***Comments / Explanations:***

*Rider B McCoull was indisposed for today's meeting. Rider B McCoull was advised that a medical clearance will be required prior to riding again.*

**RACE 1 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS OPEN HCP - (1200 METRES)**

**SAVS FINALE** – Rider T Baker reported that there was something amiss with the gelding. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

**RACE 2 – LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)**

**EXPENSIVE MISTAKE** – Fractious in the barriers a warning was placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

**JACKJACK** – Jumped outwards at the start bumping with GONE GLOBAL and was slow to muster early speed, tailed the field in the early stages. Stewards spoke with rider T Johnstone in relation to the performance of the gelding. Rider T Johnstone stated that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the early stages of the race when she trailed the field. But ran on strongly in the home straight.

**DONNA'S DAY** – Raced wide throughout, Under-went a post-race veterinary examination due to blood in its mouth on returning to the mounting yard. The veterinary examination found that the filly had recently lost a cap.

**GONE GLOBAL** – Bumped with JACKJACK at the start.

**HER THOUGHTS** – Raced three wide throughout.

**RAPID EFFECT** – Jumped awkwardly, held up for a clear run from the 500 metres until the 400 metres.

**SISTINE** – Slow to begin. Stewards spoke with rider S Carr in relation to the below market performance of the filly. Rider S Carr stated that the addition of earmuffs to encourage the filly not to over race assisted in settling the filly. She also stated that the filly failed to run on. Trainer S Carr advised that the filly would now be spelled.

### **RACE 3 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN - (1430 METRES)**

**TARKINE EAGLE** – Bumped with WANE'S QUEST inside the final 100 metres. There was a delay on correct weight as rider S Carr requested to view the official patrol films in view of lodging an objection against the winner. After viewing the official patrol films correct weight was announced on the judge's numbers.

**WANE'S QUEST** – Shifted in over the final 100 metres bumping momentarily with TARKINE EAGLE. Rider E Byrne-Burke momentarily stopped and straightened her mount.

**BROADWAY BABE** – Raced wide throughout, laid in in the home straight.

**EGAO** – Over raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

**SHE PAYS** – Raced wide throughout.

**SURANGANI** – Stewards reminded rider A Darmanin, rider of the 4th placegetter, of his obligations to ride his mounts right out to the finish line.

**TALKINGABOUTMYGIRL** – Raced wide throughout, laid in, in the home straight. Rider B Neto pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres, four times more than

permitted. Rider B Neto was suspended for one Tasmanian race date, starting midnight 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 until midnight 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. Stewards took into account his guilty plea and his record in relation to this rule. Rider B Neto was reminded of his right of appeal.

#### **RACE 4 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK MDN/CL1 – (1600 METRES)**

**LE MONDE DE LUCAS** – Over raced in the early stages. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight. Stewards spoke with trainer T Keys in relation to the improved performance. Trainer T Keys stated that the gelding had travelled wide at its previous start at Devonport. Ms Keys also stated that they had been schooling the gelding over the jumps during the week, which may have assisted the improved performance.

**FOUR LETTER WORD** – Stewards queried the below market performance of the filly. Rider A Darmanin stated that when he placed the filly under pressure from the 700 metres that it failed to respond to his riding. Stewards reprimanded rider A Darmanin under the provisions of AR131(b) for failing to ride his mount out to the finish line.

**CLOUD CHASER** – Raced three wide throughout.

**CONFUSED** – Stewards advised rider C Baker that she should not use the whip when out of contention.

#### **RACE 5 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HANDICAP - (1430 METRES)**

**STARION** – Raced wide throughout.

**SPIRITED TOFF** – Raced three wide throughout.

**HOBART** – Slow to begin.

**I'M KRUPT** – Raced wide throughout.

**DREAMING TORONADO** – Slow to begin, Rider S Carr reported than when placing the mare under pressure in the home straight it failed to respond to her riding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

**POWERFUL PEBBLES** – Slow to muster early speed, held up on the home turn and entering the home straight.

**SIGNTHECHEQUE** – Stewards queried the below market performance of the mare. Rider T Baker stated that the mare was up in distance and had failed to run out the distance in today's event.

### **RACE 6 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM68 HCP – (1430 METRES)**

**GREGORIAN CHANT (NZ)** – Declared a late scratching 11.15am for non-arrival on course. Trainer G Stevenson pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR227(a) for negligence in failing to bring the correct horse to the track. Trainer G Stevenson was fined the sum of \$500 in assessing penalty stewards accepted his guilty plea, that it was his first offence under this rule and his remorse. Mr Stevenson was reminded of his right of appeal.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on GREGORIAN CHANT be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 11.15am.

3 cents in the dollar for the win # 7 YARRA MASTER  
5 cents in the dollar for the place #7 YARRA MASTER  
6 cents in the dollar for the place #3 PRISTINE IMAGE  
4 cents in the dollar for the place #5 FREAK ON A LEAD

**IVORYMAN (NZ)** – Raced wide throughout. Prior to correct weight rider T Baker wished to view the official photo finish. After doing so correct weight was announced on the judge's numbers.

**TRUE SCOTSMAN (NZ)** – Stewards questioned rider C Jordan in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider C Jordan stated that when placing the gelding under pressure it failed to respond to her riding. Rider C Jordan believed the gelding would now be sent for a spell to freshen up. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery. Stewards will follow up with trainer G Stevenson.

**STORMONT** – Slow to begin.

**TIESTO** – Stewards questioned rider C Atkinson on the tactics adopted on the gelding today. Rider C Atkinson advised that his instructions where to find a position midfield. However, after jumping better than expected he allowed the gelding to go forward. He also stated that it was not his intentions to lead but, in his opinion, he didn't want to unsettle the gelding by attempting to restrain. Rider C Atkinson advised that the

gelding travelled well to the 600 metres but when placed under pressure from the home turn the gelding failed to respond to his riding.

### **RACE 7 – LADBROKES MATES MODE BM62 HCP - (2100 METRES)**

**ONE LOTTO** – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight bumping with SHAMPZ AGAIN.

**TRAVELLING GIGOLO** – Shifted out at the 1500 metres off the heels of GEEGEEES ROCK OPERA when starting to over race, carrying GOLD CHORUS wider.

**SHAMPZ AGAIN** – Bumped with GOLD CHORUS at the start. Rider T Baker reported that the gelding hung in, in the home straight, bumped with ONE LOTTO in the home straight when that gelding shifted out.

**GOLD CHORUS** – Jumped awkwardly, bumping with SHAMPZ AGAIN shortly after. Carried wider at the 1500 metres when TRAVELLING GIGOLO shifted out.

### **RACE 8 – LADBROKES PUNTER ASSIST CLASS 3 HCP - (1100 METRES)**

**I'M BACK** – Jumped awkwardly, shifted out abruptly bumping with NEUTRALIZE. Bumped and carried wider by SEGUIMIENTOS about the 200 metres.

**CRYSTAL PALLAZO** – Bumped with NEUTRALIZE shortly after the start. Trainer R Hall was unable to offer an explanation to the reasons why the mare performed below market expectations. But stated that the mare has been up for a while and will now be spelled. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Rider C Atkinson was advised that he is not to use his whip when out of contention.

**QUEENBOROUGH FLYER** – Jumped awkwardly, shifted out soon after inconveniencing SEGUIMIENTOS, bumped with SMOKIN' HARD approaching the 600 metres. Rider S Carr reported that the filly failed to handle today's track conditions.

**NEUTRALIZE** – Bumped with I'M BACK shortly after jumping, bumped with CRYSTAL PALLAZO shortly after.

**SEGUIMIENTOS** – Inconvenienced at the start when QUEENBOROUGH FLYER shifted out, shifted out at about the 200 metres bumping with I'M BACK which was

carried wider, out onto SMOKIN' HARD. Stewards advised rider E Byrne-Burke of her obligations when shifting ground outwards in the home straight.

**SMOKIN' HARD** – Raced wide throughout, bumped with QUEENBOUROUGH FLYER at about the 600 metres. Steadied off heels of I'M BACK at about the 200 metres.

## **GENERAL**

### **RACE 1 – DRC 29/05/2022**

**STRIKE IMPACT** - Stewards spoke with trainer D Keating in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Trainer D Keating stated that it was the first time on the synthetic surface and that after racing fiercely and pulling hard in the race all these factors would have affected its performance. He also stated that he was re-assessing the racing plans for the gelding.

### **RACE 6 - DRC 29/05/2022**

**TEE JAY FRANKIE** – Trainer S Gandy advised stewards that the gelding pulled up a bit flat and that the gelding was placed on a course of oral antibiotics.

### **BRIGHTON TRAINING COMPLEX - 17<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, 2021.**

Stable Foreman Ms N Luttrell pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR228(b) for misconduct in using abusive language towards Tas Racing employee Mr Simon Ford at the Brighton Training complex on the 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2021. Ms Luttrell was fined the sum of \$400 which was wholly suspended with a condition that she does not reoffend for a period of two years. In assessing penalty stewards took into account her guilty plea, her honesty during the inquiry and that she had no prior infringements as a stable foreman or trainer.
