Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – THAI IMPERIAL MDN/CL1 - (1800 METRES)**

MAINCOURT – Raced wide throughout. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages

HAMPTON BAY – Shifted out on jumping, bumping with ARCUCCI. Restrained off the heels of SILENT LOVE at about the 1600 metres and then commenced to over race. Continued to race fiercely throughout the early and middle stages.

ROCKYMOUNTAINHIGH – Shifted out after the start tightening SILENT LOVE out onto STRAWBERRY KISS.

STRIKE IMPACT – Rider B McCoull reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Stewards will follow up with Trainer D Keating regarding the performance of the gelding.

ARCUCCI – Bumped with HAMPTON BAY at the start, steadied off the heels of HAMPTON BAY approaching the 1400 metres, raced wide throughout.

SILENT LOVE – Rider S Carr was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a)careless riding for crossing at the 1600 metres for the lead when not fully clear, resulting in Hampton Bay having to be restrained by its rider and then commence to over race-over. Stewards reminded rider S. Carr of her obligations to ensure she doesn't set an excessively slow the speed of her mount in future when allowing STRIKE IMPACT to cross to lead on approaching the 1400 metres.

STRAWBERRY KISS – Tightened for room shortly after the start when SILENT LOVE was carried outwards by ROCKYMOUNTAINHIGH. STRAWBERRY KISS then appeared to clip the heels of MAINCOURT and blundered.

VAMP – Raced wide leaving the home straight near the 1400 metres.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES MATES MODE 2YO MAIDEN - (1150 METRES)

HE'LL ROCK IT – Inconvenienced by ELMAJAY which shifted out when being restrained near the 800 metres.

OUR SATURDAY – Raced greenly and caught wide throughout.

TURK BOY – Slow to begin.

ZULU ANGEL – Commenced awkwardly. Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin regarding the disappointing performance of the gelding. Rider A Darmanin stated that the gelding failed to handle the synthetic surface and when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

CLOUDY NIGHTS – Held up approaching the home turn.

EMPHATIC BEL (NZ) – Jumped awkwardly.

ESPUR – Declared a late Scratching at 10:30am after dislodging a shoe and being found to be lame. Trainer Y Nishitani was advised that a veterinary certificate is required prior to trialling or racing again. On the announcement of correct weight

stewards ordered that all monies invested on ESPUR be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 10.30am:

7 cents in the dollar for the win # 6 CLOUDY NIGHTS
13 cents in the dollar for the place #6 CLOUDY NIGHTS
7 cents in the dollar for the place #8 EMPHATIC BEL (NZ)
13 cents in the dollar for the place #1 FROLAND

FLYING TO PARIS – Steadied off the heel approaching the 600m, held up approaching the home turn. Held up when attempting a run inside EMPHATIC BEL (NZ) from the 100 metres to the finish where there was insufficient room to progress.

TRICKY MIKKI – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 9.45am after confirming with trainer T Hanson that they were unable to load the filly. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on TRICKY MIKKI be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 9.45am:

8 cents in the dollar for the win # 6 CLOUDY NIGHTS
17 cents in the dollar for the place #6 CLOUDY NIGHTS
8 cents in the dollar for the place #8 EMPHATIC BEL
17 cents in the dollar for the place #1 FROLAND

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN - (1150 METRES)

OUR SONNY BOY – Commenced awkwardly.

POP A HONDA – Bumped with LIONROUND on jumping and blundered shortly after nearly dislodging its rider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

HAMPTON STREET – Slow to begin.

LIONROUND – Bumped with ROCK' EM BABY shortly after the start, raced three wide throughout. Rider D Pires reported that the filly failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Trainer J Keys advised that the filly will now be spelled.

MISS ENTHUSIASM – Declared a late scratching at 12:47pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious and hitting its head on the front of the barriers. The mare has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on MISS ENTHUSIASM be refunded with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 12.47pm:

4 cents in the dollar for the win #12 ROCK' EM BABY
3 cents in the dollar for the place #12 ROCK' EM BABY
4 cents in the dollar for the place #1 LACERATE
8 cents in the dollar for the place #4 TUFFASK

PAGE – Threw its head in the air on jumping and was slow to begin as a result.

ROCK'EM BABY – Rider S Carr was reprimanded under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(i) for using her whip on consecutive strides on one occasion prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 4 –TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT MAIDEN – (1350 METRES)

ALPINE AVIATOR – Over raced in the early stages, carried RUNS LIKE WATER wider at the 1200m.

MOVE LIKE JAGGER – Stewards spoke to rider D Pires in relation to the gelding's performance. D Pires stated that once the gelding crossed to the lead it threw its head in the air and did not respond to his riding. He also stated that this was the first time the gelding had raced on the synthetic track and that the addition of blinkers may not have suited. He added that after laying in entering the home straight he changed his whip to his left hand and this resulted in the gelding shifting out considerably in the home straight.

SOUTHERN WIND – Shifted out abruptly on jumping bumping with MOVE LIKE JAGGER, which shifted out tightening FURTHER SHE GOES which at the same time received pressure from KISSES FOR ROSY, which had jumped inwards.

FURTHER SHE GOES – Checked after the start by SOUTHERN WIND shifting out and KISSES FOR ROSY which jumped inwards.

KISSES FOR ROSY – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with FURTHER SHE GOES.

RUNS LIKE WATER – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take its place in the field.

LUCE DELLA LUNA – Hung out throughout.

RACE 5 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN BM76 HCP - (1650 METRES)

SKYWAY STAR – Raced three wide in the early stages to sit outside the leader.

ROCK THE BOWLER – Compounded from the 600 metres to be beaten 39 lengths. Stewards spoke to Rider A Darmanin regarding the poor performance of the gelding. Rider A Darmanin was unable to offer any explanation for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination found a small cut on its tongue, however no other abnormalities were detected. Stewards spoke to Trainer G Stevenson who stated that he will give the gelding a short let up and then a 1000 metre gallop followed by an endoscopic examination. The results of which will be forwarded to the stewards. Stewards advised trainer G Stevenson that in addition to this the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

RISING HSIANG – Trainer G Stevenson advised a change of tactics for today's event stating that the gelding will be ridden more positively today, these tactics were adopted.

RACE 6 – NOVA DESIGN AND PRINT BM62 - (1650 METRES)

INCRIMINATE – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2:31PM after becoming cast in the barriers. Trainer A Trinder was advised the gelding will be required to do a satisfactory barrier trial prior to trialling or racing. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on INCRIMINATE be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 2.31pm:

15 cents in the dollar for the win # 8 SKILENDRA
14 cents in the dollar for the place #8 SKILENDRA
14 cents in the dollar for the place #7 KAY OH ELL
12 cents in the dollar for the place #5 OBVIOUS STEP

SKILENDRA – Held up from the home turn until the 300 metres.

TEE JAY FRANKIE – Rider B Muhcu stated that when placing the gelding under pressure at the 600 metres it failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities, stewards will follow up with trainer S Gandy.

PORT BERRY (NZ) – Held up approaching the 250 metres.

LE MONDE DE LUCAS – Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride 1kg over the allotted weight, raced three wide and over raced early and middle stages of the race.

SWEETSOP – Brushed the side of the gates and was slow to begin.

RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP - (1350 METRES)

SPIRITED TOFF – Jumped awkwardly at the start, laid in over the concluding stages, resulting in its rider having to stop and straighten.

BELMISTA – Slow to begin, raced three wide without cover, laid in, in the home straight.

GEE GEES BUZZ – Commenced awkwardly.

OLYMPIC HONOUR – Hung in throughout.

DREAMING TORONADO – Slow to begin.

SILVER PERSUASION – Over raced early stages.

LAKE BLEED – Stewards spoke to Rider K Quilty regarding the riding tactics adopted. Rider K Quilty stated that after jumping better than expected she continued forward to take up a forward position whereafter the mare proved difficult to restrain. Compounded from the 200 metres.

SILENT DREAMER – Over raced in the middle stages of the event. Steadied of heels approaching the 600m when OLYMPIC HONOUR laid in, despite the efforts of its rider.

RACE 8 – GREAT NORTHERN 0-62 (1150 METRES)

TROJAN STORM – Slow to begin, held up for a clear passing the 100 metres until the finish.

RHYME WRITER – Fractious in barriers prior to jumping.

GEE GEE JOSIE – A warning has been continued on the mare for being difficult to load.

SHAMZOU – Declared a non-runner by Order of Stewards after rider M Ulucinar and Trainer G McCulloch wished to view the official patrol films of the start. The stewards were satisfied that SHAMZOU became fractious prior to release and was being held by a barrier attendant as the gates opened. As a result of this the mare lost considerable ground. Stewards determined that SHAMZOU had been denied a fair start. A warning has been continued on the mare's barrier manners.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on SHAMZOU be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers.

1 cent in the dollar for the win # 6 OUR SHINKANSEN
1 cent in the dollar for the PLACE # 6 OUR SHINKANSEN
1 cent in the dollar for the place #11 BETHPAGE
1 cent in the dollar for the place #5 TERRACOTTA

NINTH ANGEL – Declared a late scratching at 2:22pm due to there being no available rider. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on NINTH ANGEL be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 2.22pm:

3 cents in the dollar for the win # 6 OUR SHINKANSEN
4 cents in the dollar for the place #6 OUR SHINKANSEN
3 cents in the dollar for the place #11 BETHPAGE
3 cents in the dollar for the place #5 TERRACOTTA

RACE 9 – YOUNG RACING TASMANIA CLASS 3 HCP – (1150 METRES)

FIGHTING FLOYD – Bumped with NEED TO BE UNIQUE after the start.

GENERAL

Trainer L Laskey pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR228 Conduct detrimental part (b) improper conduct.

Particulars of the charge were that prior to the start of race 8, Trainer L Laskey struck TERRACOTTA on two occasions to the shoulder with his hand. This occurred after the mare became fractious in the mounting yard when he was leading her. In assessing penalty stewards took into account his guilty plea and his clean record in relation to this rule. Mr Laskey was fined the sum of \$500, with \$250 wholly suspended that he not re-offend for a period of 12 months. Mr Laskey was advised of his right to appeal.
