels of CONFUSED shortly after.

GONE GLOBAL – Slow to begin 2L, hung out from the 600 metres until the home turn, raced greenly throughout.

HER THOUGHTS – Was declared a late scratching at 7.51am by order of stewards due to no available rider.

OUR MATERIAL GIRL – Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulucinar to ride 1kg over the allotted weight.

RACE 3 – OFF THE TRACK MAIDEN - (1600 METRES)

EAGLE STREET – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin as a result. Rider D Pires pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 12 occasions prior to the 100 metres. In determining penalty stewards took into account his guilty plea, his record in relation to this rule and the number of times the whip was used. After considering penalty stewards fined rider D Pires \$500. Rider D Pires was reminded of his right to appeal.

Rider D Pires was also reprimanded under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on consecutive strides on one occasion prior to the 100 metres.

JUST FOR CURIOSITY – Steadied off heels of Coronation Apache rounding the home turn, laid in in the home straight, rider B Muhcu had to stop and straighten nearing the 200 metres.

MYOCARDIUM – Fractious in the barriers and raced wide throughout.

FURTHER NORTH – Held up at about the 400 metres behind EAGLE STREET.

FURTHER SHE GOES – Was declared a late scratching at 8.00am by order of stewards due to no available rider.

SHAMMGOD – Stewards questioned rider C Baker in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider C Baker stated that due to the mare jumping better than expected from a wide barrier and knowing the horse's racing manners with the horse pulling hard or over racing, she allowed the horse to go further forward than she wanted to and that she was mindful of not wanting to unsettle the mare. Rider C Baker further stated that when placing the mare under pressure in the home straight it failed to respond. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

RACE 4 – BEC THOMAS MAYOR OF GLENORCHY MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

JACKJACK – Shifted out on jumping hampering EGYPTIAN STRYKER.

MANODAL RAIN – Jumped awkwardly at the start after making contact with the side of the barriers.

DEB'S DREAM – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

EGYPTIAN STRYKER – Hampered at the start when JACKJACK shifted out, raced four wide throughout.

WEALLSTUCKATHOME – Raced three wide throughout, rider R Tan was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for not being fully clear when crossing SISTINE near the 1000 metres.

SISTINE – Over raced early and middle stages, held up rounding the home turn and entering the home straight.

RACE 5 – A-MAZE-IN RICHMOND CLASS 1 HCP - (1200 METRES)

MAKE A DECISION – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.24pm after rearing behind the barriers, dislodging it's rider and breaking free. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on MAKE A DECISION be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 2.24pm:

31 cents in the dollar for the win # 4 I'M BACK
17 cents in the dollar for the place #4 I'M BACK
26 cents in the dollar for the place #5 LAYLOW PLUCK
21 cents in the dollar for the place #3 BANCA TOM

Trainer S Cotton was advised that the gelding must complete two consecutive satisfactory trials. Stewards also discussed the option of a senior rider. Ms Cotton stated that she had engaged a senior rider who was then indisposed. Ms Cotton also stated that it was her intentions to now spell the gelding to address the geldings traits, prior to trialling again.

TWO DOLLAR TOM – Slow to begin.

BANCA TOM – Got its head up on jumping and shifted in bumping with I'M BACK. Raced wide throughout.

I'M BACK – Bumped with BANCA TOM shortly after jumping.

LAYLOW PLUCK – Raced wide throughout.

RANSOM TRUST – Stewards spoke with rider B McCoull in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider B McCoull stated that the mare failed to handle the track conditions when taking an inside run and when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.

POWERFUL PEBBLES – Slow to begin and slow to muster early speed.

BAHEERA – Bumped with LIKILIKU at the start.

HEAVEN'S MIRACLE – Got its head up and commenced to over race nearing the 700 metres and shifted out abruptly.

LIKILIKU – Bumped with BAHEERA at the start, over-raced in the early stages.

PERKINS – Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulucinar to ride 2kg over the allocated weight due to rider shortages at today's meeting.

RACE 6 – GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS BM62 HCP – (1200 METRES)

HOLY DIAMOND – Bumped with I'M KRUIPT at the start.

TIESTO – Raced four wide throughout.

ALINJER – Blundered at the start and was slow to begin as a result. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

I'M KRUIPT – Bumped with HOLY DIAMOND at the start, laid out home straight.

LUCA BRATZI – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – AVISO TAS PINK CUP - (1430 METRES)

TRUE SCOTSMAN – Stewards queried rider A Darmanin in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider A Darmanin stated that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

AMANCAYA – Approaching the 1200 metres steadied off heels when tightened for room between TRUE SCOTSMAN and PHENOMENAL DANCER.

SQUARE DONUT – Rider T Baker reported that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions, in his opinion the gelding handles the synthetic racing surface better. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

BERRUTI – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 2kg over the allocated weight when replacing the injured rider L Annells as there was no other available riders. Raced three wide early and middle stages of the race.

NEV'S BOY – Inconvenienced at the start when tightened for room between PHENOMENAL DANCER and AMANCAYA.

STEFANIDI – Slow to begin.

RACE 8 – UP CUPS BM68 HCP - (2100 METRES)

STORMONT – was a late scratching at 3.45pm on veterinary advice after falling in the day stalls. Trainer Mrs R Hall was advised the gelding will require a veterinary certificate prior to trialling or racing. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on STORMONT be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 3.45pm:

6 cents in the dollar for the win # 6 GEEGEES ROCK OPERA
11 cents in the dollar for the place #6 GEEGEES ROCK OPERA
10 cents in the dollar for the place #1 ONE LOTTO
5 cents in the dollar for the place #3 TRAVELLING GIGOLO

COSTERO – Slow to begin.

GEEGEES ROCK OPERA – Stewards spoke to rider T Johnstone in relation to allowing her mount to shift wider in the home straight. Rider T Johnstone was advised to exercise care and ensure she stops and straightens her mount if shifting out in future.

SUNSET GUN – Stewards delayed correct weight due to C Baker, rider of the 4th placed SUNSET GUN wishing to review the official patrol films in the home straight. After consideration rider C Baker elected not to proceed with an objection. Correct weight was then declared on the judge's numbers.
